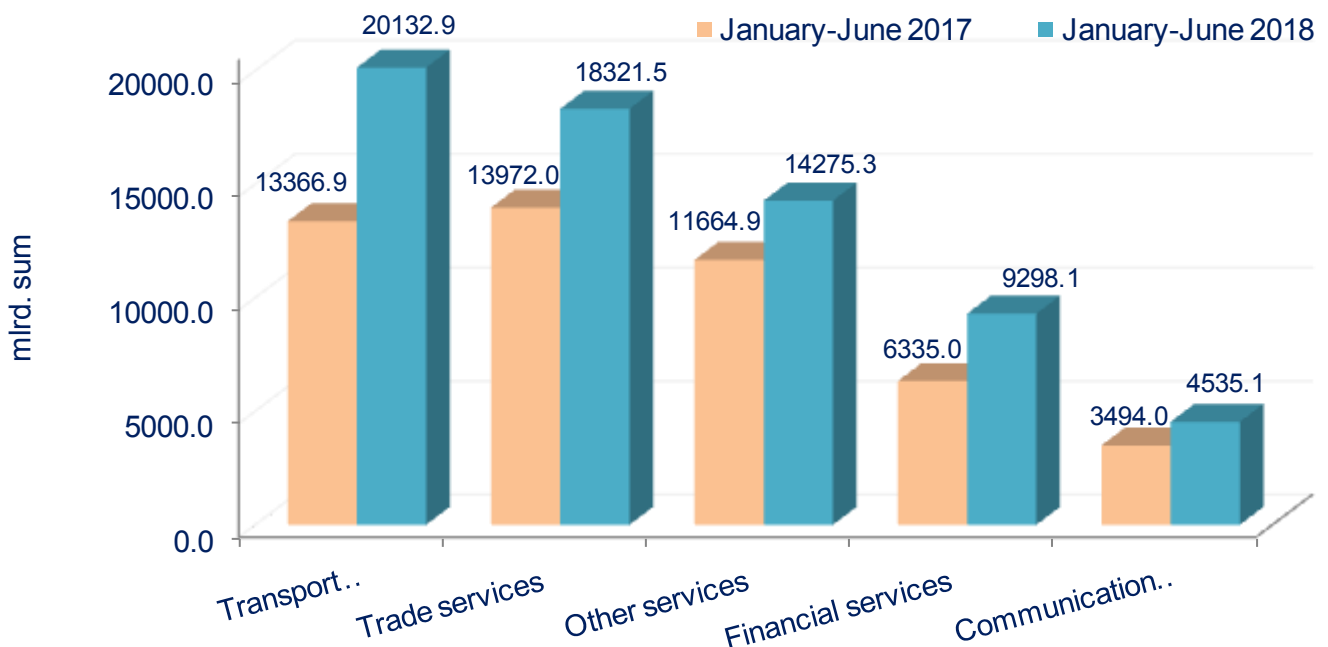
Figures:

- The volume of market services for January-June 2018 was 66562.9 billion sums.
- The growth rate of financial services amounted to 132.2%.
- The share of transport services in the total volume of services was 30.3%
- The volume of market services per capita amounted to 2,030.7 thousand sums.

Expansion and development of the service sector contributes to an increase in national income, is a determining factor in ensuring a decent quality of life for the population. High quality and variety of services increases the productivity of workers, reduces the costs of consumption, contributes to saving time, improves the efficiency of leisure.

In January - June of 2018, according to preliminary data, the volume of rendered market services was equal to 66562.9 billion sums. The growth rate, compared with the same period last year, amounted to 107.6%. In the total volume of rendered market services, the largest volume is accounted for transport services (20132.9 billion sums).

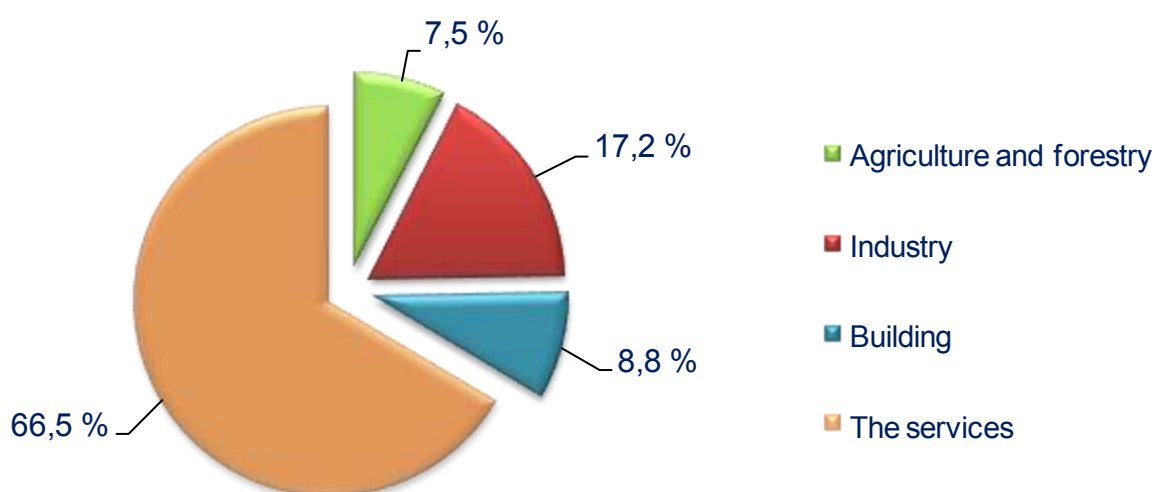
Comparison of production volumes of services, billion sums



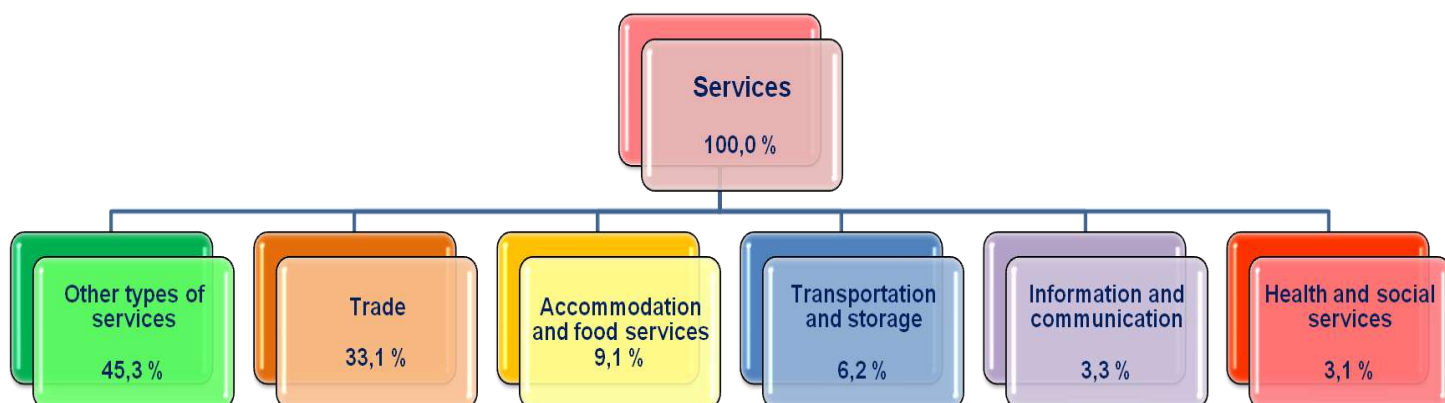
Along with this, the volumes of trade services increased (18321.5 billion soums), financial services (9298.1 billion soums), communication services and informatization (4535.1 billion soums).

At present, 203,700 organizations and enterprises are involved in the service sector. The share of organizations and services in the total number of organizations and enterprises was 66.5%.

Share of operating organizations and service companies in the total number of organizations and enterprises for January-June of 2018 (excluding farmer and dekhkan farms),%

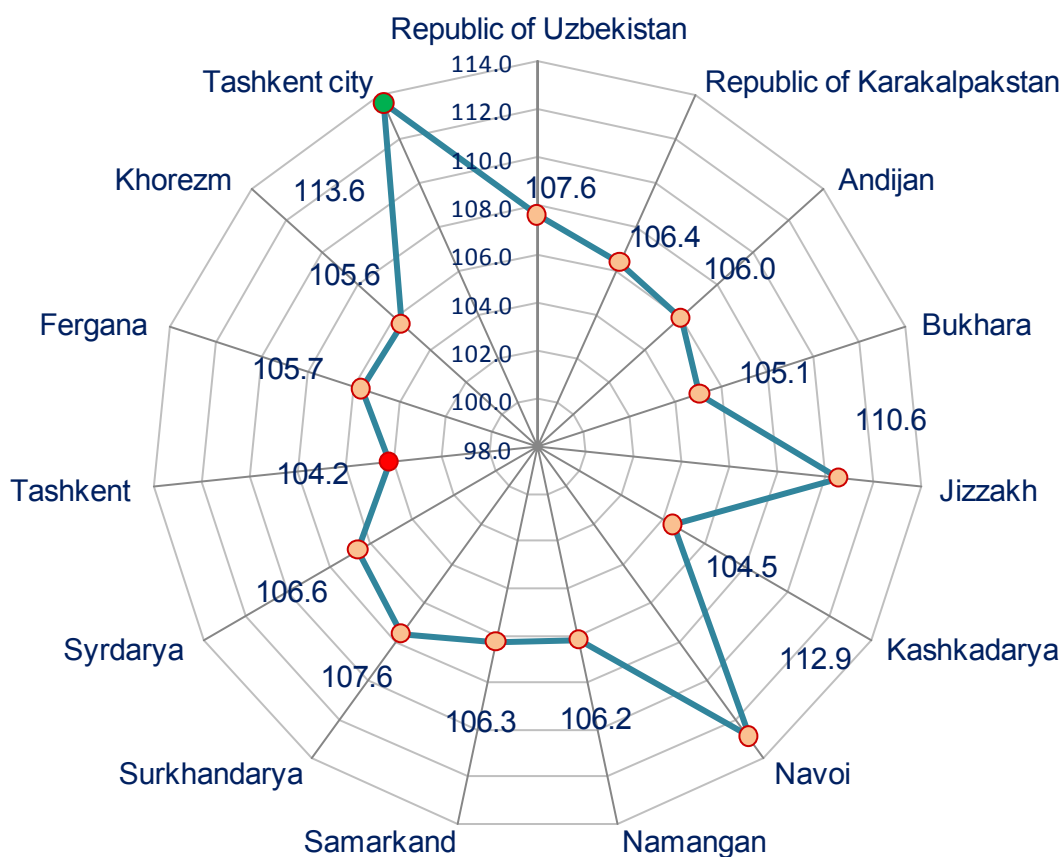


Structure of operating organizations and service enterprises by types of economic activity in January-June 2018, %



In January-June of 2018, compared to the same period last year, the highest growth rates were registered in Tashkent (113.6%), Navoi (112.9%), Jizzakh (110.6%), Surkhandarya (107.6) regions.

Low growth rates were observed in Tashkent (104.2%), Kashkadarya (104.5%), Bukhara (105.1%), Khorezm (105.6%), Ferghana (105.7%).

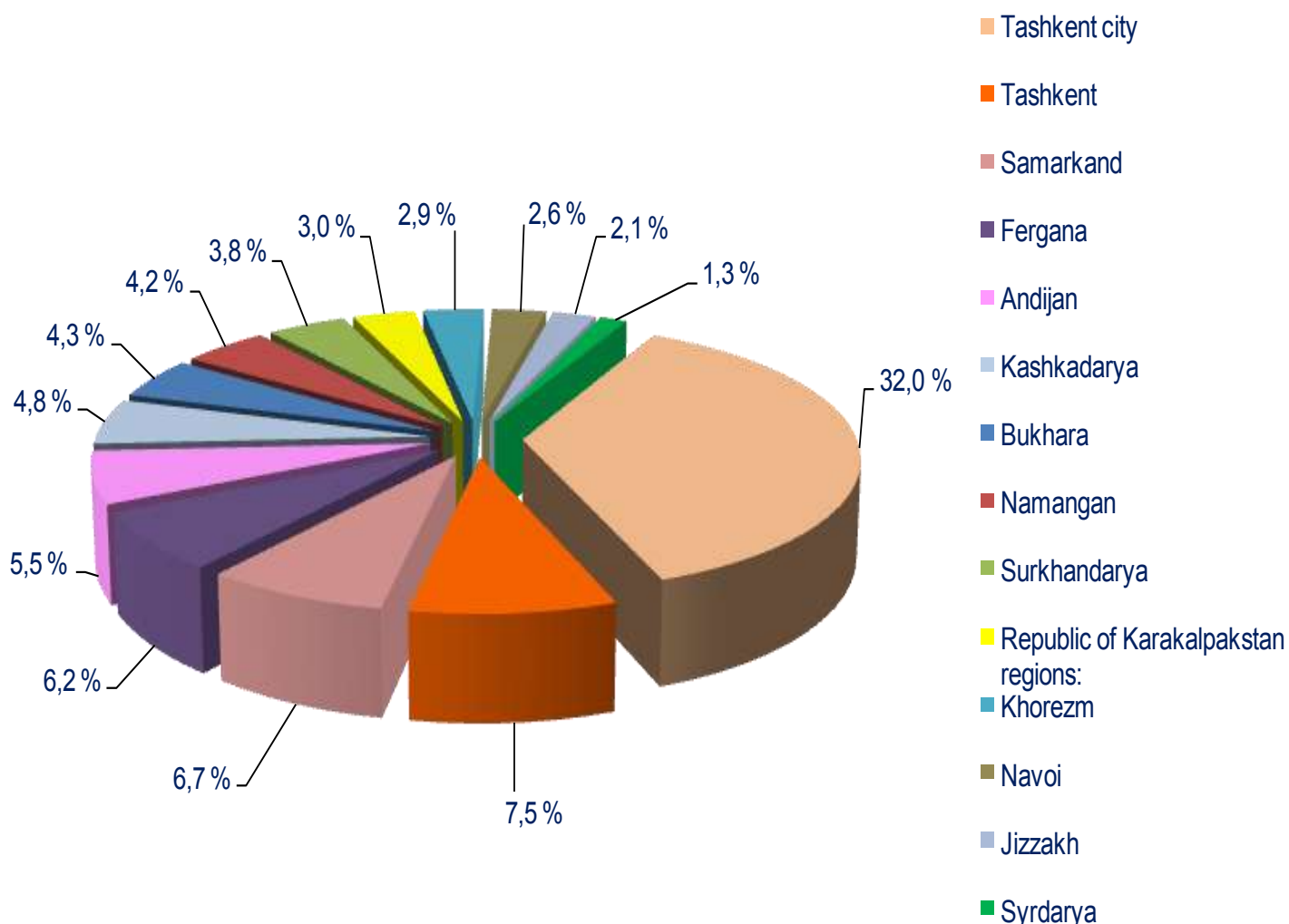

Among the regions, the largest volume is in Tashkent (21316.6 billion soums), the Tashkent region (4,980.3 billion soums).

The smallest volume is observed in the Syrdarya (866.6 billion soums), Jizzakh (1411.2 billion soums) regions.

Among the regions the leading place is located in Tashkent. The share of Tashkent city occupies 32.0% of the total volume of market services rendered. Along with this, the largest share in the total volume of services by regions are Tashkent (7.5%), Samarkand (6.7%), Fergana (6.2%), Andijan (5.5%) regions.

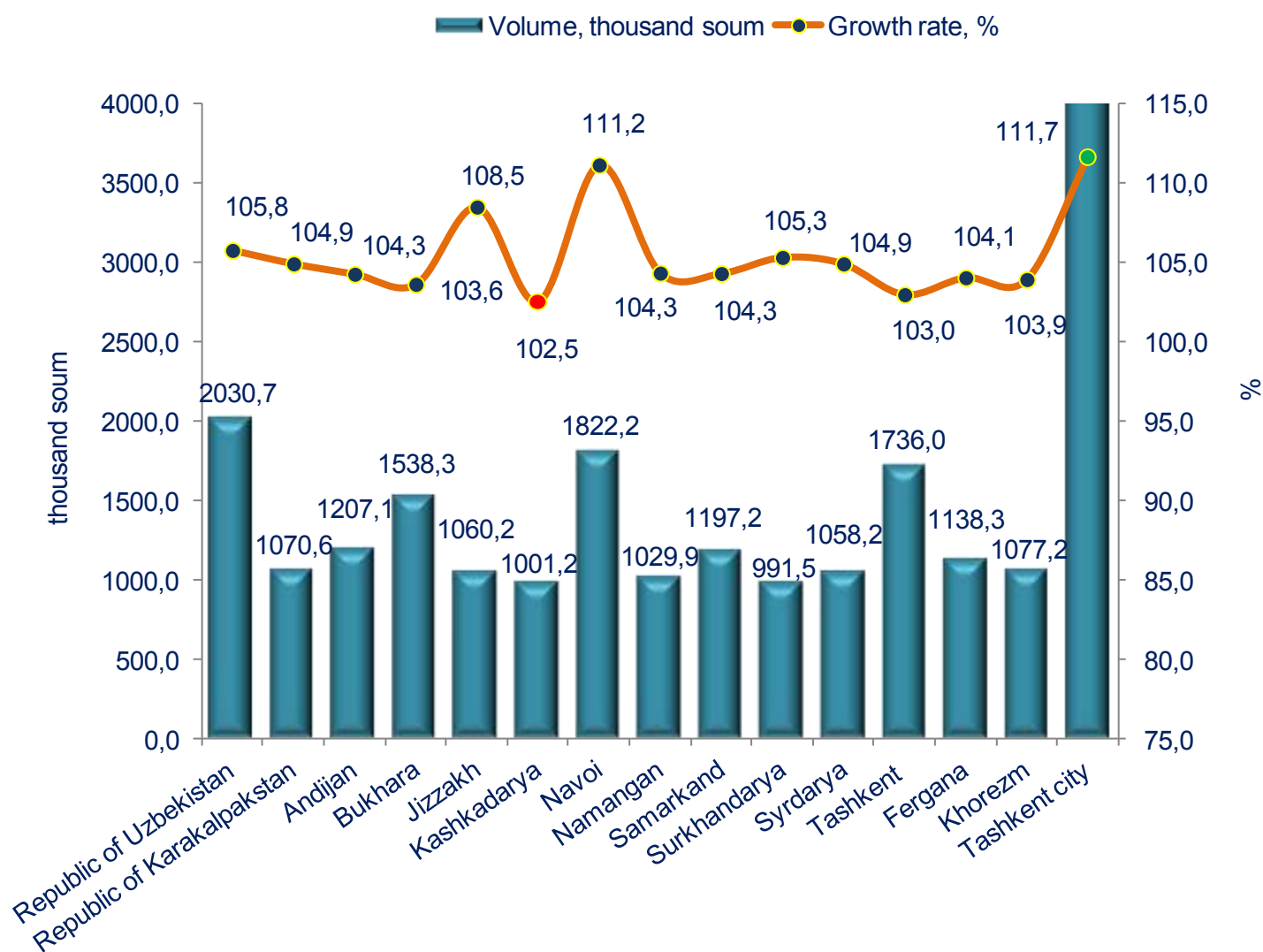
**The share of the region in the republic in january-june 2018

The lowest relative density, in comparison with other regions, was recorded in the Syrdaryo (1.3%), Jizzakh (2.1%), Navoi (2.6%), Khorezm (2.9%) and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3, 0%).

In January-June 2018, the volume of market services provided per capita was 2030,7 thousand soums. The growth rate, compared with last year, amounted to 105.8%.

Average per capita indicators by region for January - June 2018

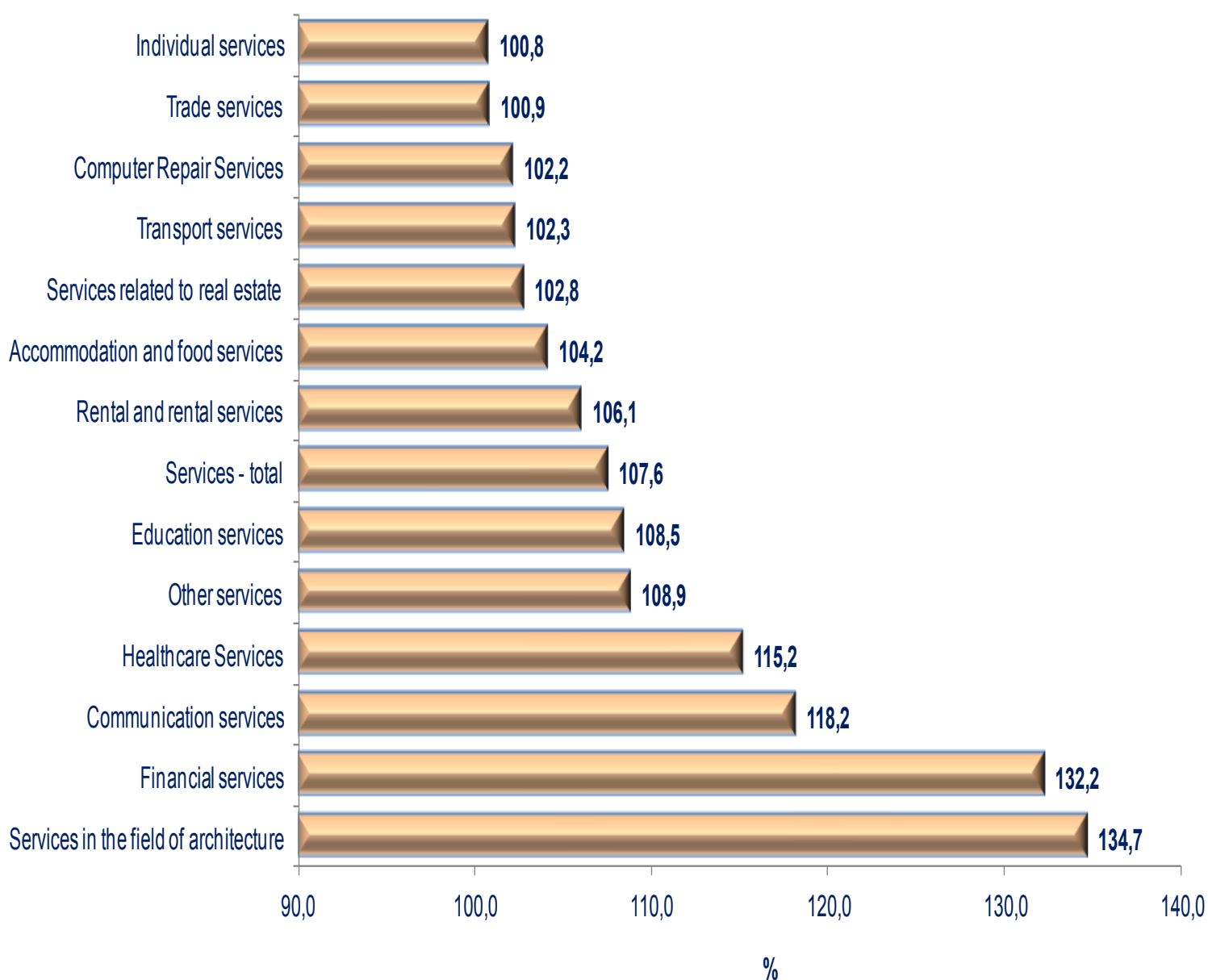


The highest rates for services provided per capita were registered in the city of Tashkent - 8611.4 thousand soums. Compared to January-June of 2017, the growth was 11.7%.

The lowest volume of services per capita is observed in the Surkhandaryya region - 991.5 thousand soums, with growth rates of 105.3%.

In January-June of 2018, the growth of such types of services by types economic activity, as services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys, technical testing and analysis (34.7%), financial services (32.2%), communication and information services (18.2%), services in the health sector (15.2%).

Growth rates of market services provided by types of economic activity in January-June 2018, %

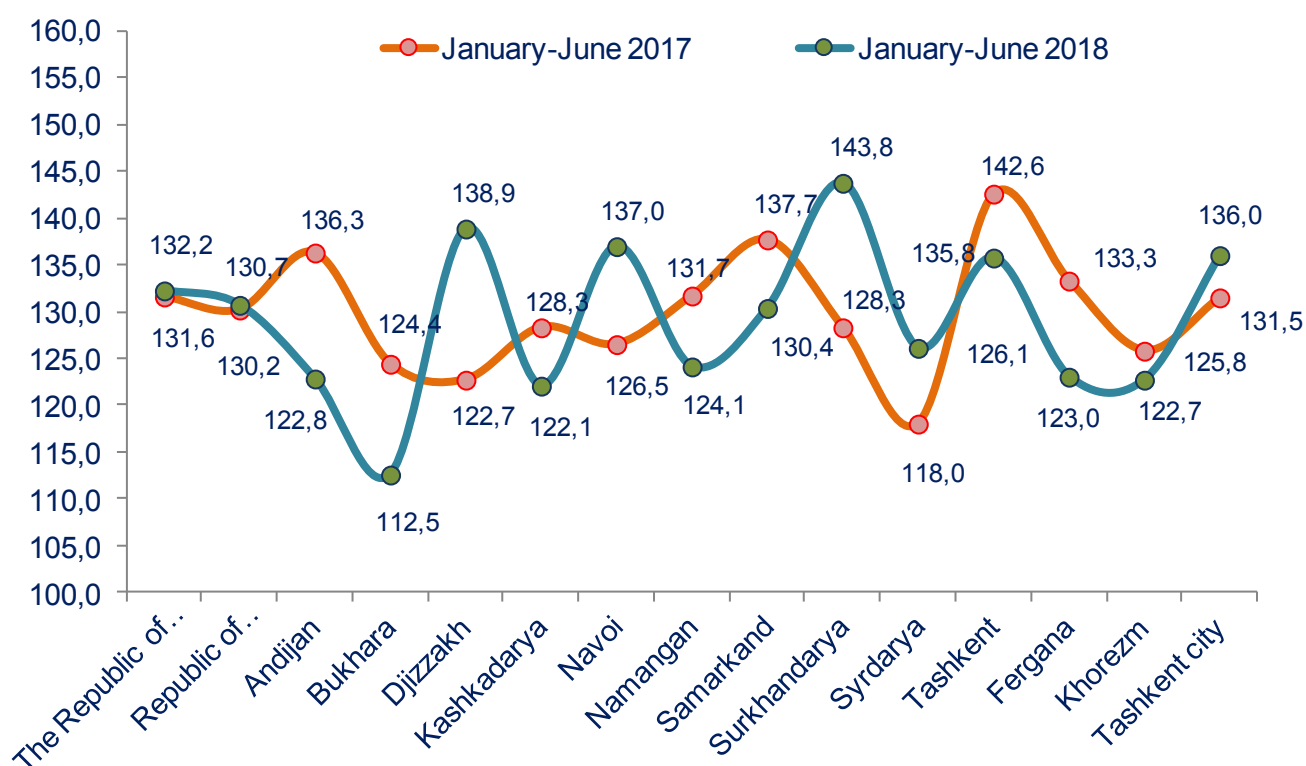


For comparison, in January-June 2017, the growth rate of services in the area architecture, engineering surveys, technical testing and analysis accounted for 106.6%, financial services - 131.6%, communication and information services - 116.2%, healthcare services - 114.7%.

Consistent measures to reform the financial and banking system are an important factor in the sustainable development of the economy, ensuring employment and well-being of the population.

An increase in the growth rate of financial services is observed in Surkhandarya (143.8%), Djizakh (138.9%), Navoi (137.0%), Tashkent (135.8%) regions and Tashkent (136.0%).

The lowest growth rates for financial services, compared to with other regions, were noted in Bukhara (112.5%), Kashkadarya (122.1%), Khorezm (122.7%), Andijan (122.8%), the Fergana (123.0%) regions. .

Today the autonomy of transport is ensured in the republic and a national system has been created linking all the regions of the republic with each other. Along with this, the transport system serves as a factor for the development of foreign economic relations and integration with other countries.

The leading place in the total volume of transport services is occupied by services rendered by motor transport (48.3%).

The services rendered by railway transport in the total volume of transport services occupy 14.9%. The share of services for transportation of goods and passengers by air is 10.6% of the total volume of transport services. Subsidiary transport activities occupy 7.3% of the total volume of transport services.

In the structure of services provided by road transport, The largest share is in Tashkent (16.7%), Tashkent (13.7%) and Samarkand (11.8%).

The lowest rates were registered in the Syrdarya (1.6%), Djizzakh (2.7%), Navoi (2.8%) oblasts and the Republic Karakalpakstan (3.3%).
