



## **CONSTRUCTION WORKS**

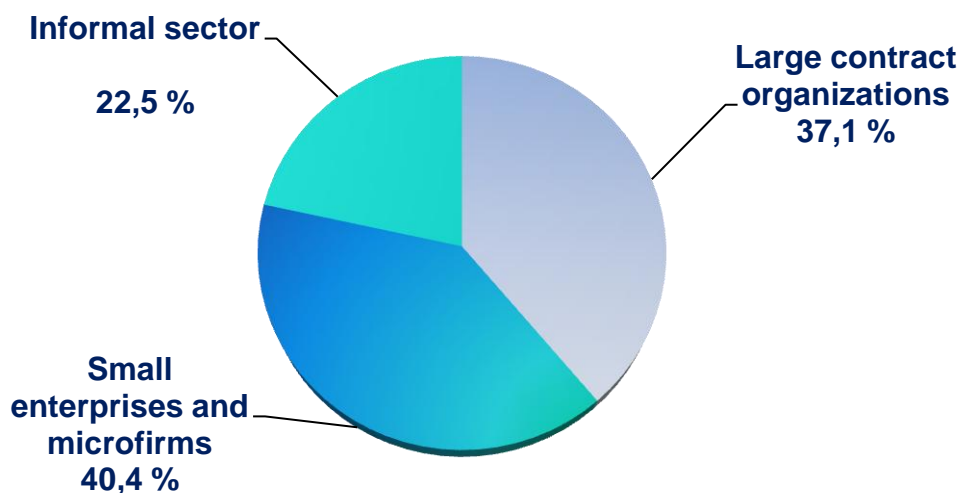
**January-April 2018**

The volume of completed construction works for January-April of this year amounted to 13,143.5 billion soums. The growth rate to the corresponding period of the previous year amounted to 113.1%. The volume of construction works performed by major contractors amounted to 4,880.7 billion soums, or 144.6% compared to the same period last year, the share in the

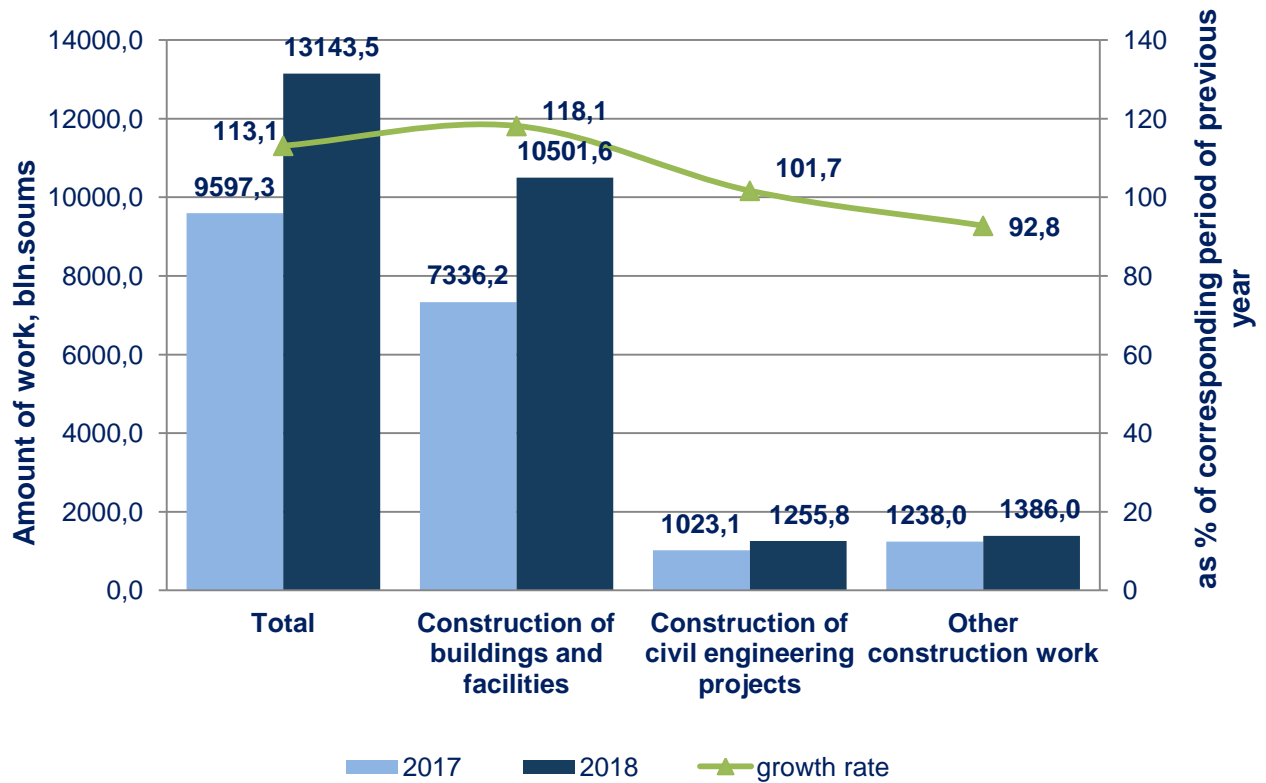
total amount of construction work reached 37.1 %.

The volume of construction works carried out by small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 5,307.0 billion soums, or 40.4% of the total volume of construction works, the growth rate - 106.4%. The share of the informal sector was 22.5%, or 2 955.8 billion soums, growth rate - 90.4%.

### Construction works by activities



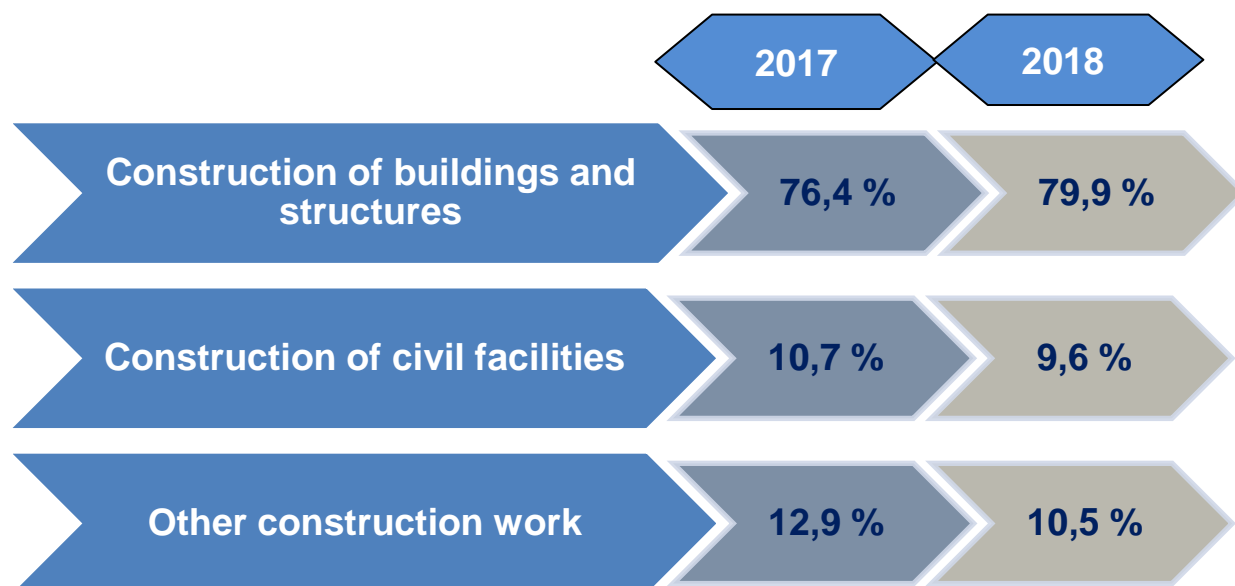
The main part of construction works by types of economic activity was carried out due to the construction of residential buildings and non-residential premises. Their share in the total volume of construction works was 79.9% and, compared to the same period last year, increased by 3.5% x point.

The share in the volume of

construction work for this type of economic activity, like the construction of civilian objects, was 9.6% and, compared to the same period last year, decreased by 1.1% x point.

The share of other contract works was 10.5% and, compared to the same period last year, decreased by 2.4% x point.

### Structure of construction works by types of economic activity (in% of total)



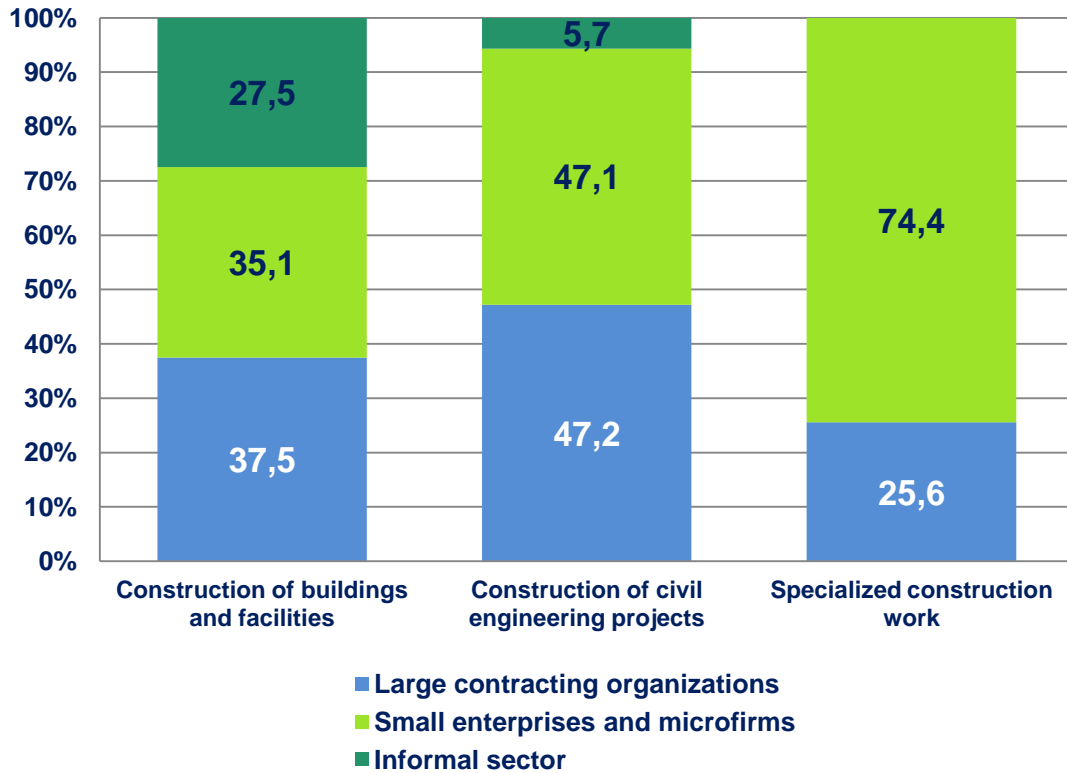
The share in the volume of construction works for this type of economic activity, such as the construction of buildings and structures, carried out by large organizations, amounted to 37.5% and, compared to the same period last year, increased by 10.0% x point. Accordingly, the share of small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 35.1% (decrease by 1.9% x point), the informal sector - 27.5% (decrease by 8.0% x point).

Large contractor organizations implemented 47.2% of the total construction work for the

construction of civilian facilities. Compared to the same period last year, this indicator grew by 8.0% x point. The share of small enterprises and microfirms amounted to 47.1% (a decrease of 7.5% x point), the informal sector - 5.7% (an increase of 0.5% x point).

In the volume of other contract works, the share of large contracting organizations decreased by 5.0% of the point and amounted to 25.6%. The share of small enterprises and microfirms accounted for 74.4% (an increase of 5.0% x point).

### Structure by activities in January-March 2018 (as % of total)

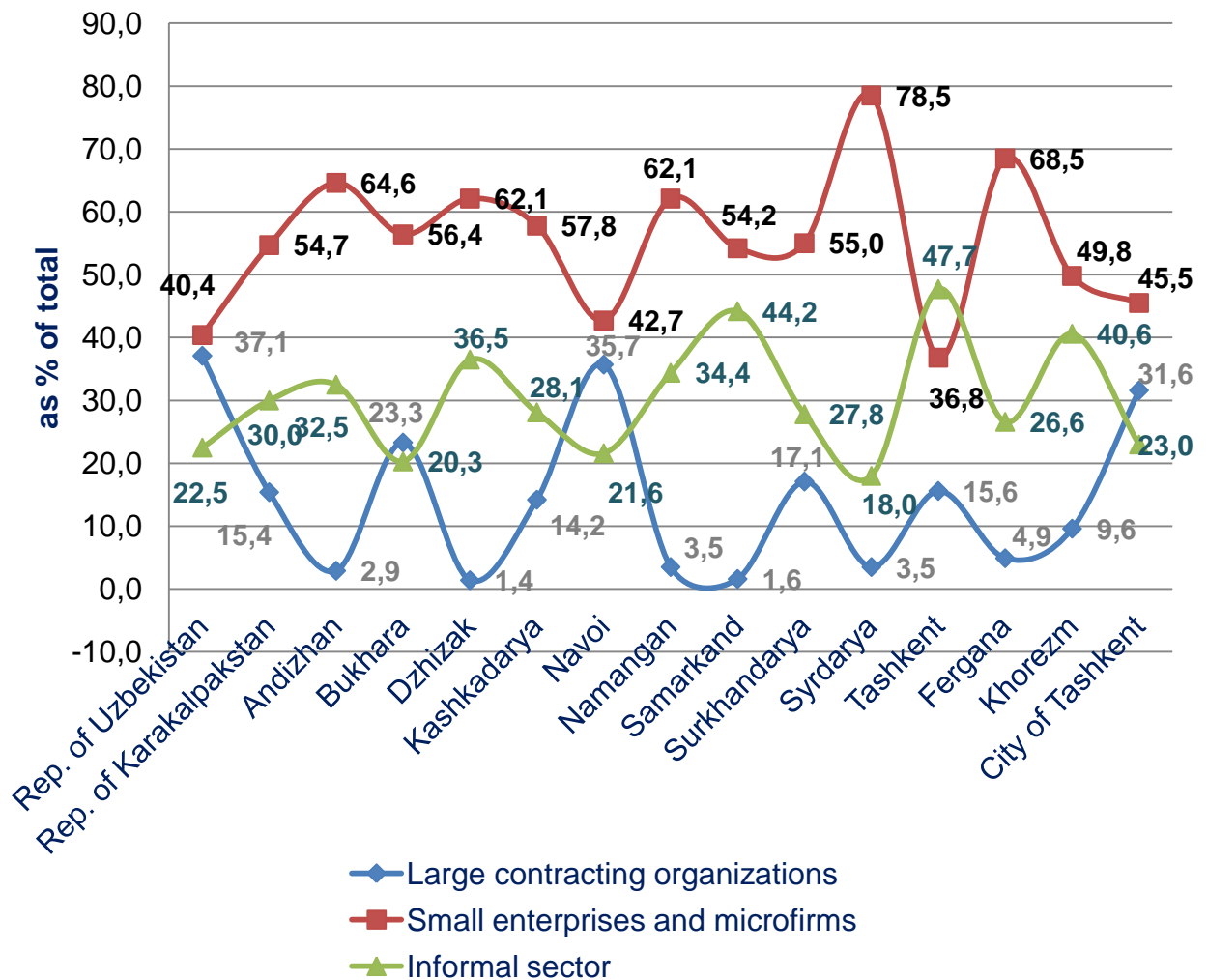


Navoi region is in the lead in the regional structure of construction works executed by large contract organizations. Major contractors in the territory of this region performed 35.7% of the total construction work.

The next position in this

indicator was observed in the city of Tashkent - 31.6%. At the same time, in this region small enterprises and microfirms performed 42.7% of the total volume of construction works and the informal sector accounted for 21.6%.

### Structure of construction work by regions

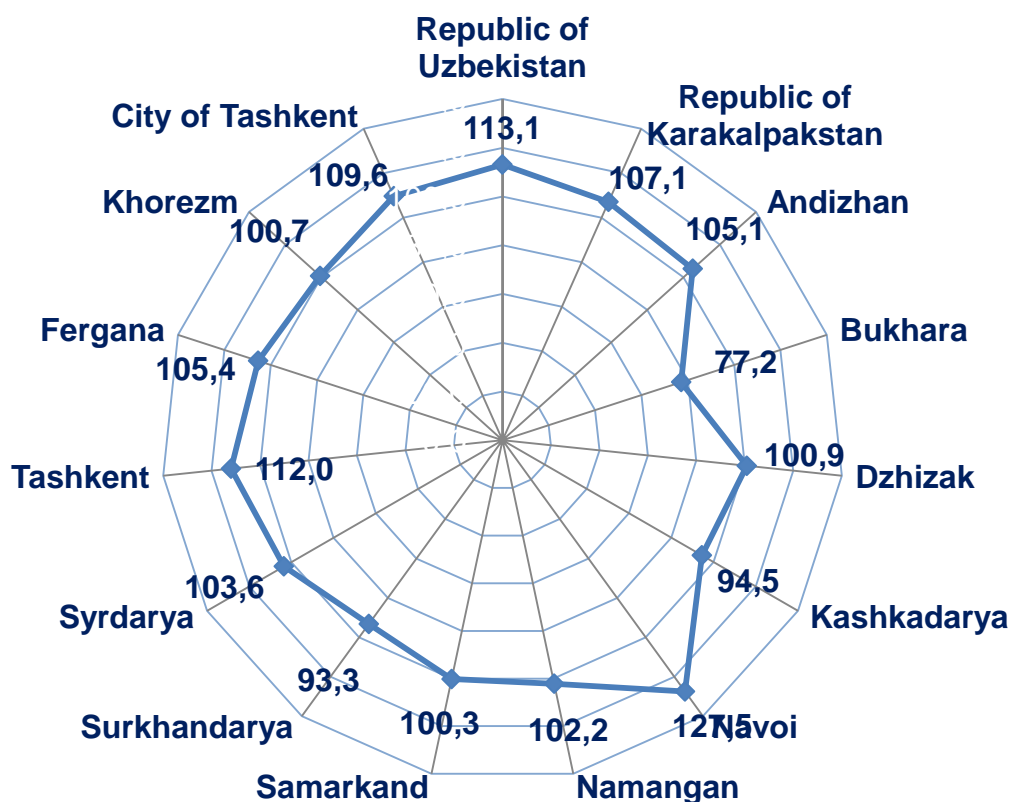


The lowest share in the volume of construction work performed by major contractors was noted in the Jizzakh region - 1.4%. Most of the construction work in this region fell to small businesses and microfirms, accounting for 62.1% of the total construction work.

A high proportion in the total volume of construction work on small entrepreneurship was observed in the Syrdarya region - 78.5%. In this region, the share of large organizations was 3.5% and the informal sector 18.0%.

### Growth rates of construction work by regions (as % of corresponding period of previous year)

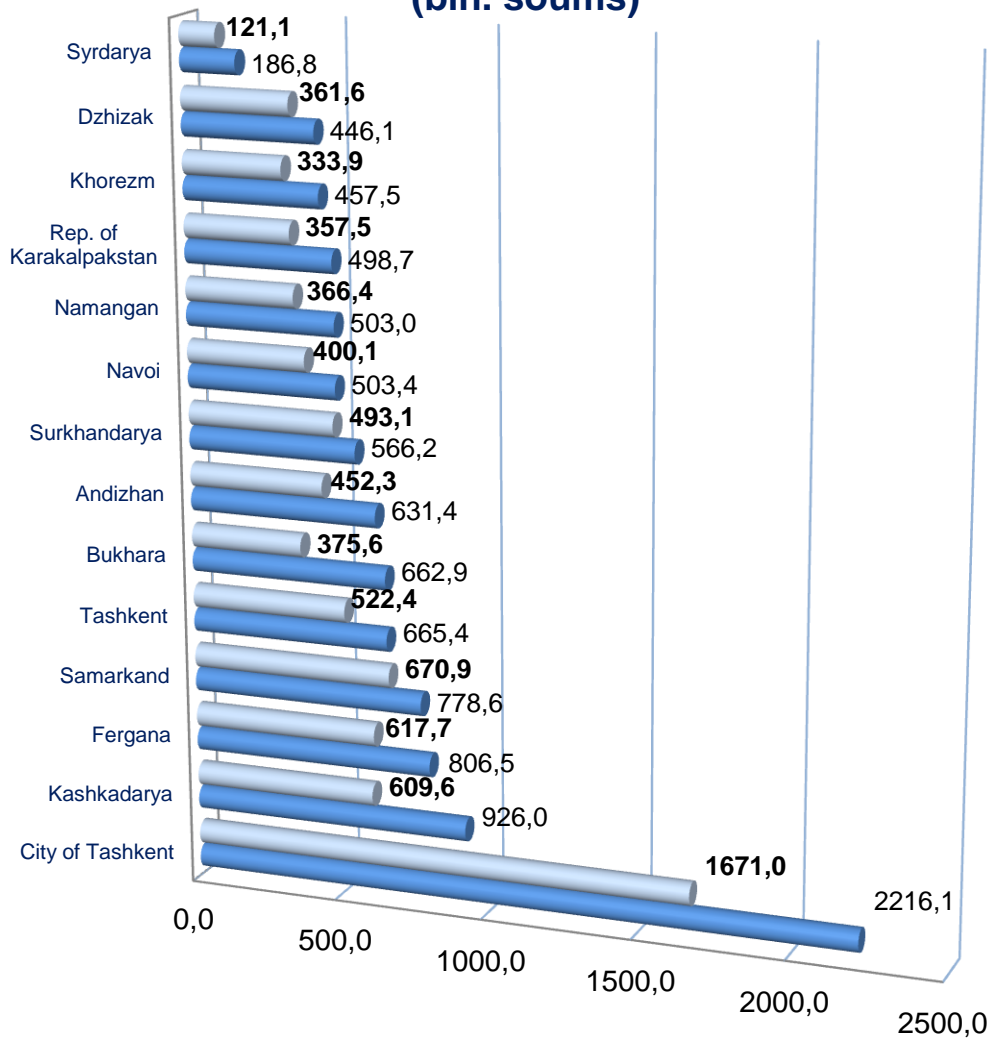


The highest growth rates of construction work were observed in Navoi region and in Tashkent city. In the Navoi region, a high growth rate of 127.5% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year was achieved through the construction of a mine for the extraction and processing of gold-bearing ores from the Auminso-Amantoy ore field (IGM-5) (I-II stages), the reconstruction of the third line pumping station «Amudaryo-Zarafshon».

The active construction of individual houses in the Tashkent region ensured a growth rate of 112.0% compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

The construction of the metro line, the bridge, the ring railway, the reconstruction of the Tashkent Pedagogical Institute and the national park ensured a growth rate of 109.6% in the city of Tashkent.
