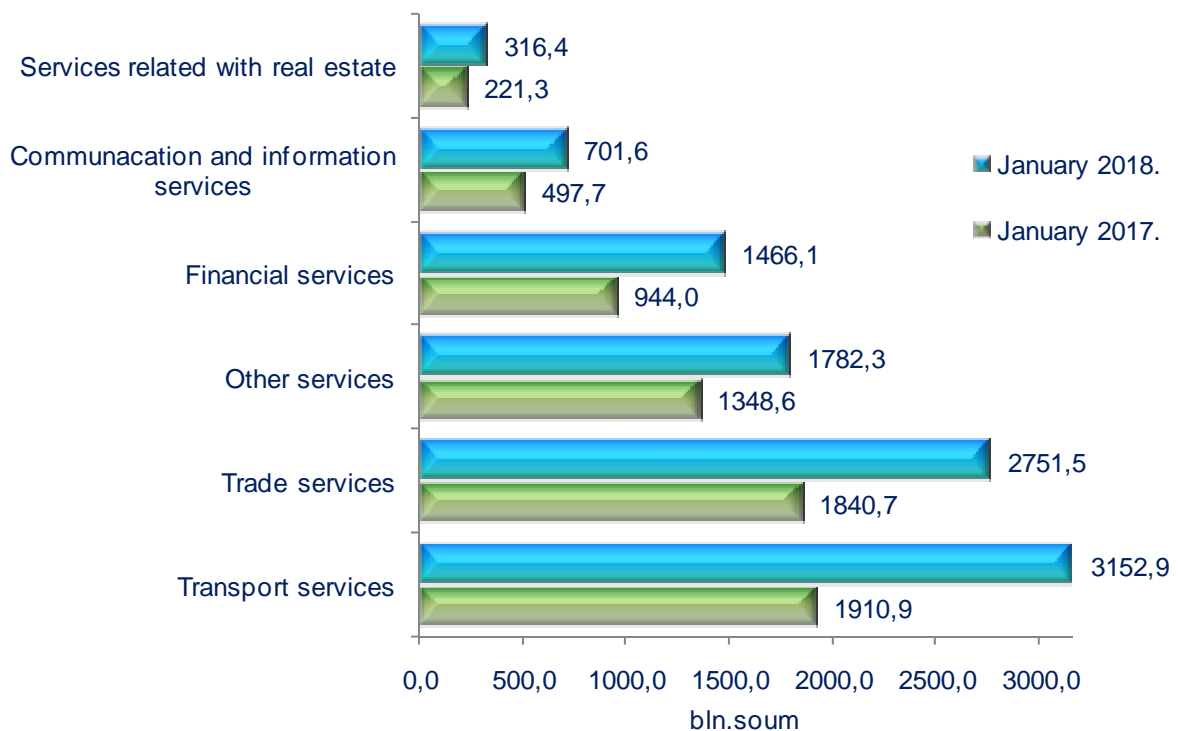
- In January 2018 the volume of market services was 10170,8 billion soums.
- Growth rate of services sector in the city of Tashkent has reached 114,5%.
- Volume of market services per capita was 314,0 thousand soums.

In January 2018 the volume of market services was 10170,8 billion soums and reached by 10,5%.

The largest volume falls on transportation services (3152,9 billion soums), trade services (2751,5 billion soums), financial services (1466,1 billion soums), communication and information services (701,6 billion soums).

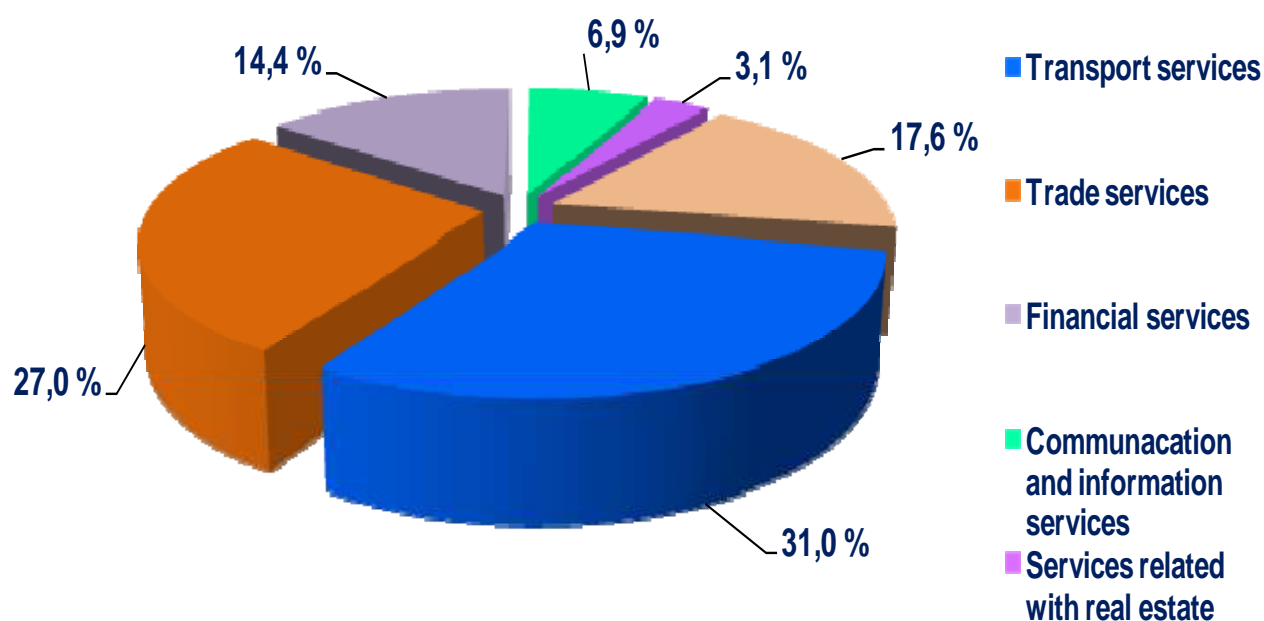
The largest share in the total volume of services is observed in the city of Tashkent, Tashkent region, Samarkand region, Fergana region, Andijan region and Kashkadarya region.

Transport services (31,0%), trade services (27,0%), financial services (14,4%), communication and information services (6,9%) prevail in the structure of services.

The structure of transport services is dominated by road transport services - 46,3 %. This is due to its mobility and relatively low cost of services

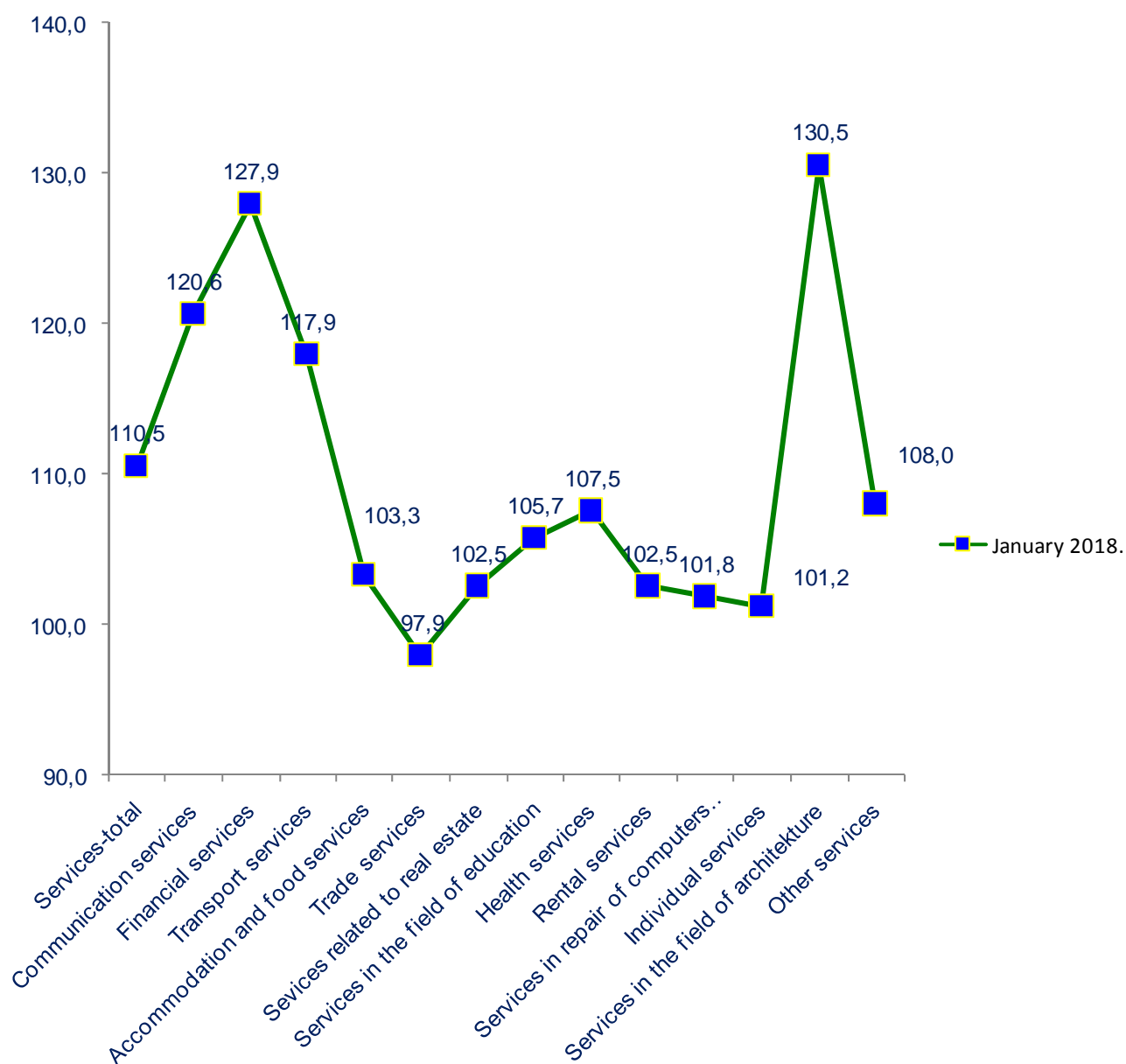
In the structure of trade services, retail trade prevails, except for motor vehicles and motorcycles - 67,1 %

The largest share in the volume of financial services is held by financial services, except for insurance and pension services (88,1%)

Today, information and communication technologies are involved in various spheres of the economy and everyday life of the population. In the total volume of communication and information services, telecommunications services account for the largest share (88,8%)

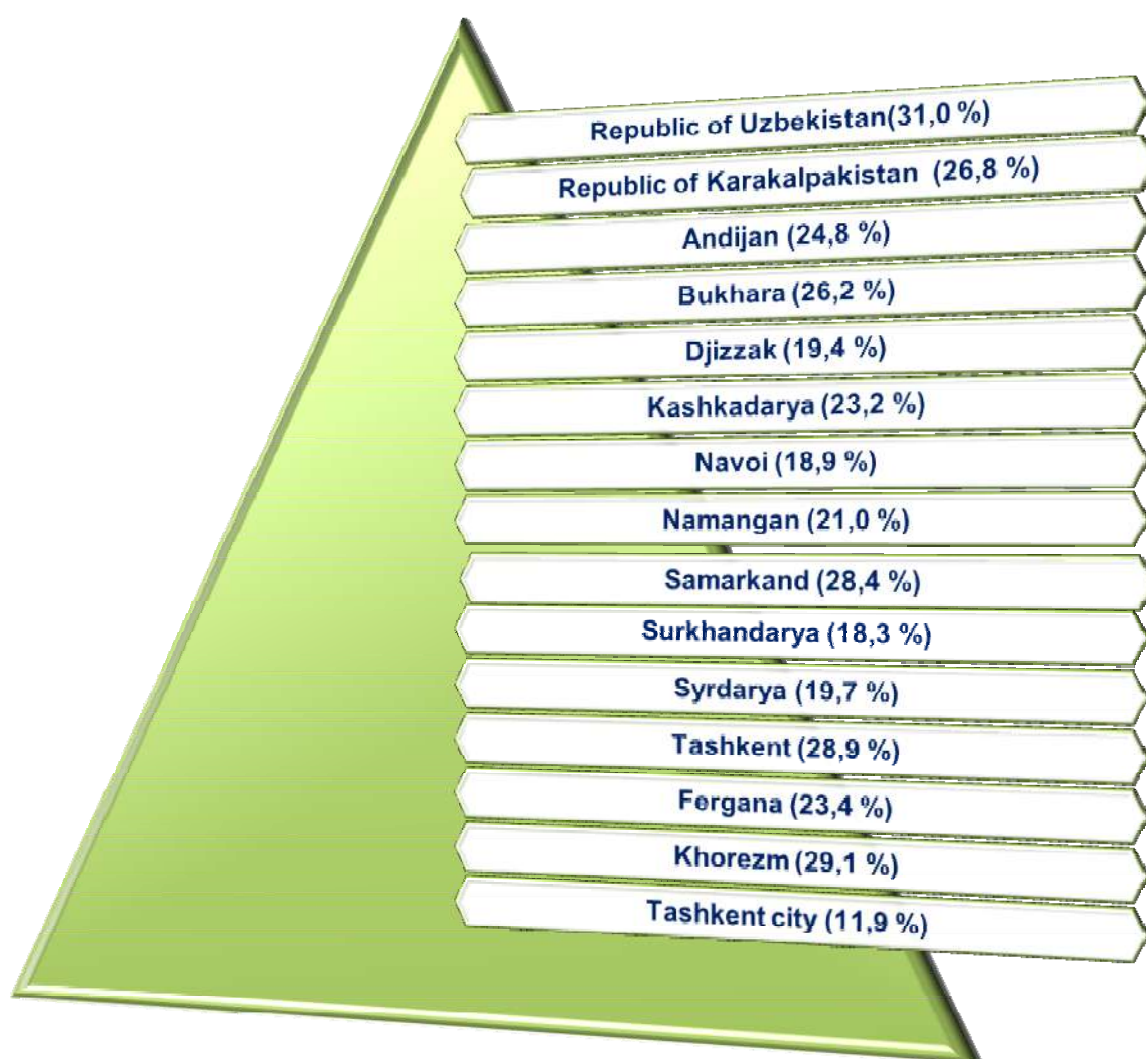
In January 2018, the highest growth rates were observed for services in the field of architecture, engineering surveys, technical testing and analysis (130,5%), as well as financial services (127,9%), communication and information services (120,6%), transport services (117,9%)

Growth rates of market services by types of economic activity in %January 2018, in percentage terms



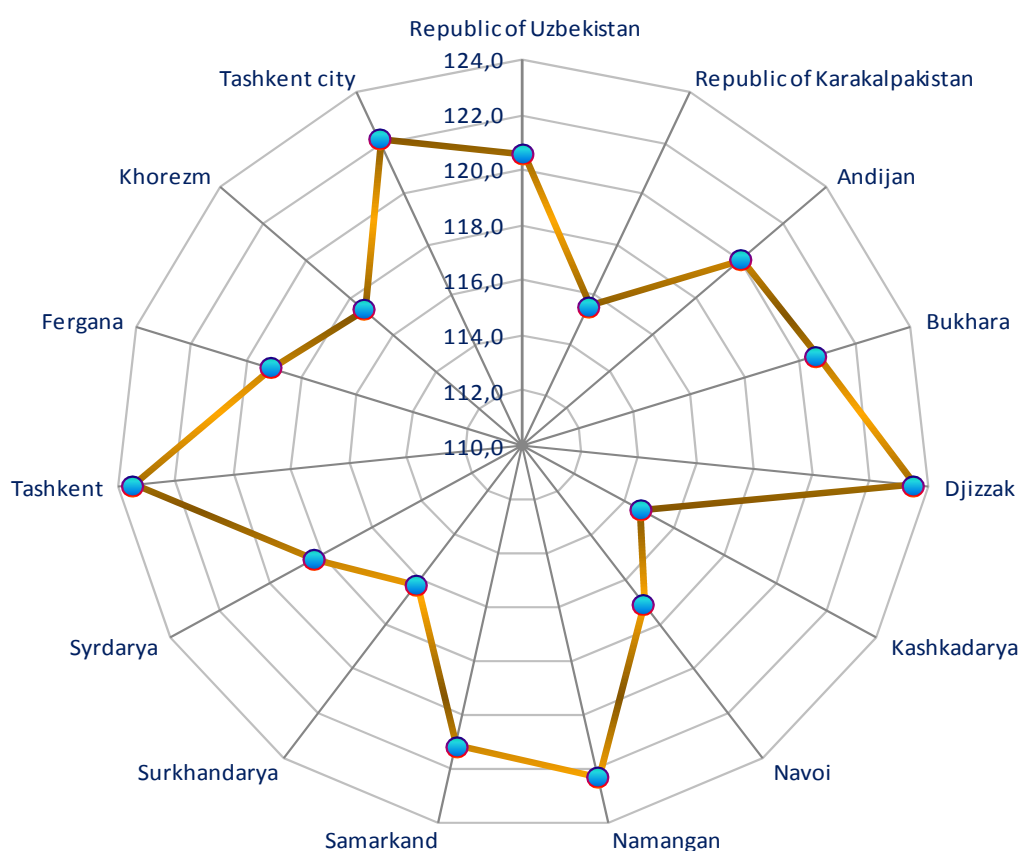
In the total volume of market services, transport services account for the largest share. "The main growth factors are new construction, the creation and expansion of industrial zones, the development of tourism, the development of logistics infrastructure

In the volume of communication and information services telecommunication services (mobile communication services, Internet, satellite communication services, etc.) have the largest share - 88.8% .

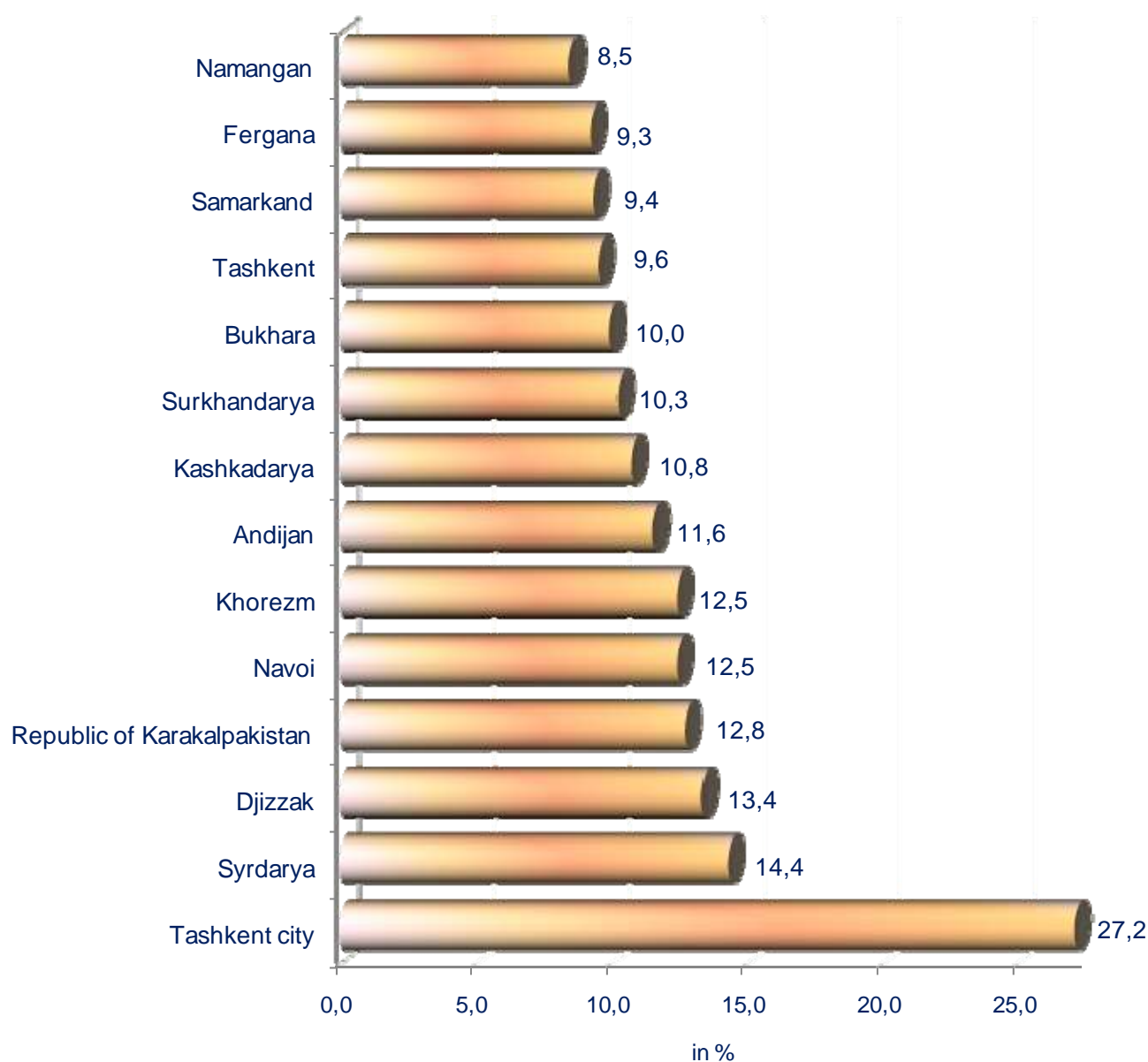
Growth rates of communication and information services by regions, in percentage terms



The largest share falls on the city of Tashkent (10.2%), the Republic of Karakalpakstan (8.9%), Syrdarya region (9.9%), Khorezm region (8.2%), Namangan region (7.9%), Fergana region (7.8%), Djizzak region (7.5%), Andizhan region (7.1%).

In January 2018 the growth of financial services reached 127.9% compared with the same period of the last year. The share of financial services in the total volume of market services was 14.4%.

Among the regions the largest volume is marked in the city of Tashkent (3249.6 billion soums) and Tashkent region (755.3 billion soums).

The lowest volume is observed in Syrdarya (128.6 billion soums) and Dzhizak region (211.0 billion soums).

The largest share in the development of the services sector is occupied by such regions as the city of Tashkent (31.9%), Tashkent region (7.4%), Samarkand region (6.6%), Fergana region (6.1%), Andizhan region (5.4% %), Kashkadarya region (4.8%).

In January 2018**



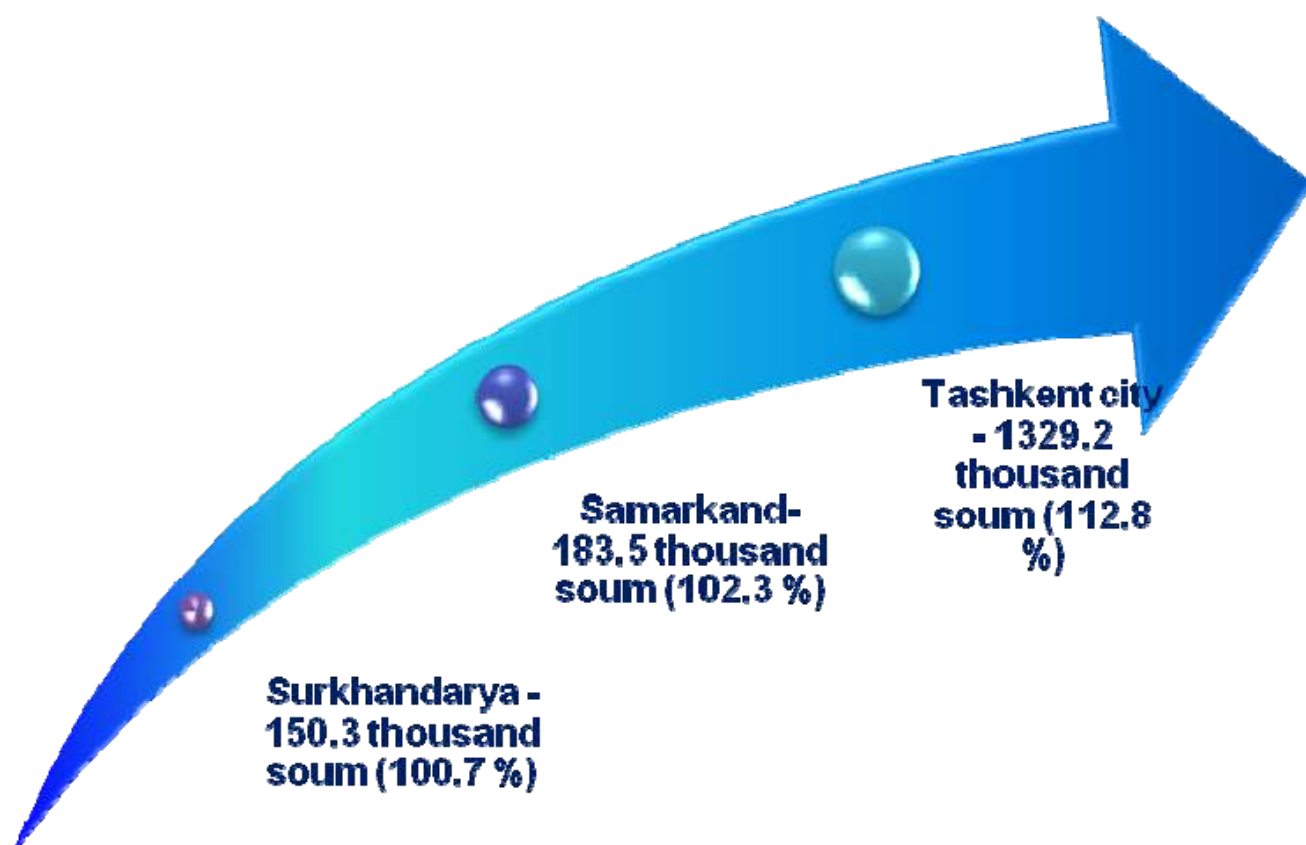
The smallest share in the total volume of services rendered is occupied by such regions as Syrdarya region (1.3%), Djizzak region (2.1%), Navoi region (2.5%), Khorezm region (2.9%) and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (2.9%).
