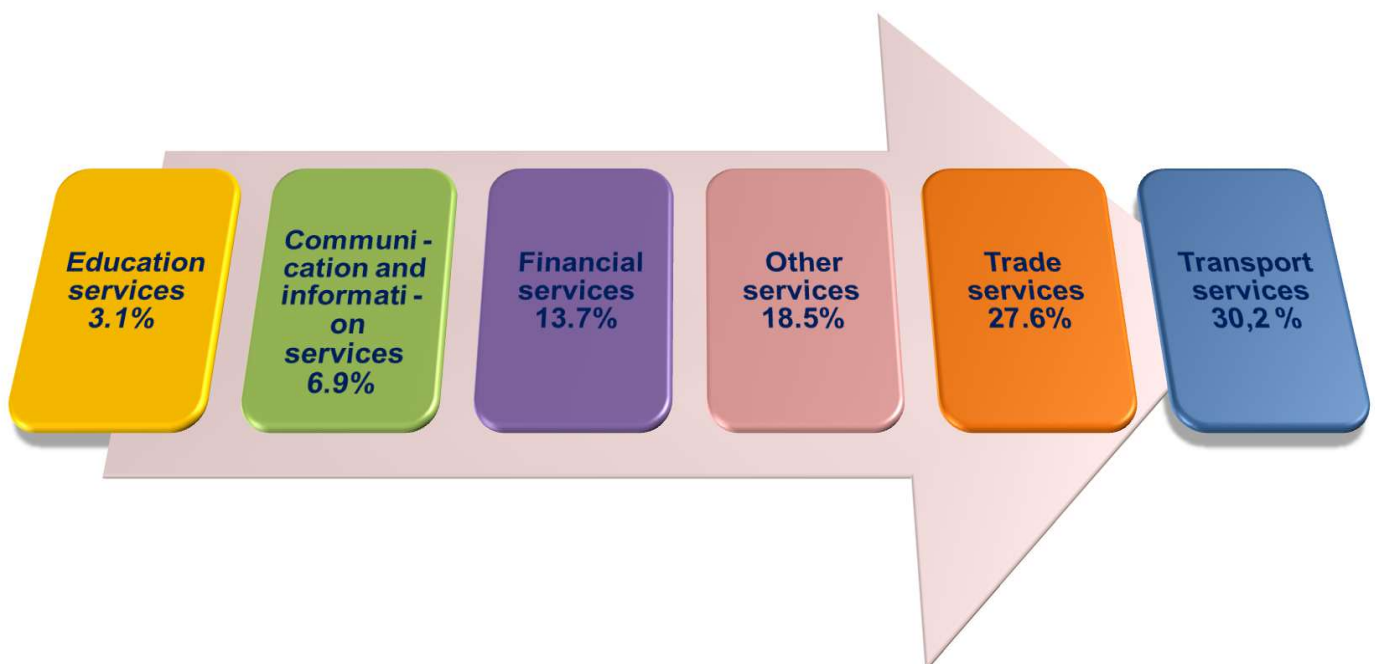
- The volume of market services for January-May 2018 was 54,498.0 billion soums.
- The growth rate of financial services was 129.4%.
- The volume of market services per capita was 1666.1 thousand Soums.

Conducting targeted integrated measures to introduce innovative and improve the quality of traditional services leads to an increase in the share of services in the country's economy.

In January-May 2018, according to preliminary data, the volume of rendered market services was 54498.0 billion soums.

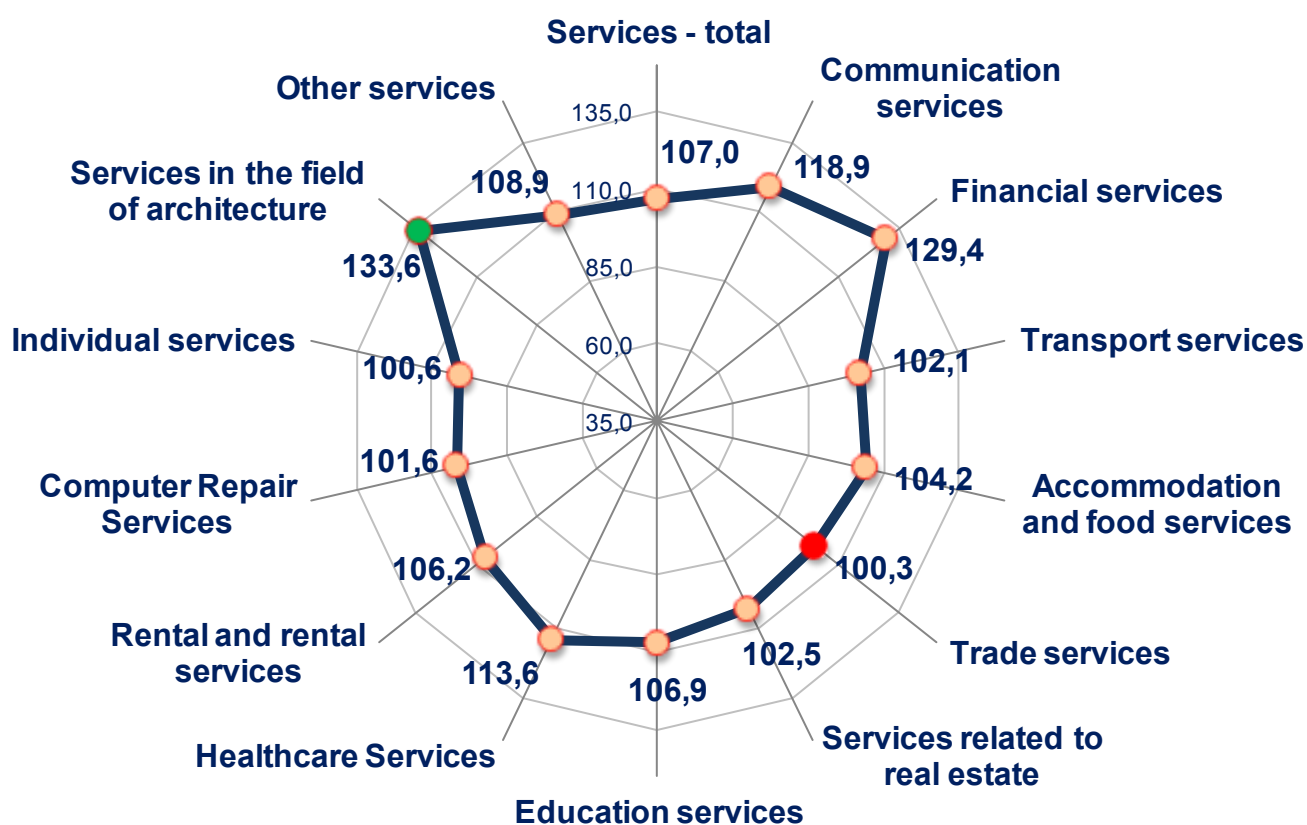
Compared to the same period last year, the growth rate was 107.0%. In the total volume of rendered market services, the largest share is transport services (30.2 %).

Currently, fast-growing types of services include ICT services and credit and financial institutions. Relying on new technologies and the results of market liberalization, these activities have recently taken a new turn in development and now play a decisive role in the technological progress of society and the globalization of the economy.

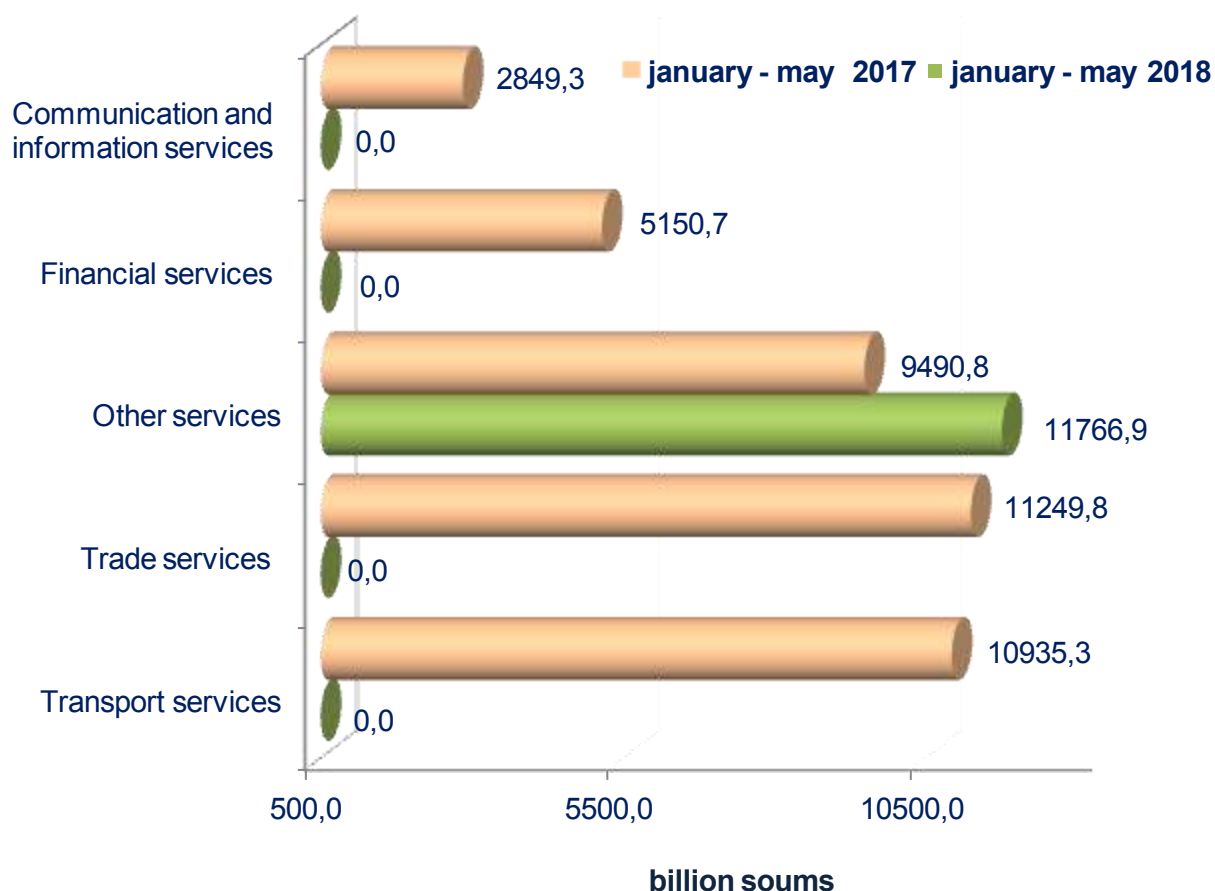
Rates of growth of market services by types of economic activity for January-May 2018,%



In January-May 2018, compared to the same period last year, the highest growth rates were achieved for services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys, technical testing and analysis (133.6%); financial services (129.4%); communication and information services (118.9%); services in the field of health (113.6%)

Transport services occupy the largest volume in the total volume of rendered market services - 16,479.2 billion soums. This is due to the high demand for this type of services in such diverse sectors as industry, construction, foreign and domestic trade, agriculture, tourism and etc

Along with this, compared with the same period last year, there was an increase in the volume of trade services - 15025.4 billion soums financial services - 7492.0 billion soums, communication and information services - 3734.5 billion soums

The largest share in the total volume of transport services is provided by services provided by road transport (48.3%). Transportation services by pipeline account for 18.5% of the total transport services.

Structure of transport services by mode of transport for January-May 2018,%



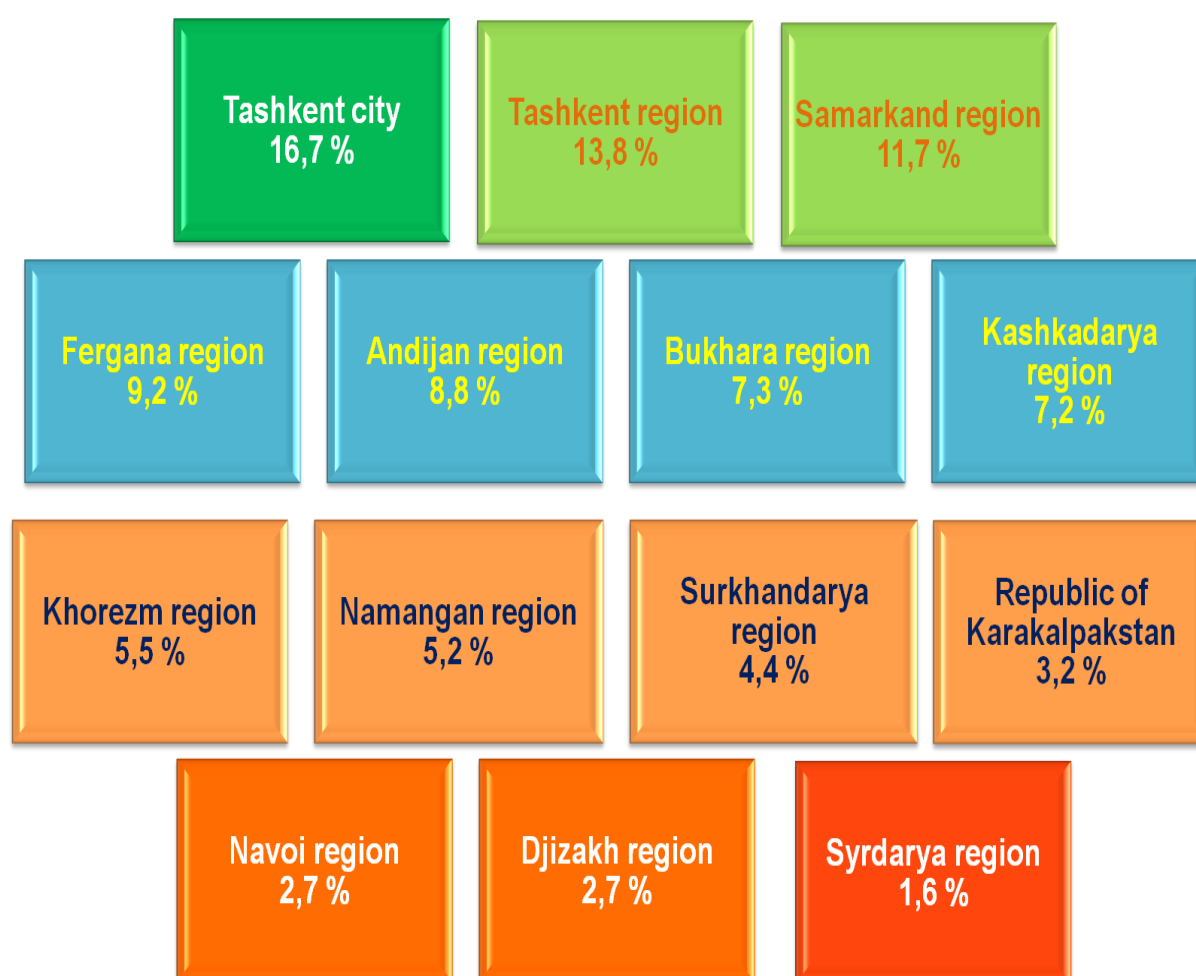
The services rendered by railway transport in the total volume of transport services make up 15.3 %.

The share of services for the transportation of goods and passengers by air reached 10.6% of the total volume of transport services.

Subsidiary transport activity occupies 7.3% of the total volume of transport services

Transport plays a huge role in the economic development of the country. At present, due to the maneuverability and relatively low cost of the services provided, compared to other modes of transport, the automobile mode of transport is one of the most demanded services

**The structure of services provided by road transport,
by regions in January-May 2018,%**



In the structure of services provided by road transport, the largest share is in Tashkent city (16.7%), Tashkent (13.8%) and Samarkand (11.7%) regions.

The lowest indicators were recorded in the Syrdarya (1.6%), Jizzakh (2.7%), Navoi (2.7%) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.2%).

In January-May 2018, the growth rate of financial services, compared with the same period last year, reached 129.4%.

An increase in the growth rate of financial services is observed in Surkhandarya (140.5%), Djizak (136.7%), Tashkent (136.2%), Navoi (135.5%) regions and Tashkent (131.3%).

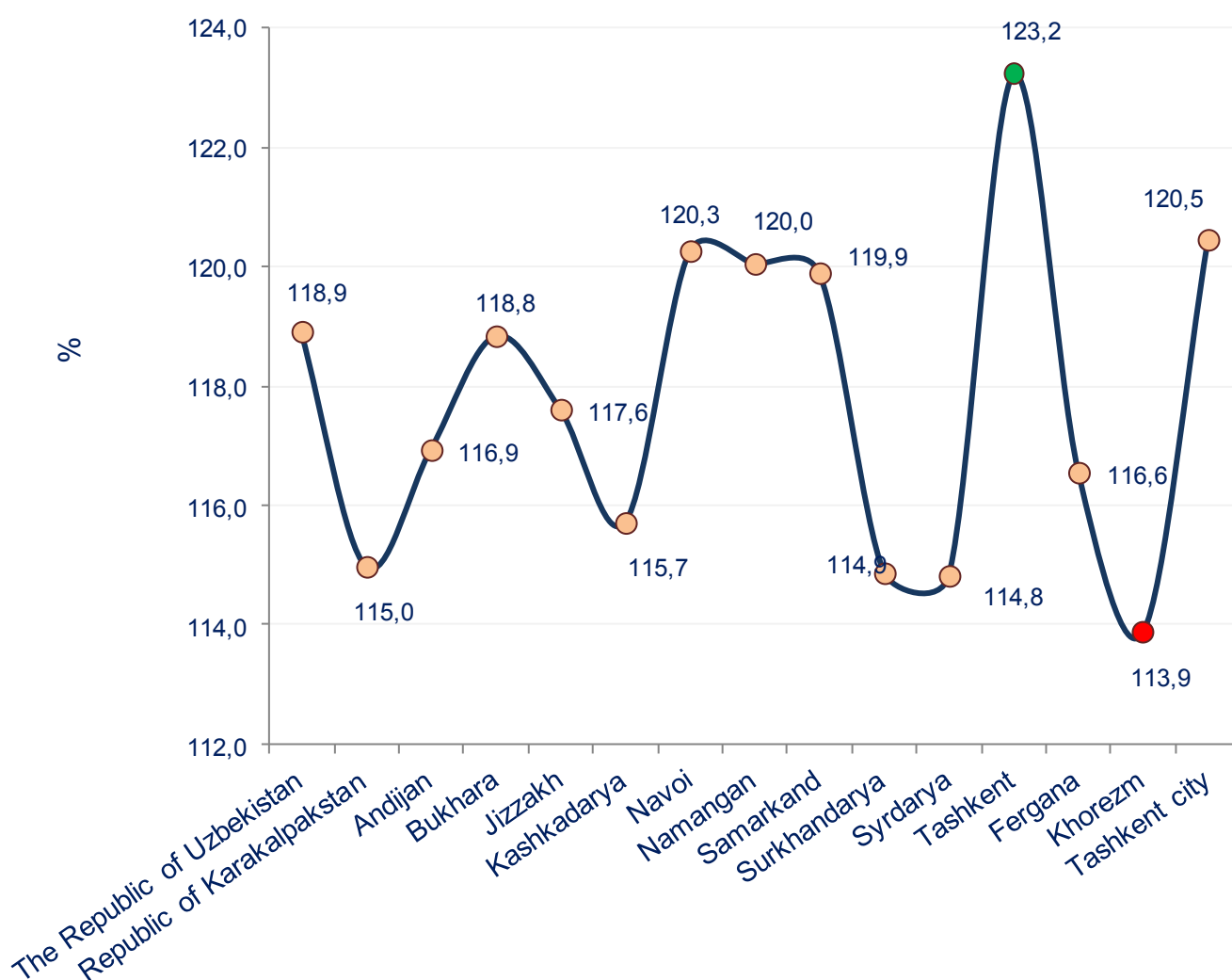

The lowest growth rates for financial services, compared to with other regions, were noted in Bukhara (115.6%), Khorezm (120.7%), Andijan (121.2%) Namangan (121.7%), Fergana (122.7%) regions.

In terms of regions, the highest growth rates for communication services and Informatization are observed in Tashkent (123.2%), Navoi (120.3%), Namangan (120.0%), Samarkand (119.9%), Bukhara (118.8%) and Djizak (117.6%) regions, as well as in Tashkent city (120.5%).

Growth rates for communication and information services for January-May 2018,%



Relatively low growth rates for communication services and informatization were recorded in Khorezm (113.9%), Syrdarya (114.8%), Surkhandarya (114.9%), Kashkadarya (115.7%) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (115.0%).

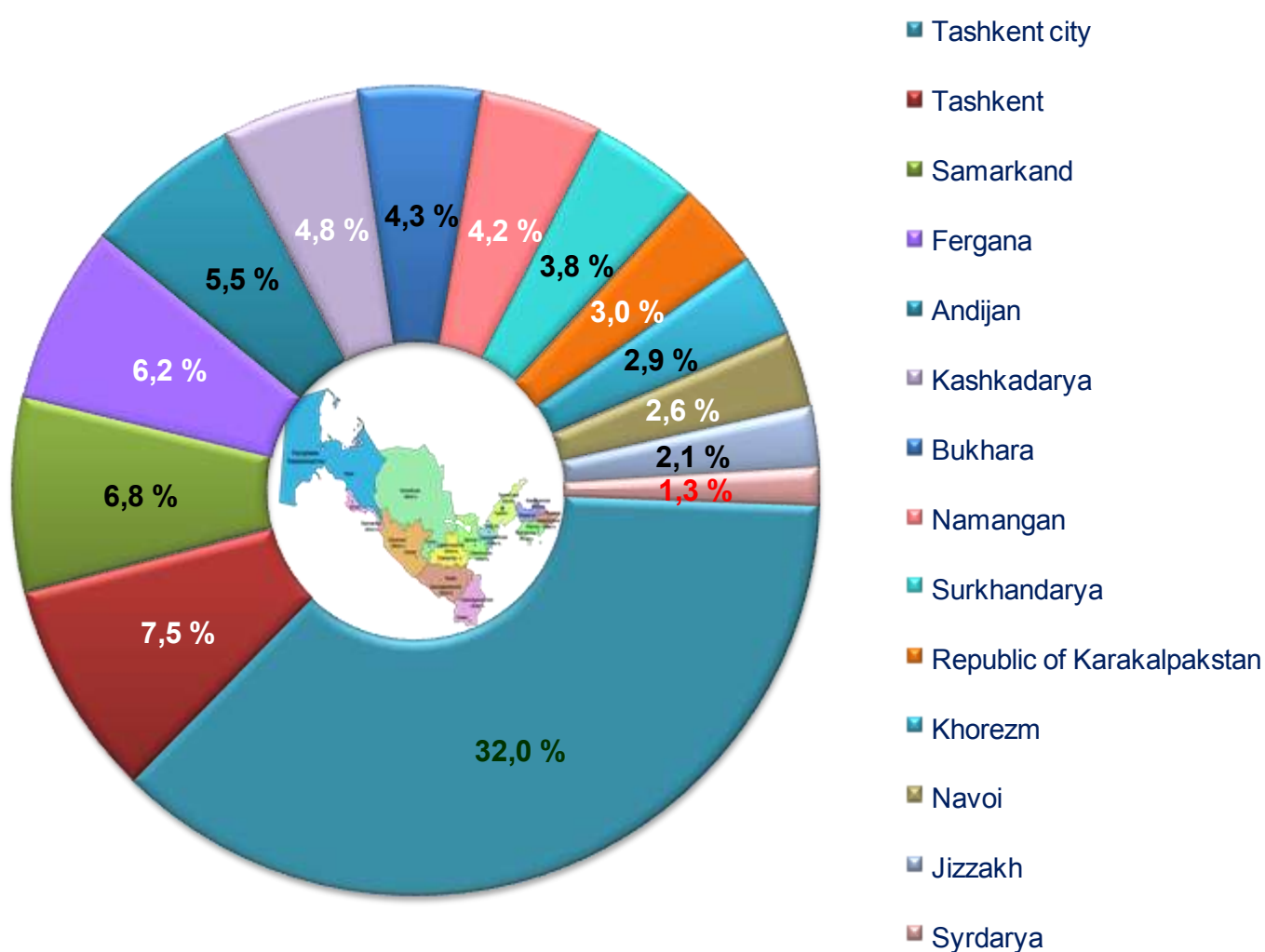

Among the regions, the largest volume is in Tashkent (17451.7 billion soums), the Tashkent region (4,078.1 billion soums).

The smallest volume is observed in the Syrdarya (707.7 billion soums), Djizak (1129.9 billion soums) regions.

Among the regions the leading place is located in Tashkent. The share of Tashkent occupies 32.0% of the total volume of market services rendered. At the same time, the largest share in the total volume of services by regions are Tashkent (7.5%), Samarkand (6.8%), Fergana (6.2%), Andijan (5.5%) regions.

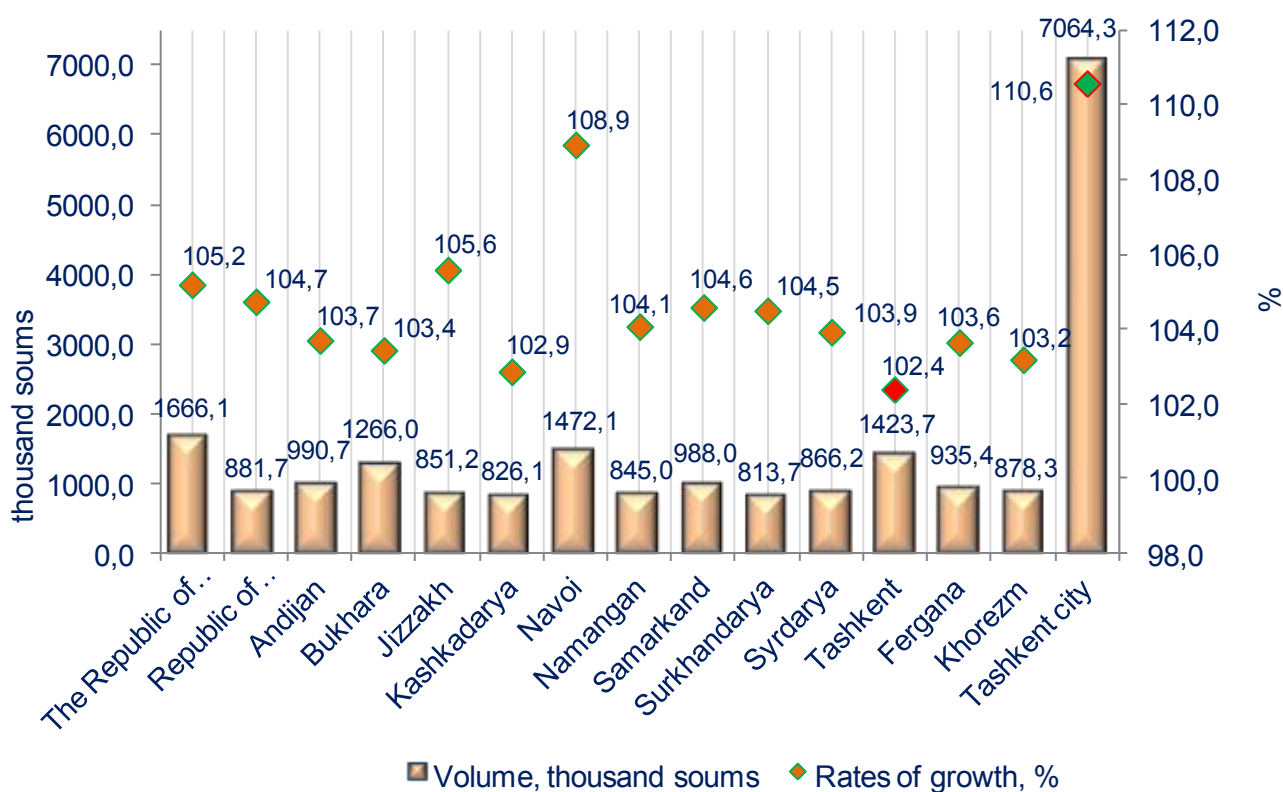
The share of the region in the total volume of services in the country for January-May 2018,%



Among the regions, the smallest share to Syrdarya (1.3%), Djizak (2.1%), Navoi (2.6%), Khorezm (2.9%) and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.0%).

In January-May 2018, the volume of market services provided per capita was equal to 1666.1 thousand Soum. Growth rate, compared to with the previous year, amounted to 105.2%.

Average per capita indicators by region for January - May 2018



The highest rates of service per capita of the population were registered in Tashkent - 7064.3 thousand Soums. Compared with January - May 2017, the growth was 110.6%. The lowest volume of services per capita is observed in Surkhandarya region - 813.7 thousand soums, here the growth rate was 104.5%.
