

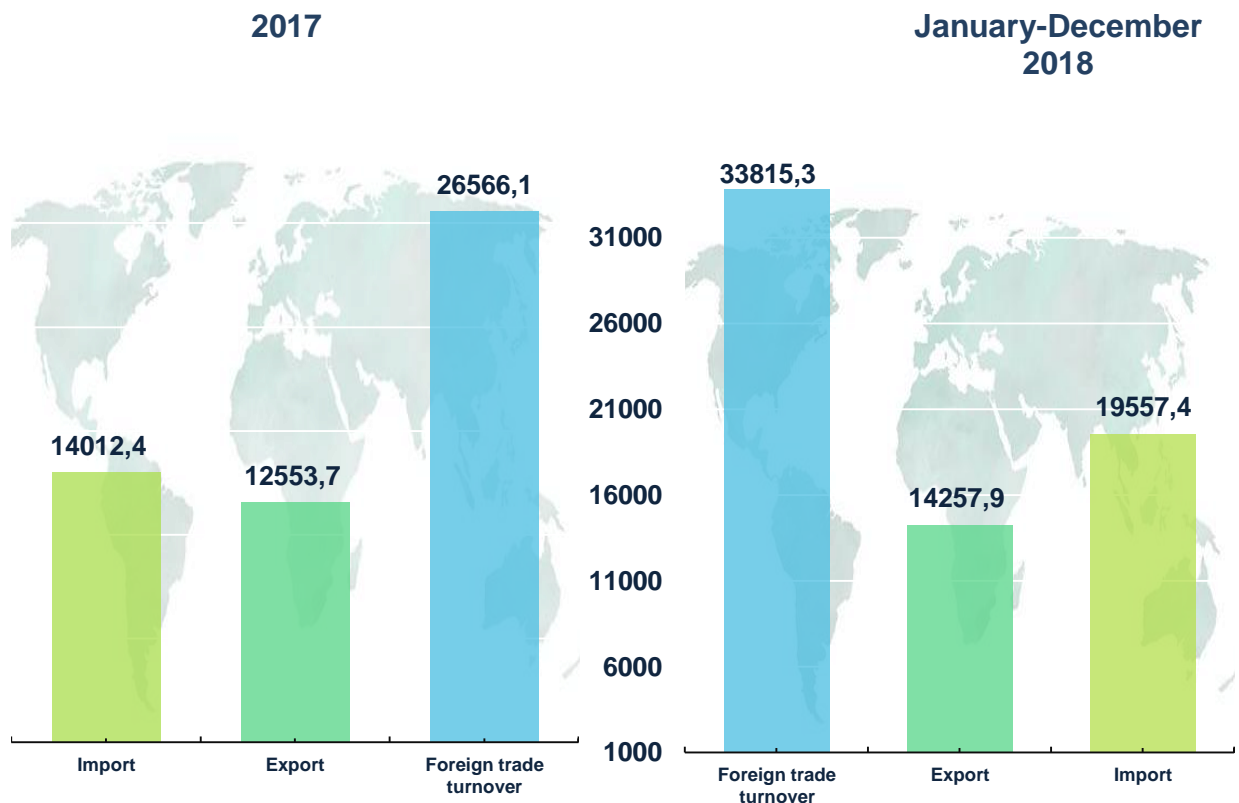
FOREIGN TRADE TURNOVER OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

(January-December 2018 *)

According to the results of January-December 2018, the foreign trade turnover of the republic amounted to 33815.3 million USD and increased, as compared with the same period last year, by 27.3 %. Exports amounted to 14257.9 million USD (growth rate - 13.6 %), import volume - 19557.4 million USD (growth rate - 39.6 %). The balance of foreign trade is minus 5299.5 million USD.

For reference: The data for the periods of 2017 and the first half of 2018 are recalculated taking into account the results of a sample survey of inbound and outbound tourism conducted in the second quarter of 2018.

Foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekista (million USD)

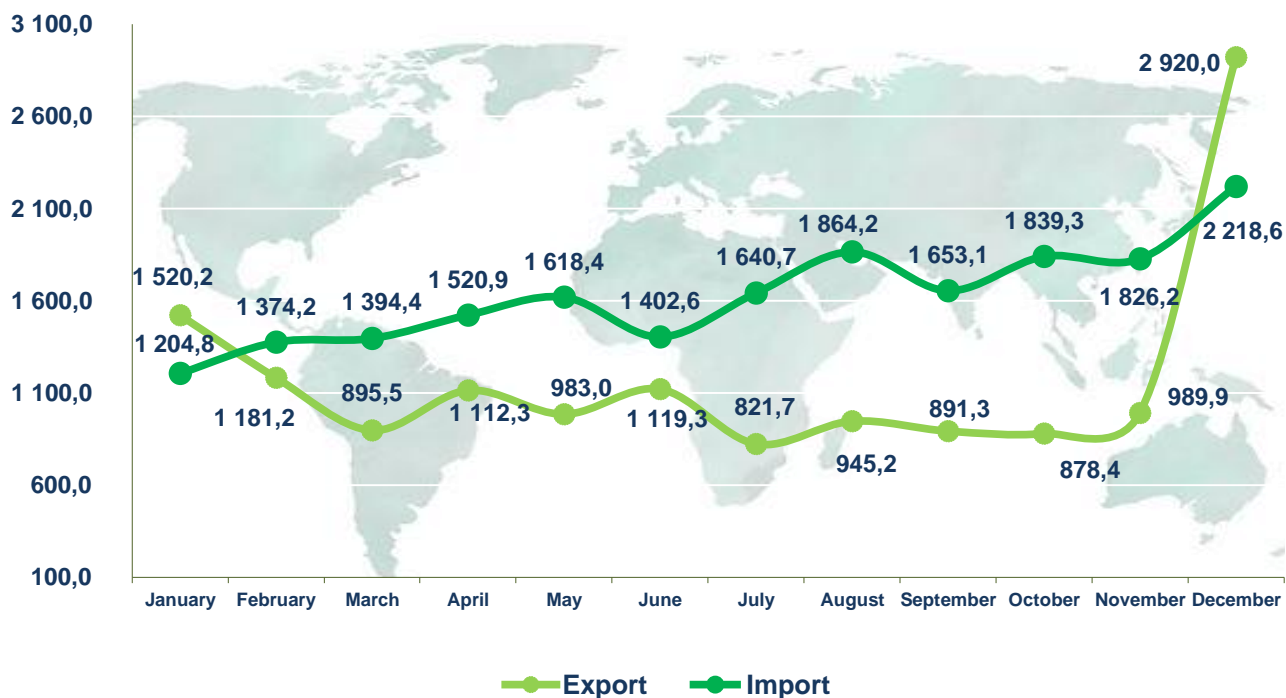


As a result of the increase in the production of products that replaced imported goods and the diversification of industrial production, significant changes have been achieved in the structure of exports.

It should be noted that in December 2018, exports of goods and services increased by 1930.0 million USD compared to November, while the volume of imports of goods and services also increased by 392.5 million USD.

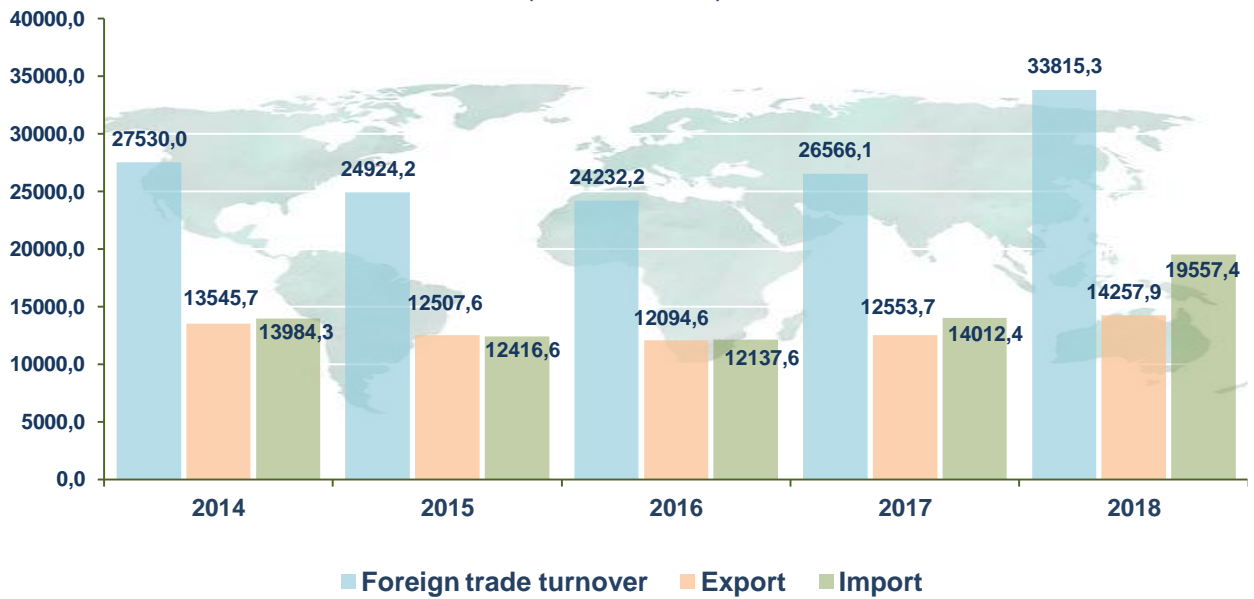

At the same time, it is aimed at integrating Uzbekistan into the world economy, occupying a worthy place in a number of developed countries of the world.

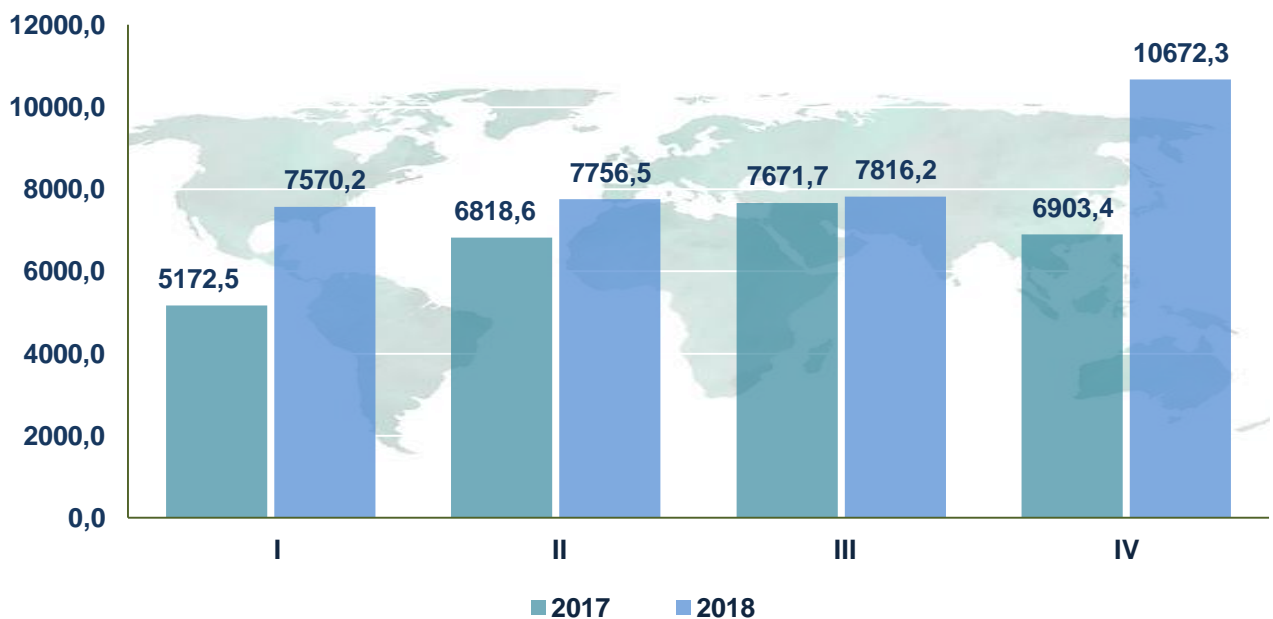
In January-December 2018, the number of enterprises engaged in the export of goods, compared with the same period last year, increased by 446 and their total number reached 3509 units.

Dynamics of foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan (million USD)



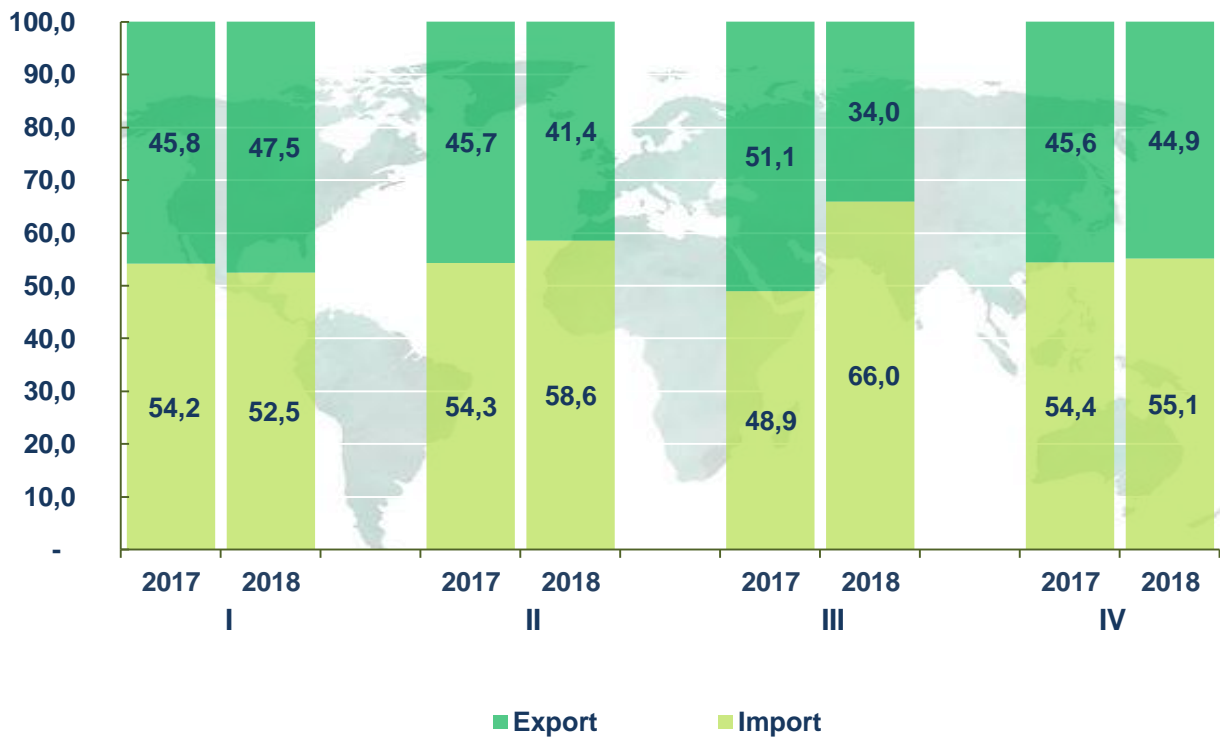
An analysis of the dynamics of the foreign trade turnover of the Republic of Uzbekistan showed an increase in exports and imports in 2018 compared with previous years.

Analysis of the dynamics of foreign trade turnover also showed an increase, and in the fourth quarter of 2018 it amounted to 10672.3 million USD, which increased by 3768.9 million USD compared to the same period of the previous year.

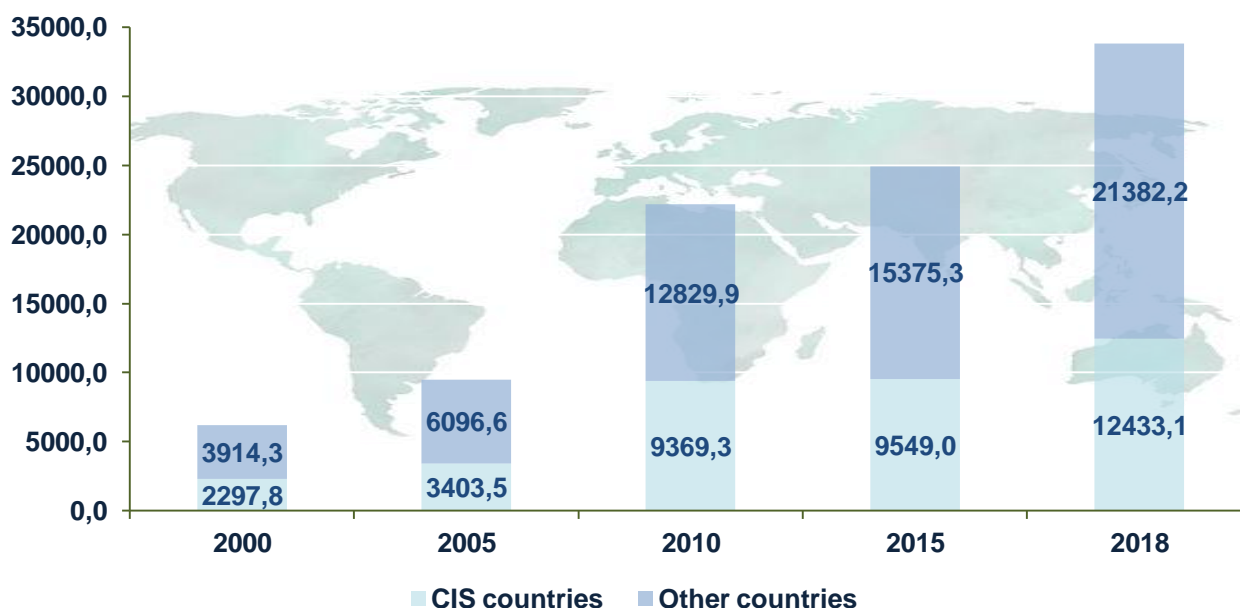
The share of exports and imports in foreign trade turnover

As a result of measures taken by the Government of the Republic to strengthen cooperation with the CIS countries and comprehensive support for foreign trade, the share of CIS countries in foreign trade in January-December 2018 amounted to 36.8 % and, compared to the same period last year, the growth rate of foreign trade turnover reached 136.9 %.

The share of other countries in foreign trade turnover in January-December 2018 decreased by 2.6 % compared with the same period last year and amounted to 63.2 %.

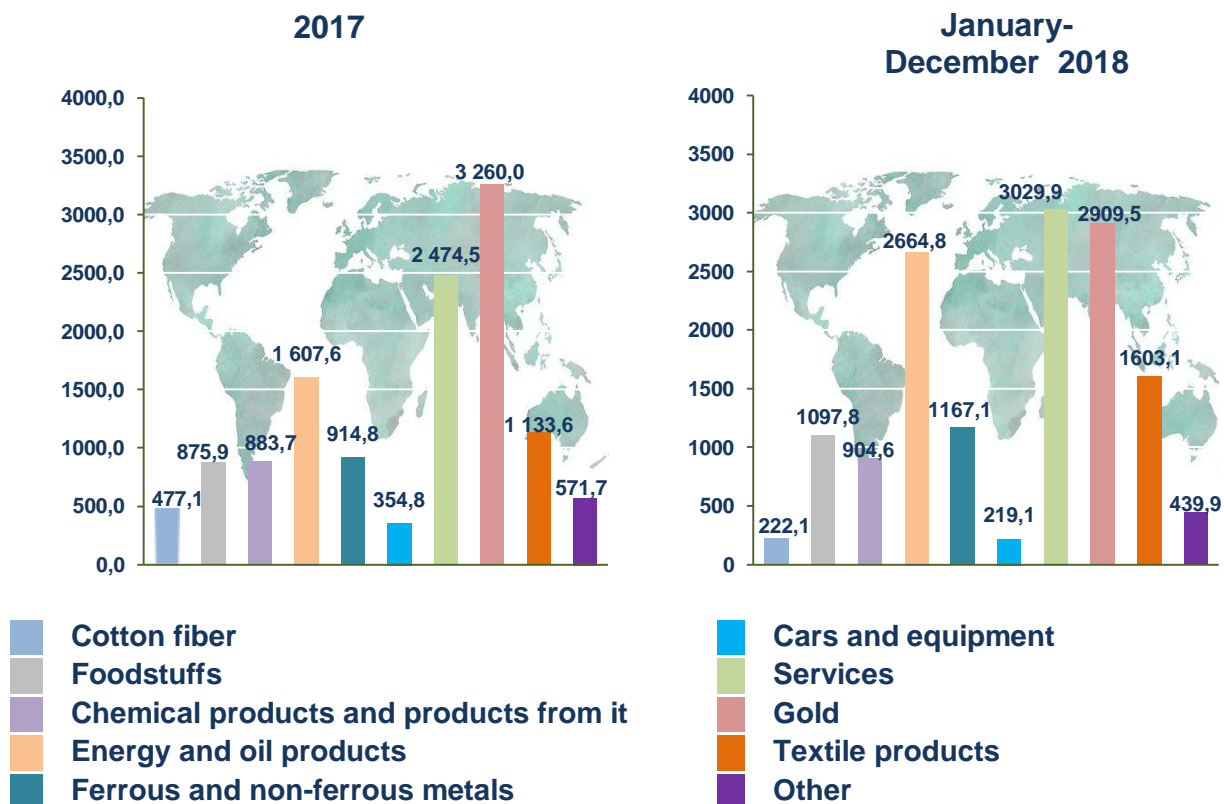

EXPORT

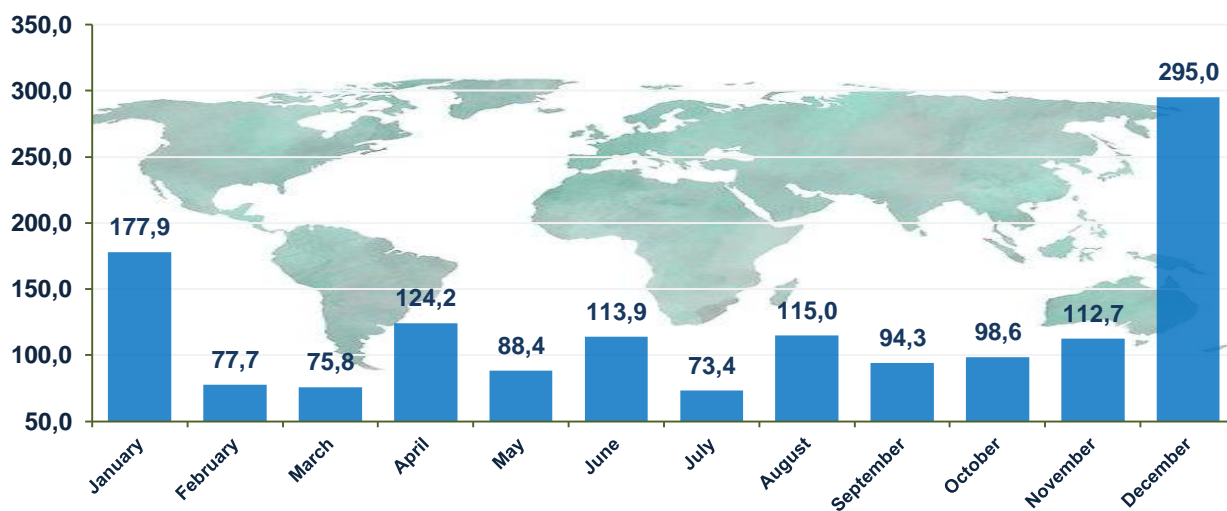
The volume of exports of the Republic of Uzbekistan in January-December 2018 amounted to 14257.9 million USD (an increase of 13.6 % over the same period last year). The share of goods in the composition of exports reached 78.7%, of which energy carriers and petroleum products – 18.7 %, foodstuffs – 7.7 %, ferrous and non-ferrous metals - 8.2 %.

Structure of exports of goods and services (million USD)



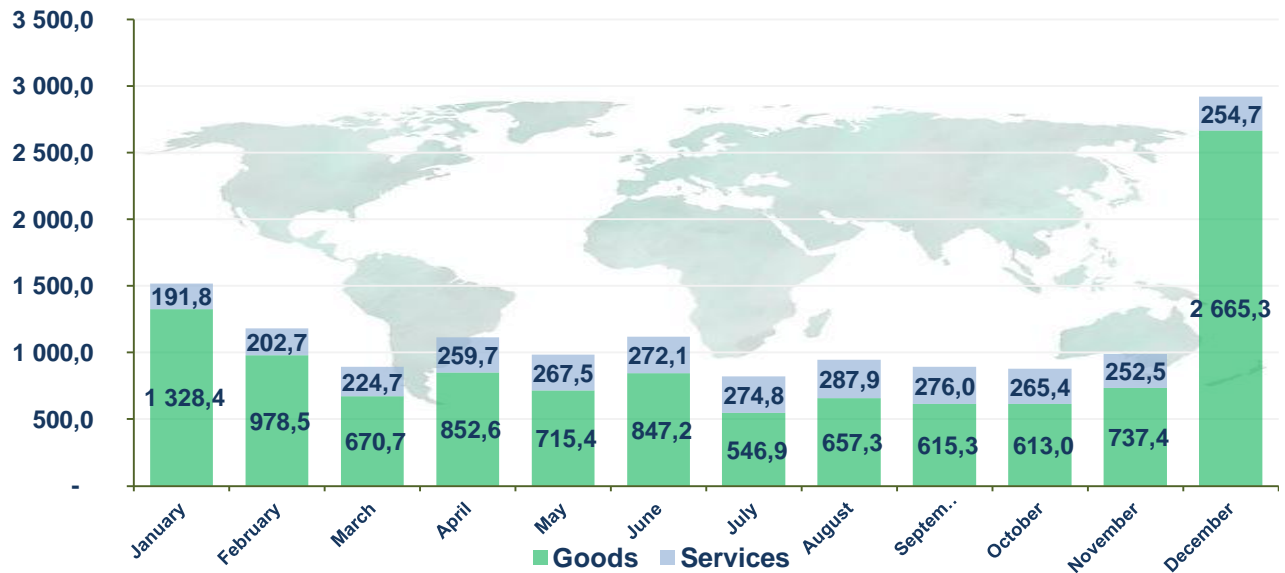
The following data indicate growth rates by months in terms of exported goods and services: the highest growth rates were recorded in January and December 2018.

Analysis of the growth rate of exports of goods and services in December 2018 showed an increase of 3 times compared with November 2018.

Analysis of the dynamics of exports of goods and services also showed that in December 2018, compared with November 2018, the volume of exports of goods increased by 1927.9 million USD and amounted to 2665.3 million USD. Exports of services reached 254.7 million USD.

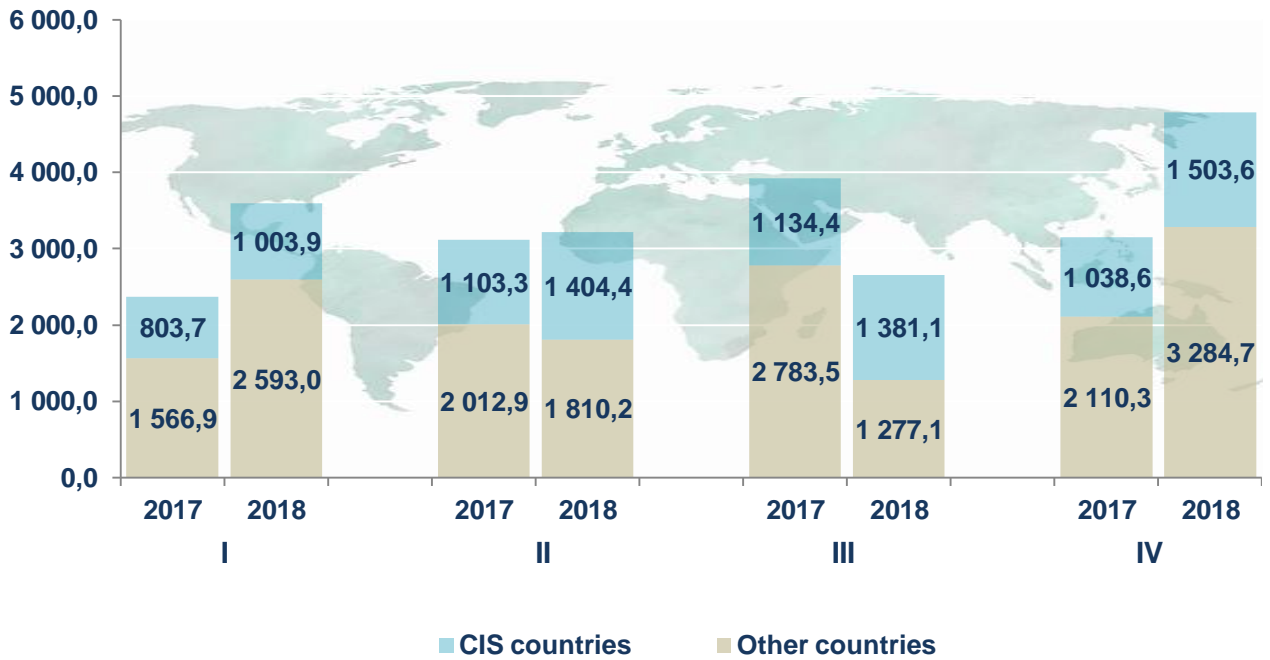

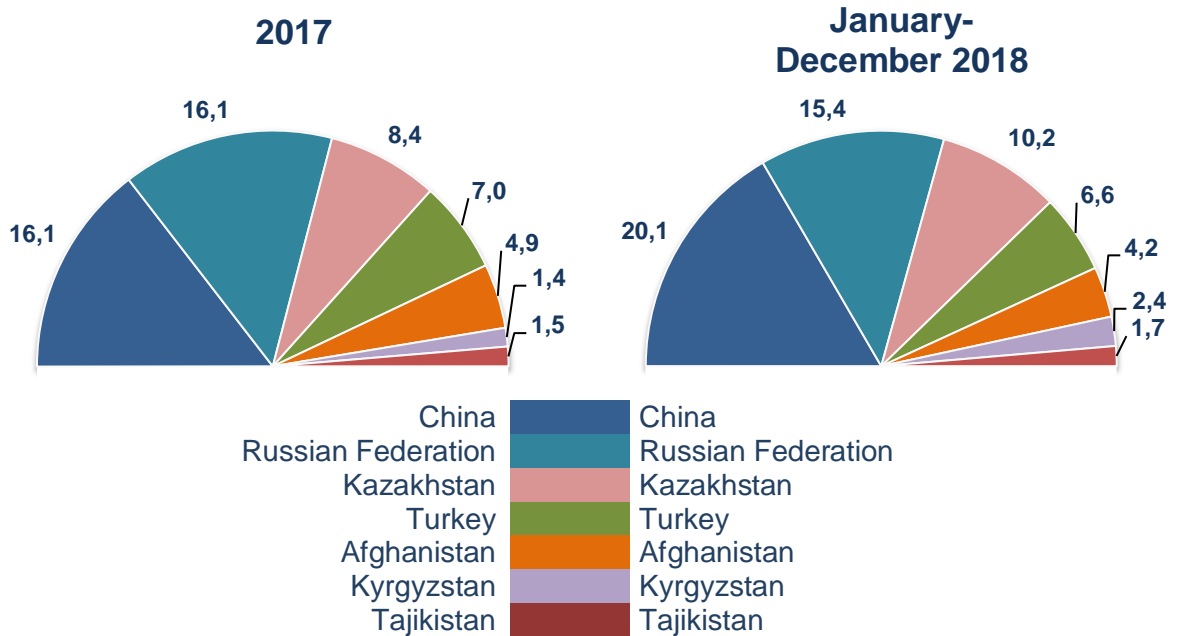

In January-December 2018, the share of cotton fiber in total exports (1.6%), compared with the same period last year, has decreased significantly. During this period, 115.6 thousand tons of cotton fiber were exported in the amount of 222.1 million USD.

Analysis of the trend in the share of cotton fiber in total exports showed that in January-December 2015, the share of exports of cotton fiber was 5.9 % of its total volume, while 503.8 thousand tons of raw materials were exported. In January-December 2016, 416.0 thousand tons of cotton fiber were exported. According to the results of January-December 2017, its share in total exports decreased to 3.8 % and, in general, 278.9 thousand tons of raw materials were exported.

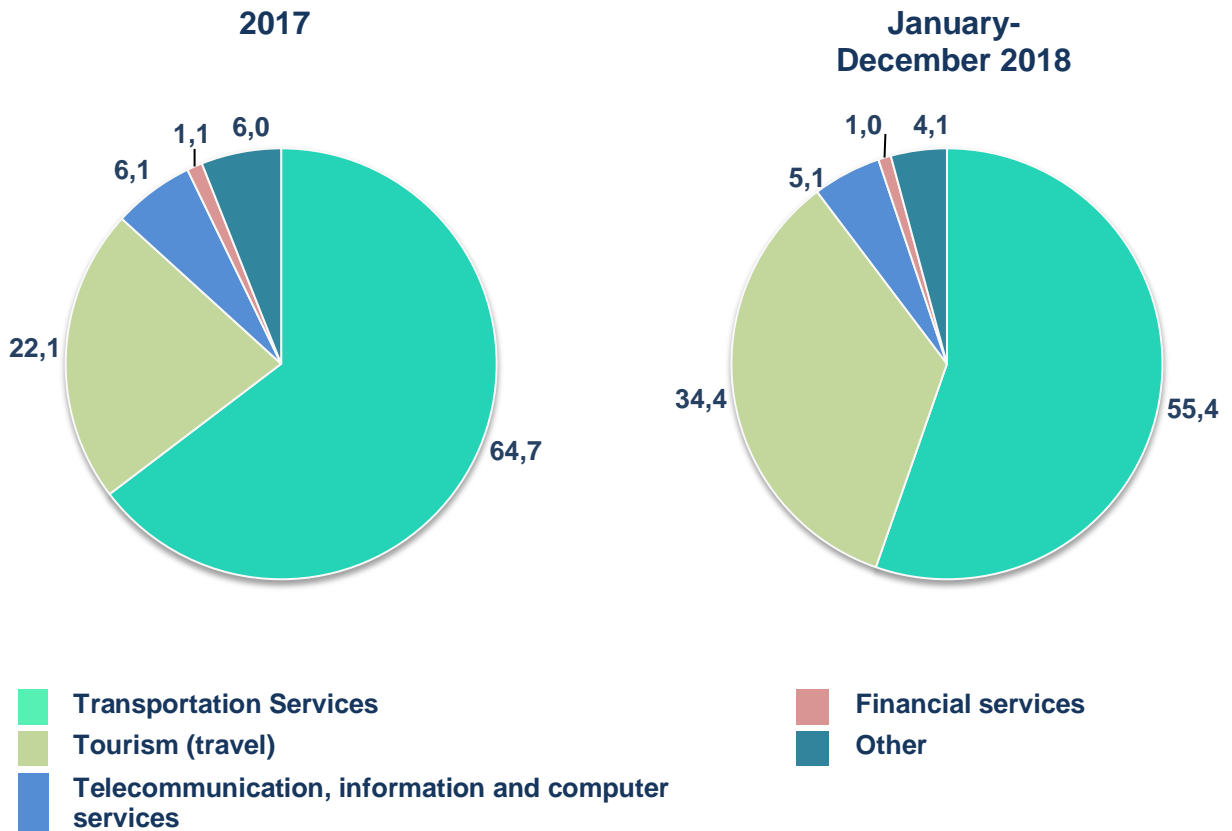

The volume of export services in January-December 2018 amounted to 3029.9 million USD, or 21.3 % of its total volume, and increased, compared to the same period last year, by 22.4 %. As part of service exports, the lion's share is taken up by transportation services, tourism, as well as telecommunication, information, computer and financial services.

Structure of service exports, (%)

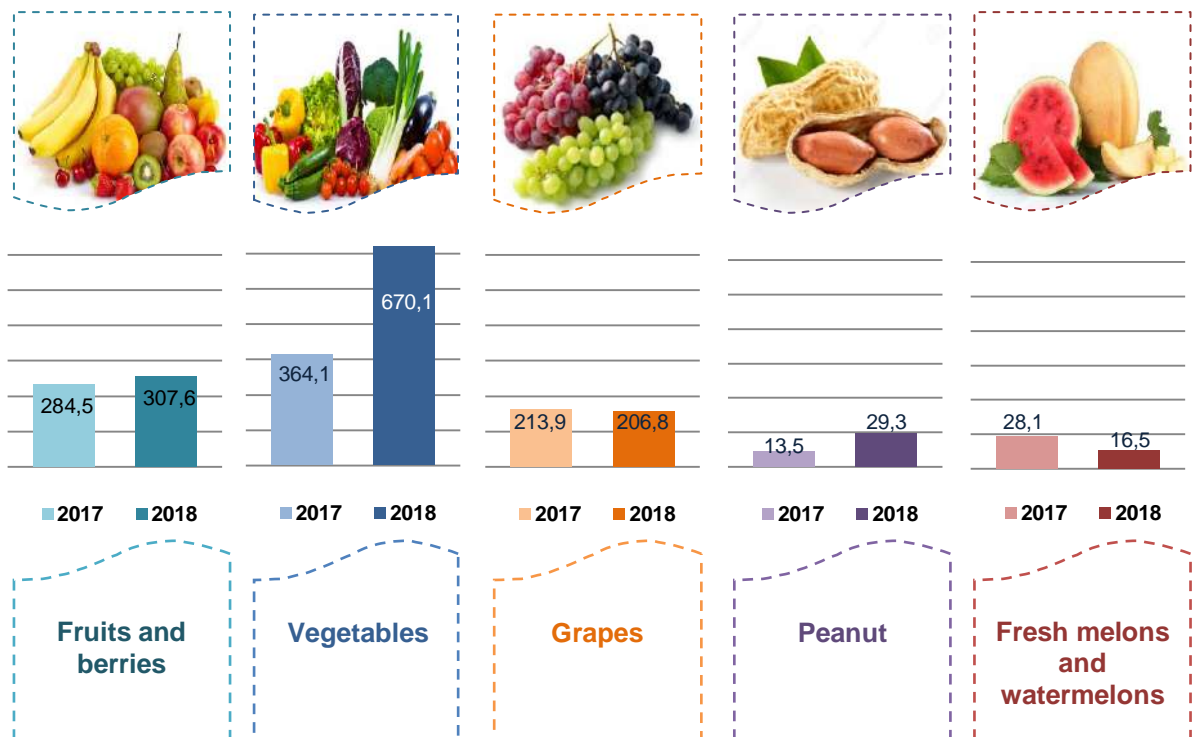


Export of fruits and vegetables

The volume of exports of fruits and vegetables amounted to more than 1230.6 thousand tons and reached 874.5 million USD (growth rate - 37.5 %).

Of the fruits and vegetables, more than 670.1 thousand tons of vegetables were exported (physical growth increased by 84.0 %) in the amount of 307.6 million USD, fruits and berries - 307.6 thousand tons (physical volume increased by 108.1 %) in the amount of 357.7 million USD (growth rates in terms of value, compared to the same period last year, were 141.3 % and 140.6 %, respectively).

It is noteworthy that as a result of the expansion of the export potential of the country and the development of new markets, exports of fruits and vegetables, grapes, melons, legumes, as well as dried vegetables and fruits, are growing. In January-December 2018, exports of fruits and berries, as well as vegetables, reached 665.3 million USD (40.9 % more than during the same period last year).

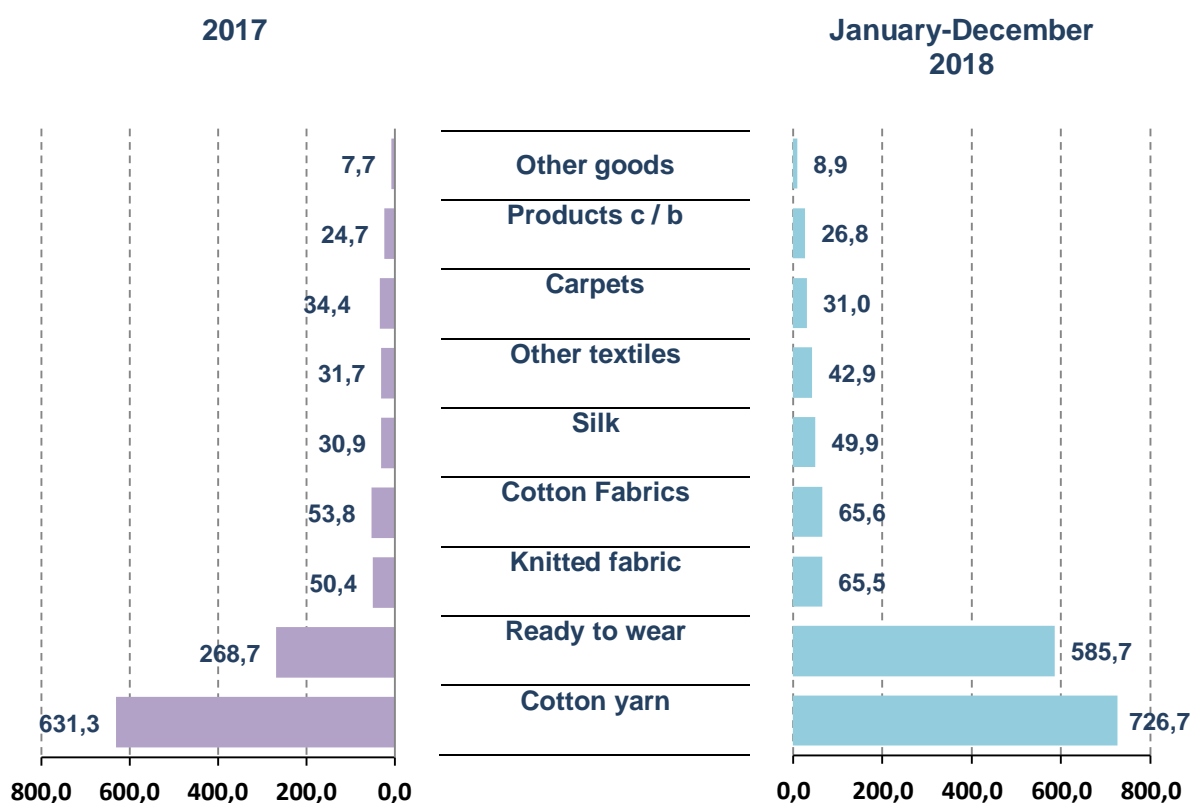
Textile exports

In January-December 2018, the volume of exports of textile products amounted to 1603.4 million USD and increased, compared to the same period of 2017, by 41.4 %, which is 11.2 % of its total volume. Of the export structure of textile products, the main share is cotton yarn (45.3 %), as well as finished knitwear and garments (36.5 %). Since the beginning of the year, more than 348 types of goods have been exported to 57 countries of the world.

Dynamics of the structure of textile exports *(million USD)*

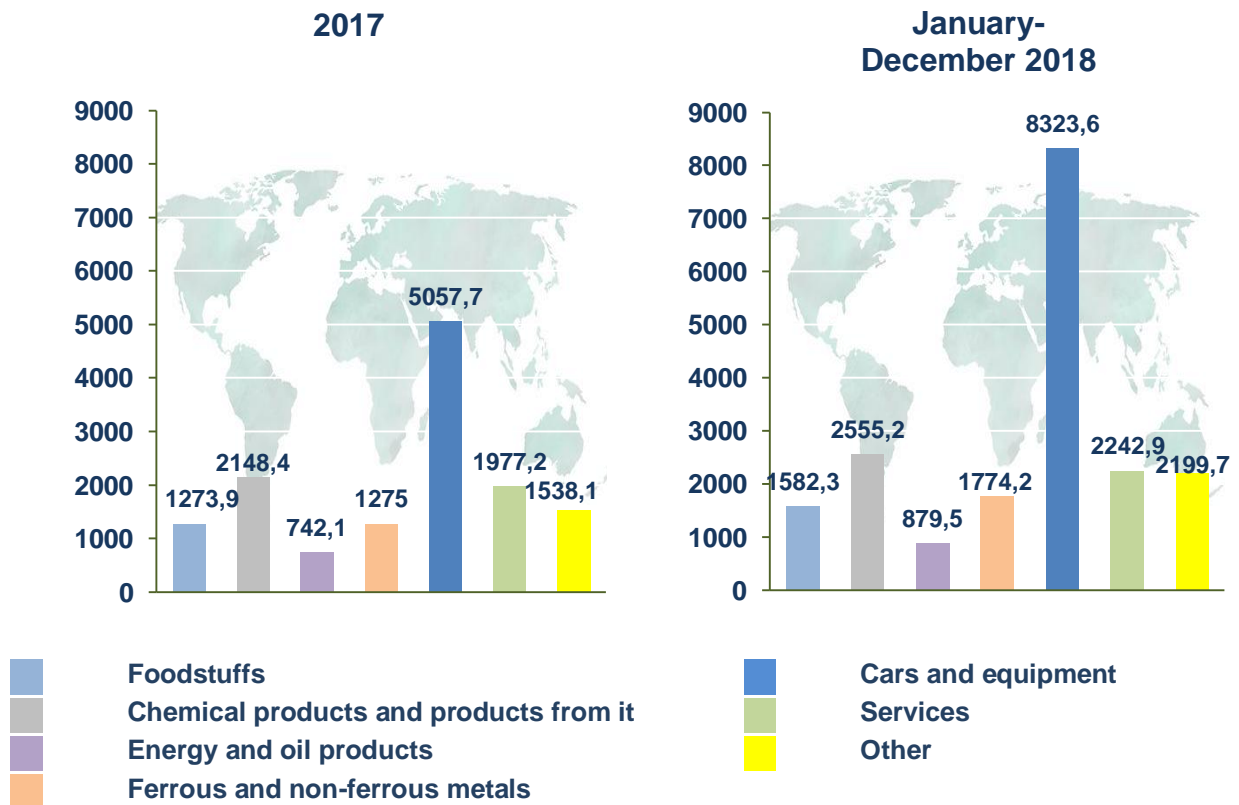

It is noteworthy that if in the first years of independence, exports of light industry products of the republic had a raw material orientation, then at present our country occupies a leading position in the export of finished products of textile and light industry.

IMPORT

In January-December 2018, the volume of imports in the Republic of Uzbekistan amounted to 19557.4 million USD (growth rate - 39.6 %). In the structure of imports, the main share is occupied by machinery and equipment (42.5 %), chemical products and articles thereof (13.1 %), as well as ferrous and non-ferrous metals (9.1 %).

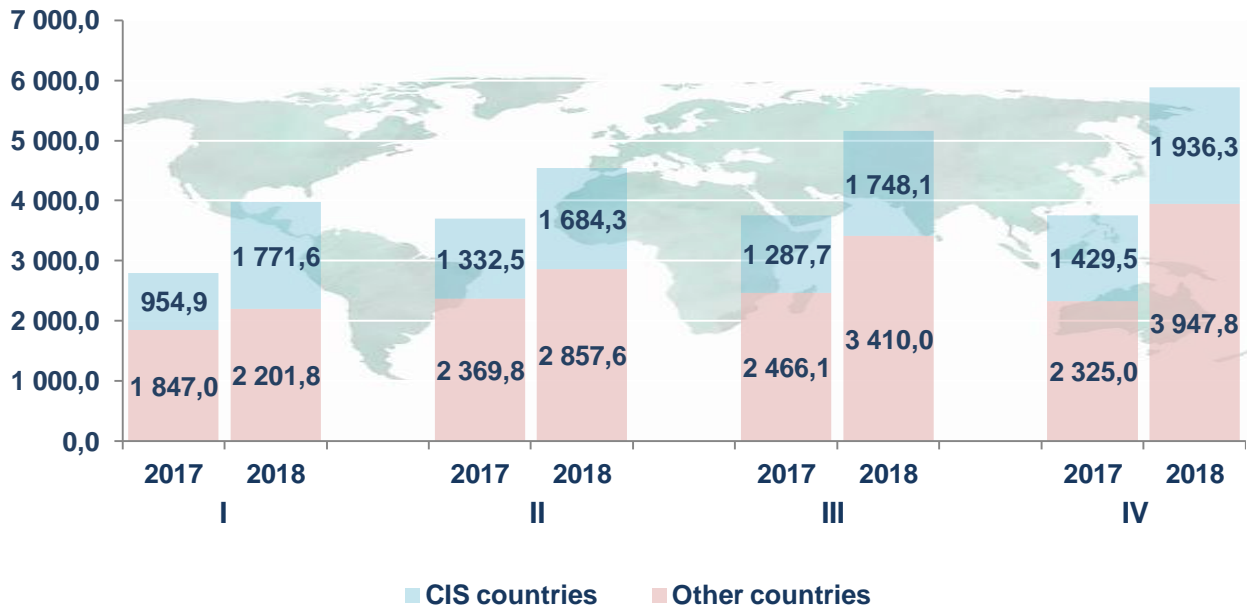

(for the quarter million USD)

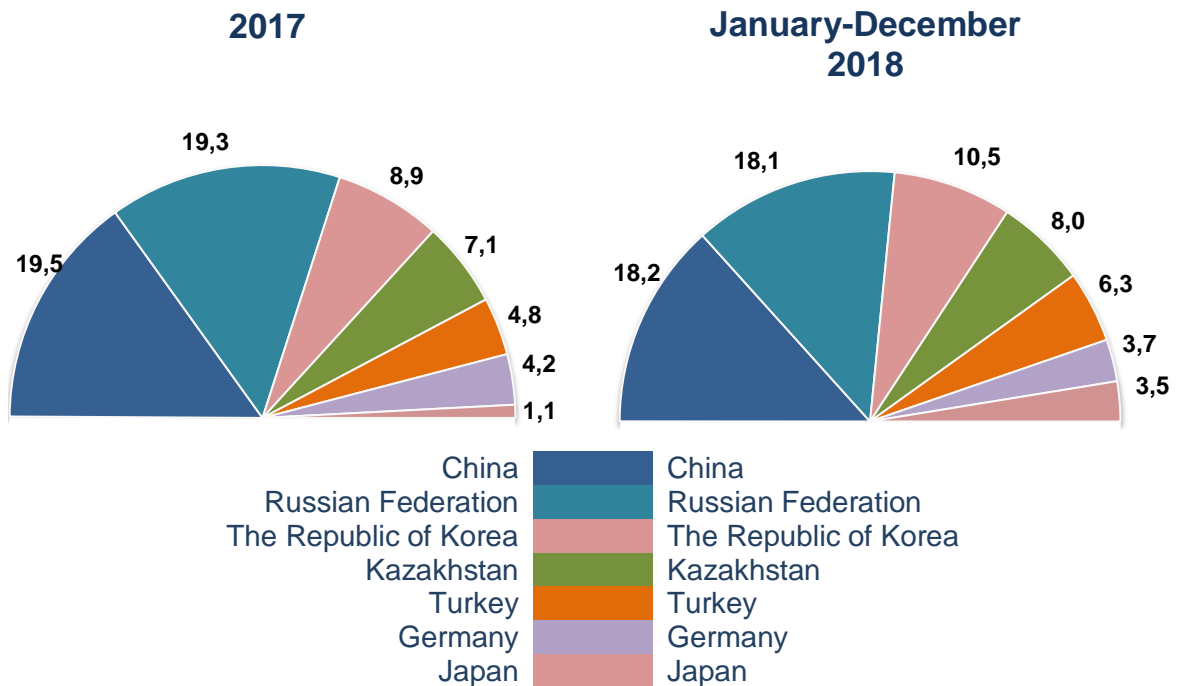

Share of seven major partner countries in the import of goods and services

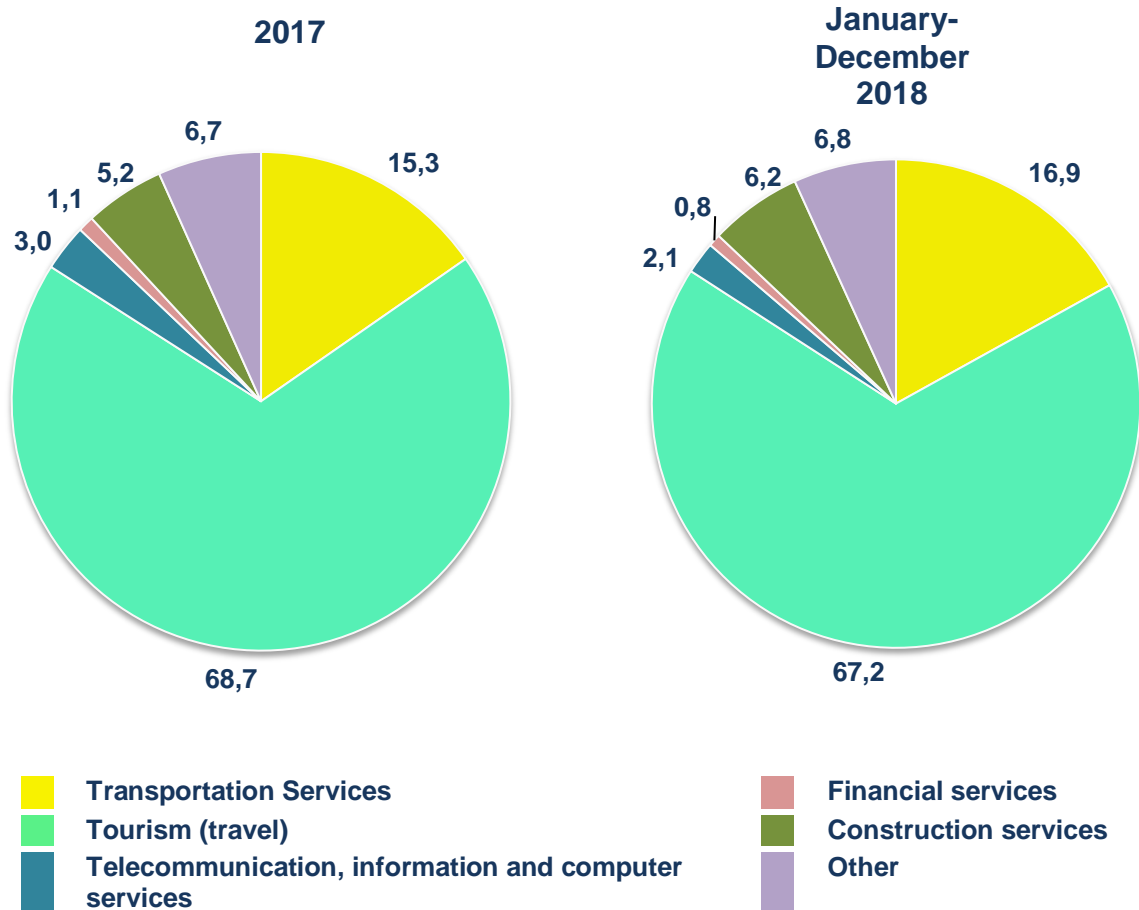


In January-December 2018, goods and services from 159 countries were imported into the republic.

Structure of imports of services, in %



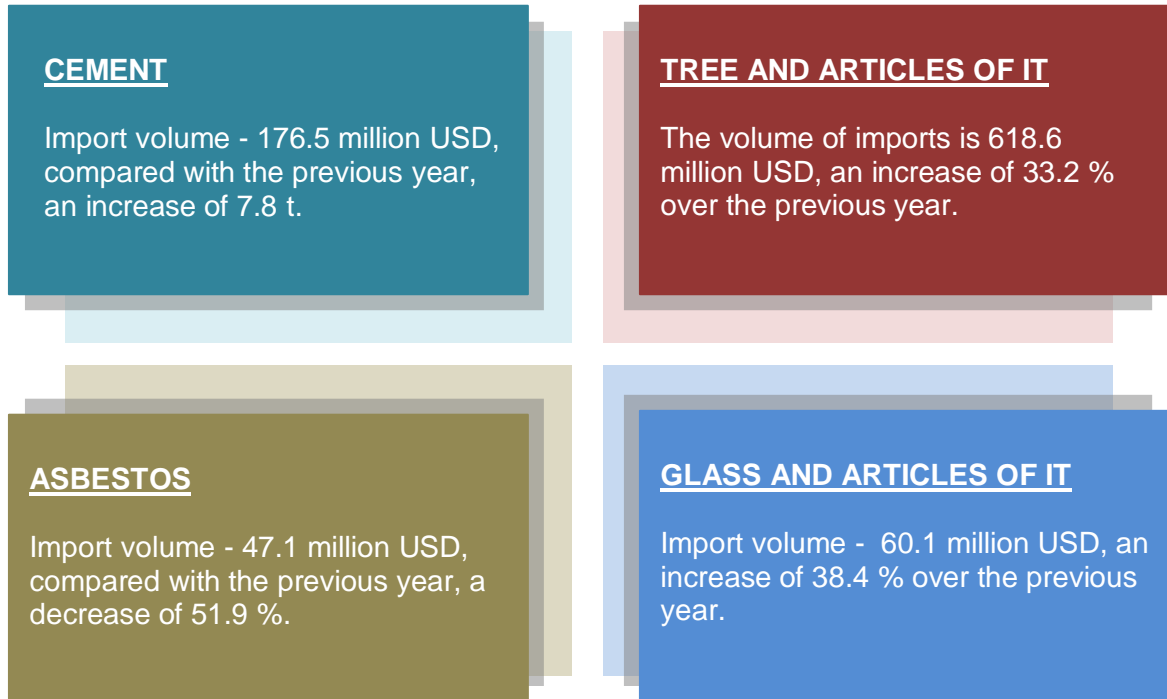
The volume of imports of services in January-December 2018 amounted to 2242.9 million USD, or 11.5 % of total imports and increased, compared to the same period last year, by 13.4 %. Transport services, tourism, as well as telecommunication, information, computer, construction and financial services, account for the bulk of services imports.

Import of building materials

In January-December 2018, the volume of imports of construction materials amounted to 1187.4 million USD and increased, compared to the same period in 2017, by 23.3 %. The share of imports of building materials in the total volume is 6.1 %.

In the structure of imports of building materials, the main share is occupied by cement (14.9 %), wood and products from it (52.1 %), asbestos (4.0 %), as well as glass and products from it (5.1 %).

This infographic shows that the import of building materials in January-December 2018, compared with the corresponding period of 2017, has increased significantly. The growth in imports of construction materials is due to large-scale construction and reconstruction work in the country.

It should be noted that the government is implementing a number of reforms aimed at the production of building materials and products, as well as providing the domestic market with high-quality and at the same time low-cost building materials.

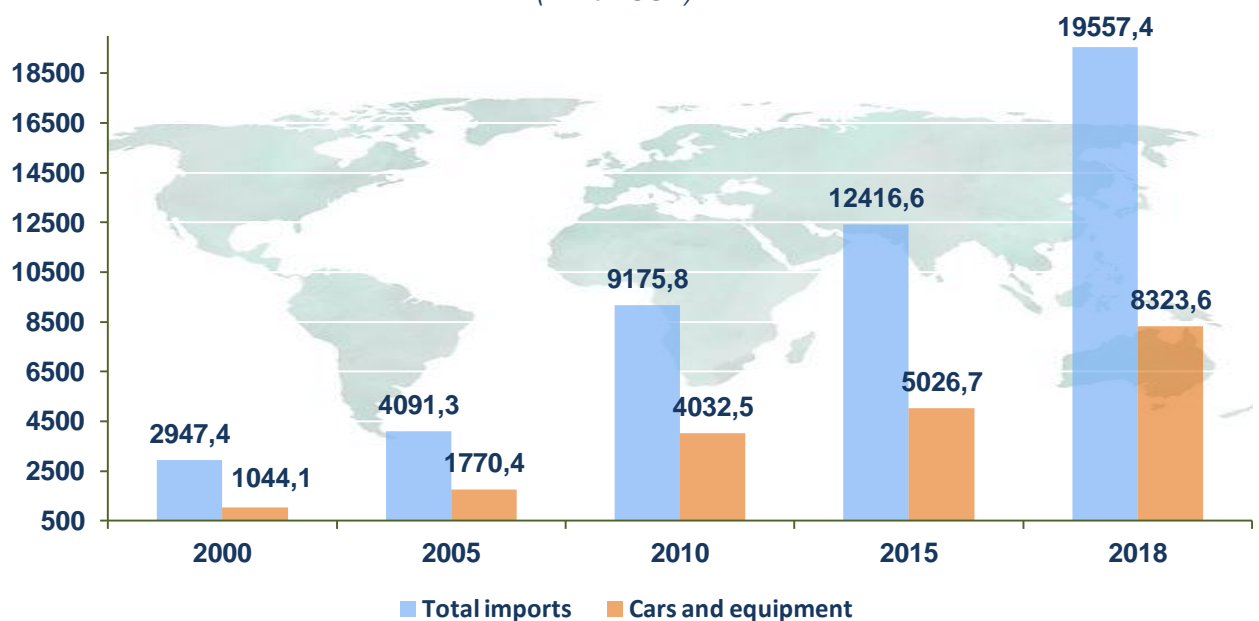

The volume of imports of cars and special machinery increased by 2.5 times and amounted to 426.8 million USD, imports of excavators and bulldozers increased 2.9 times and reached 306.3 million USD.

The increasing volume of imports of machinery and equipment is a reflection of industrialization policies, as well as an active policy to support foreign direct investment in the creation, modernization and increase in production capacity.

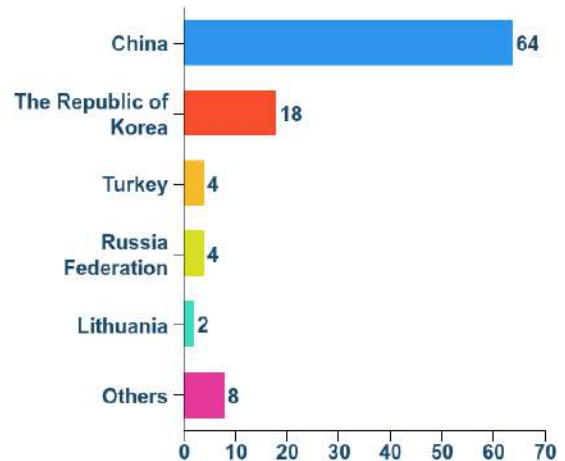

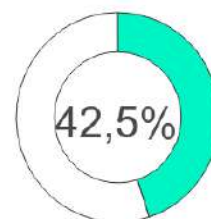
