

GROSS REGIONAL PRODUCT



In accordance with the State Statistical Work Program, the State Committee on Statistics has carried out a preliminary assessment of the gross regional product (hereinafter referred to as GRP) of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, regions and the Tashkent city for 2018.

GRP is the main indicator of the national accounts system, which characterizes the final result of the production activities of institutional units - residents located in the economic territory of the region, for a certain period of time. The GRP is calculated using the production method as the sum of gross value added by type of economic activity, basic prices and net taxes on products.

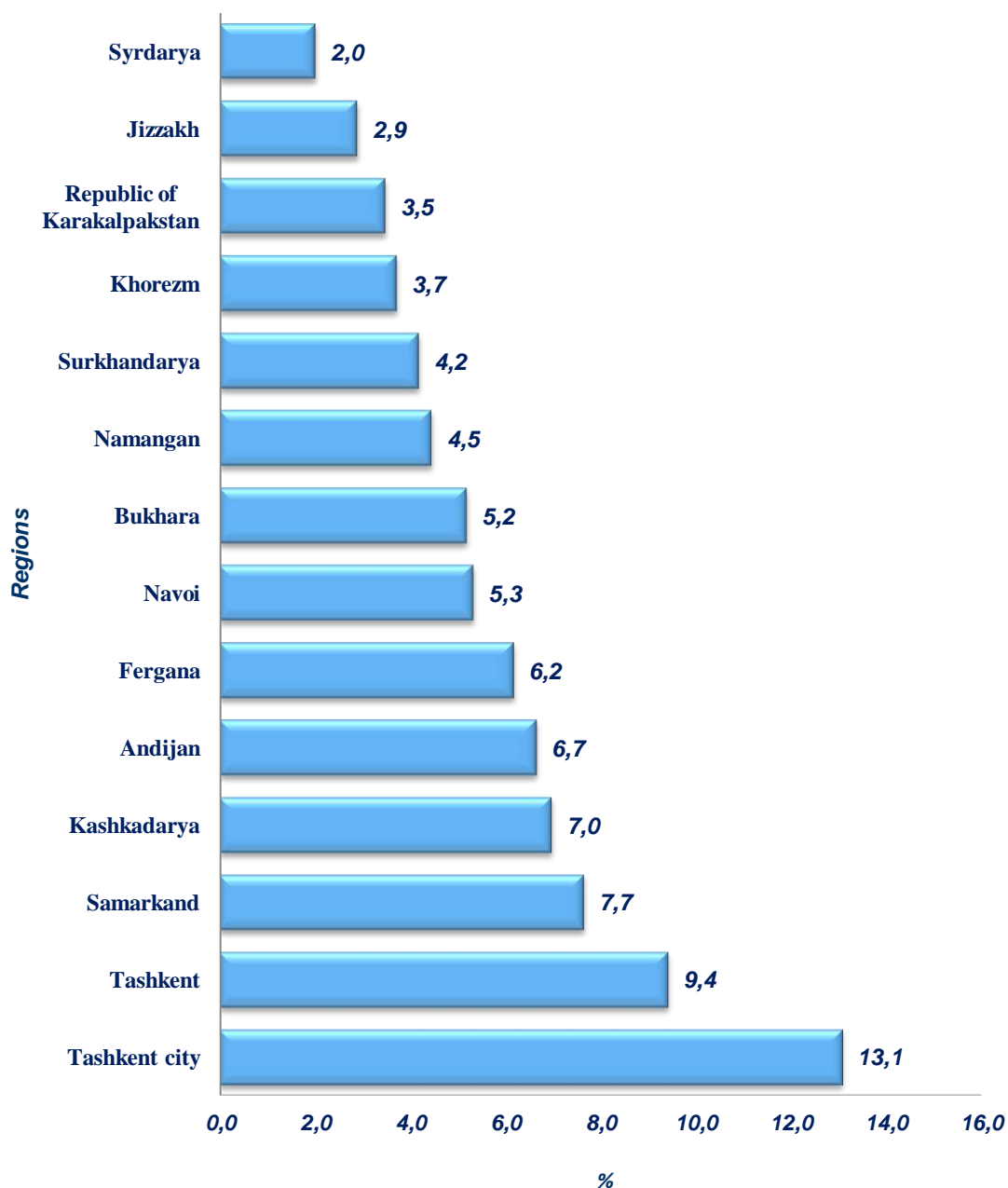

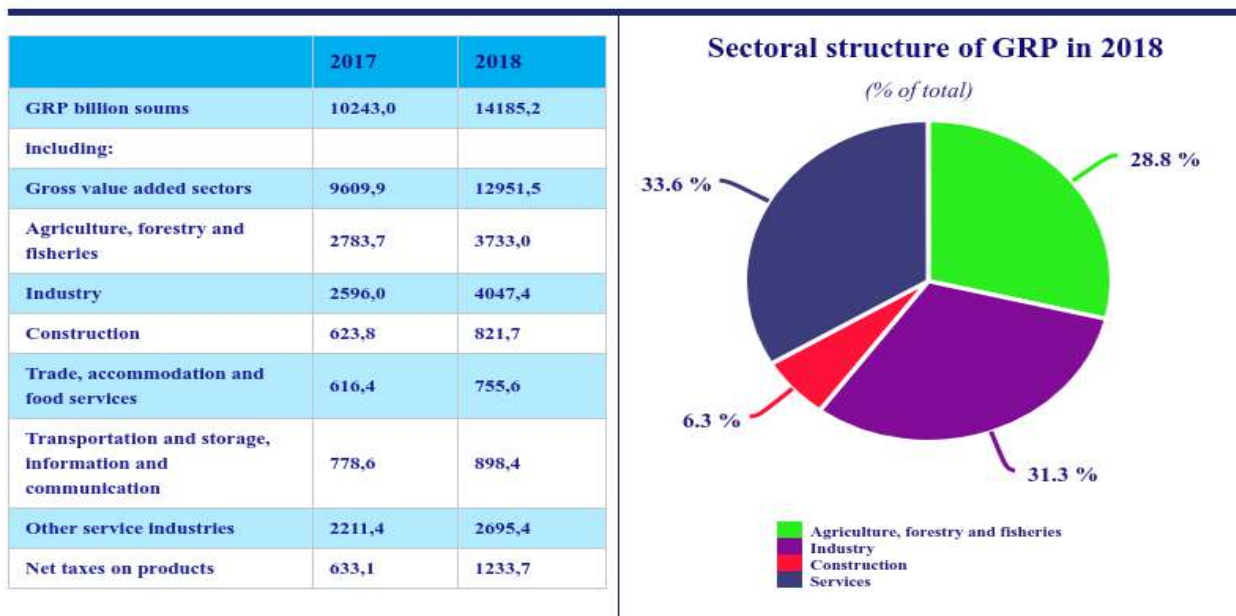
At the end of 2018, the leading growth rates of GRP were recorded in the Tashkent city (108.1 %), Andijan (112.1 %) and Tashkent (106.4 %) regions. Low growth rates of GRP, as compared with the republican level (105.1 %), were observed in Samarkand (99.3 %), Kashkadarya (101.0 %), Surkhandarya (101.0%) and Syrdarya (102.1 %) regions.

Participation of regions in the formation of GDP for 2018 (% of GDP)



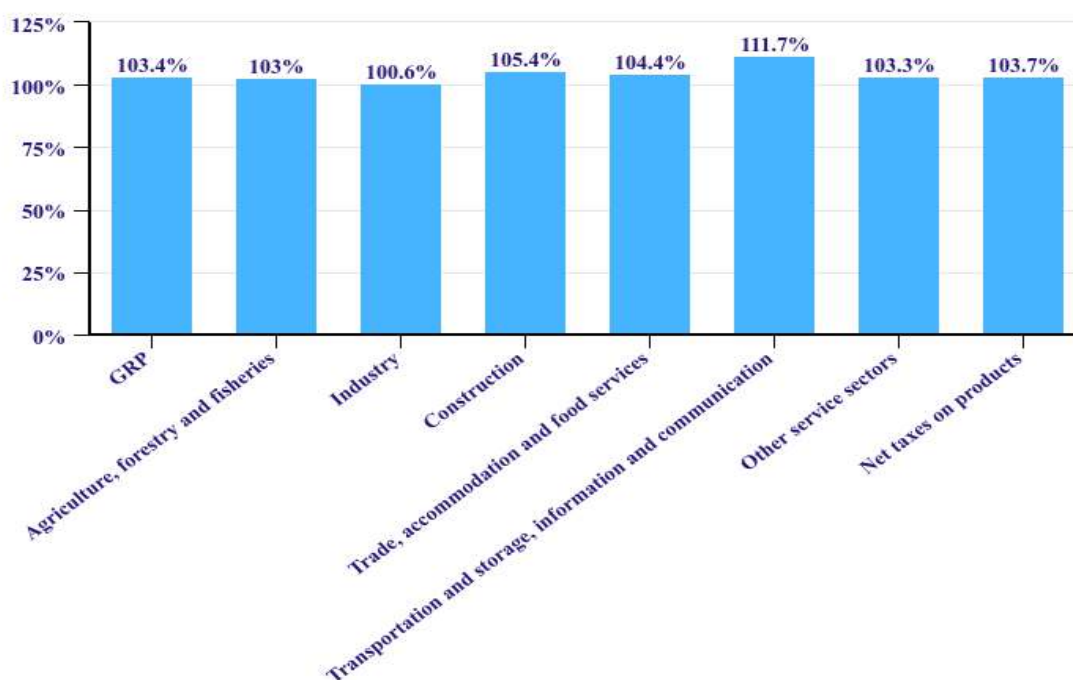
The largest contribution to the formation of the republic's GDP was made by the Tashkent city with a specific weight of 13.1 %. Tashkent and Samarkand regions take the next places with indicators of 9.4 % and 7.7 %, respectively. The lowest share of GRP in the formation of GDP of the republic was noted in Syrdarya (2.0 %), Jizzakh (2.9 %) regions and the Republic of Karakalpakstan (3.5 %).

According to preliminary data, the GDP of the Republic of Karakalpakstan for 2018 in current prices amounted to 14185.2 billion soums and increased, in real terms, by 3.4 % compared with the previous year. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the main sectors of the region's economy, such as agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 103.0 % (its share in the structure of GRP is 28.8 %), industry - 100.6 % (31.3 %) , construction - 105.4 % (6.3 %), services - 105.3 % (33.6 %). GRP per capita amounted to 7642.9 thousand soums and grew by 1.9 %.

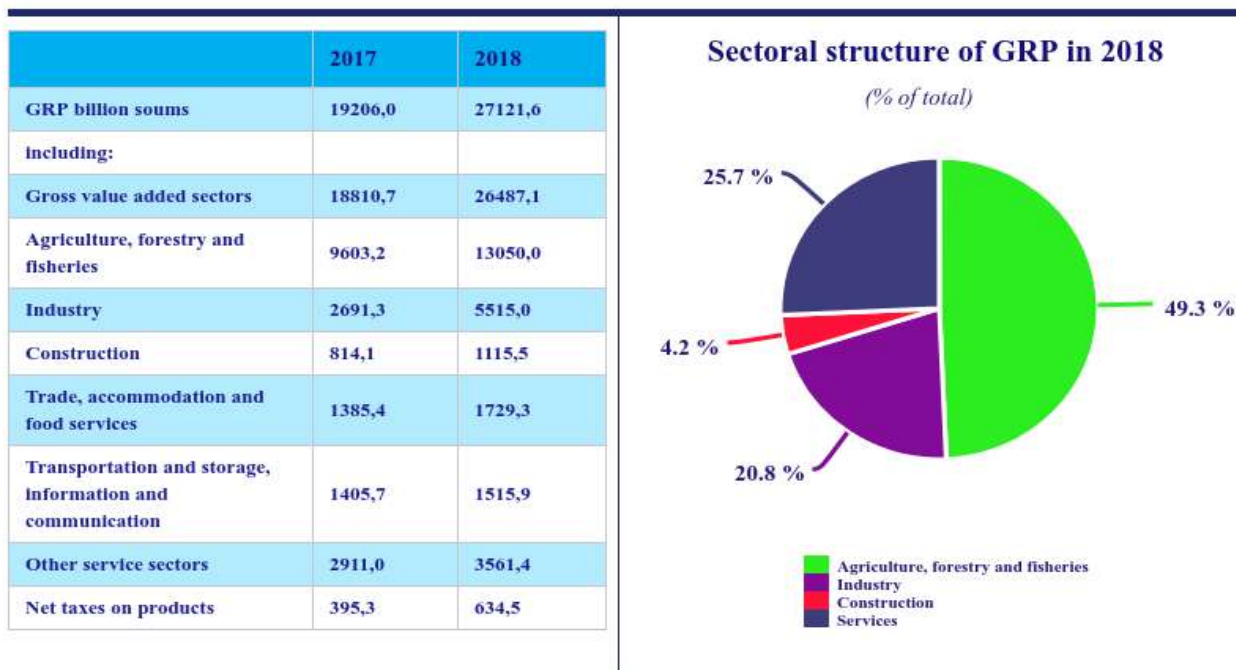


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in% by 2017)

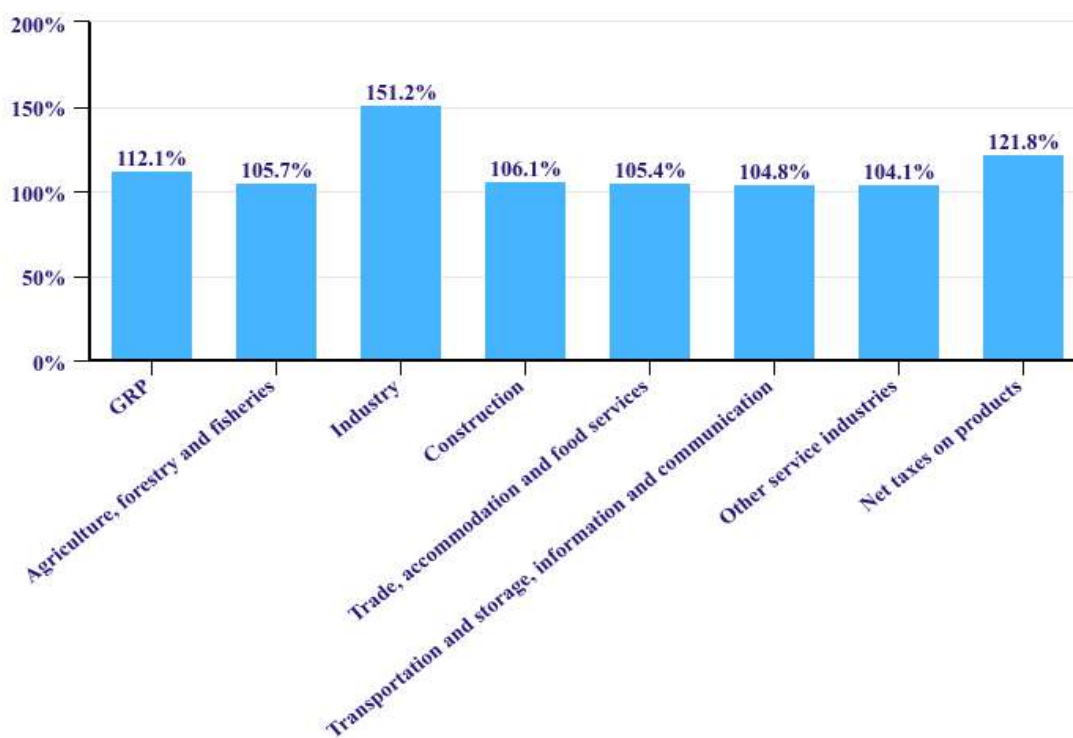


The GRP of the **Andijan region** in current prices amounted to 27121.6 billion soums and grew by 12.1 %. Economic growth is due to positive growth rates in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 105.7 % (share in the GRP structure - 49.3 %), industry - 151.2 % (20.8 %), construction - 106.1 % (4.2%), services - 104.6 % (25.7 %). GRP per capita amounted to 8923.9 thousand soums and increased by 10.2 %.

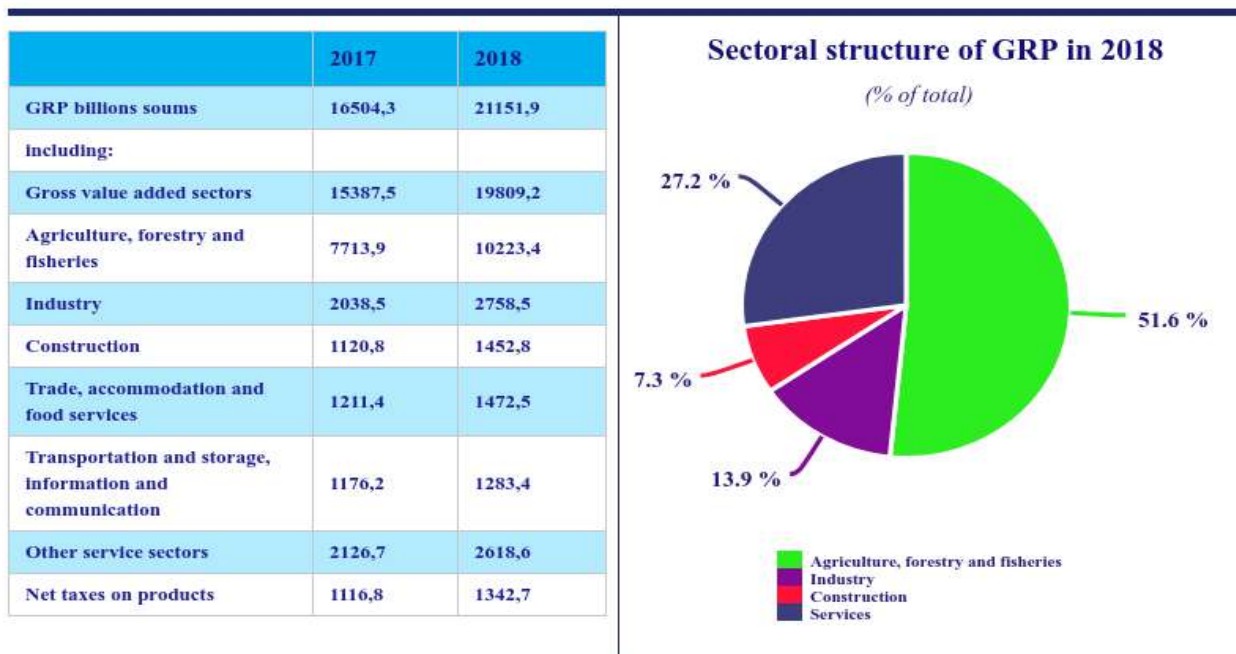


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

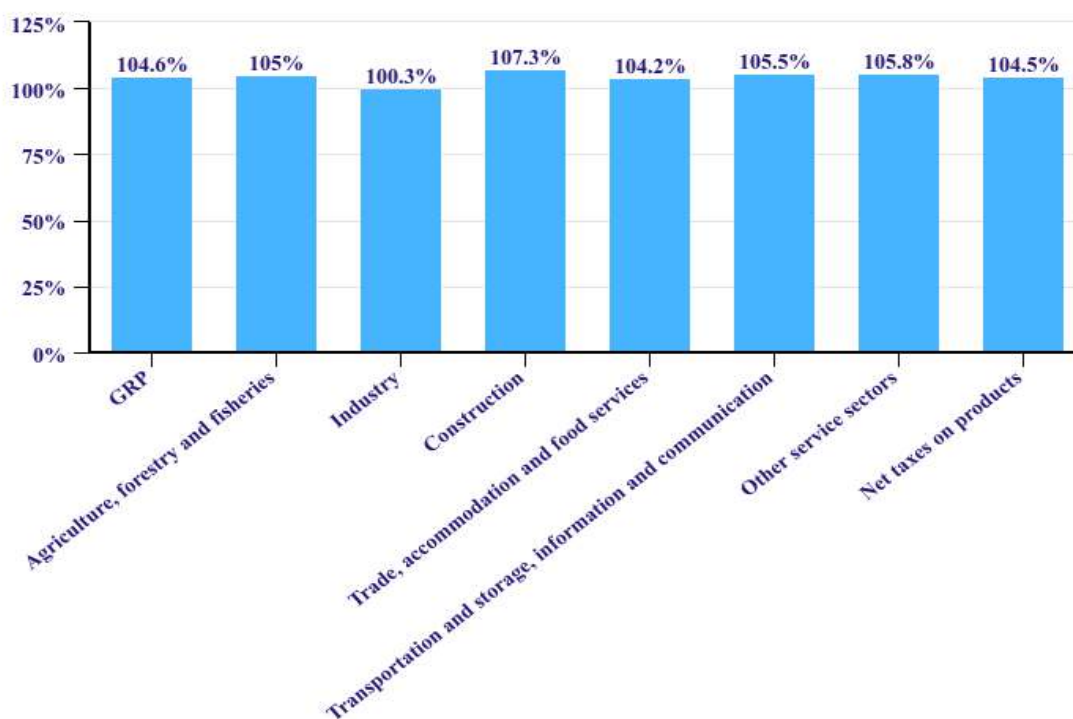


In the **Bukhara region**, the GRP growth was 4.6 % and reached 21151.9 billion soums. In the sectoral structure of GRP, growth rates were as follows: in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 105.0 % (share in the structure of GRP - 51.6 %), industry - 100.3 % (13.9 %), construction –107.3 % (7.3 %), services - 105.3 % (27.2 %). The volume of GRP per capita increased by 3.1 % and amounted to 11222.4 thousand soums.

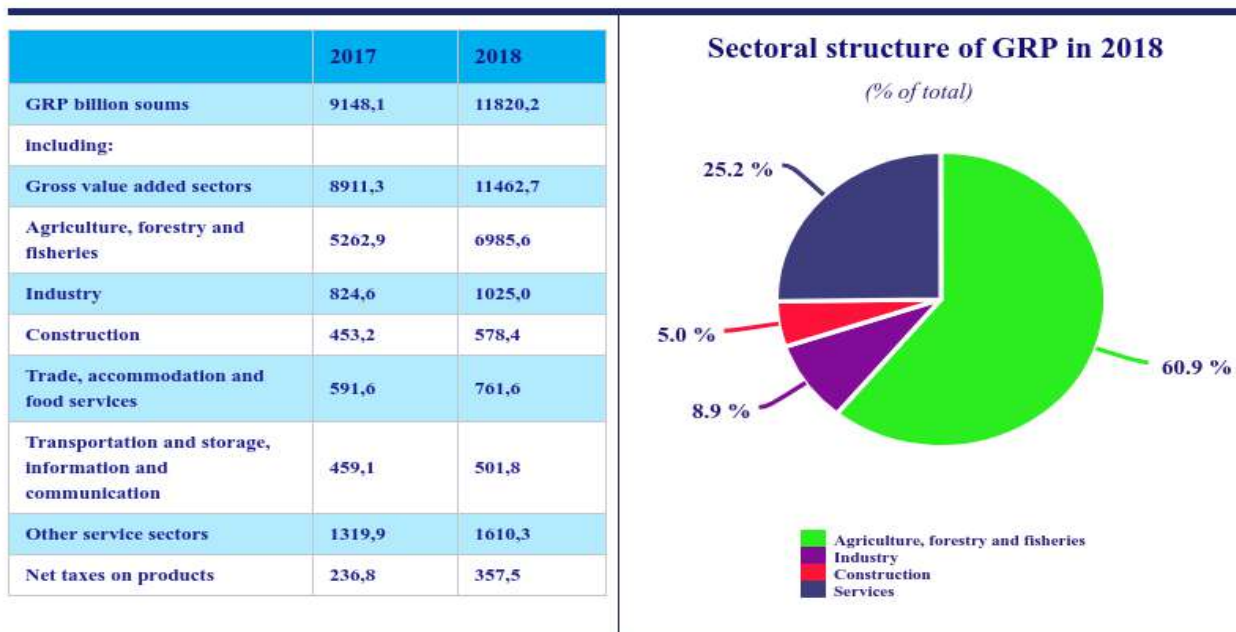


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

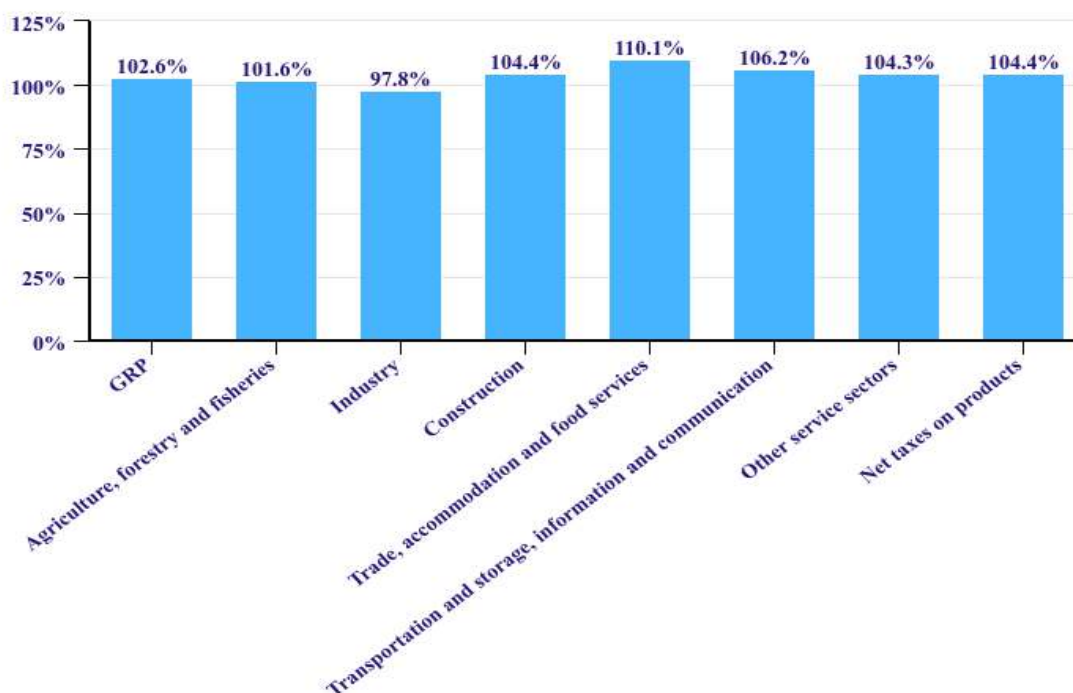


The GRP of **Jizzakh region** reached 11820.2 billion soums from growth of 2.6 %. The growth rates of agriculture, forestry and fisheries amounted to 101.6 % (the share in the structure of GRP is 60.9 %), construction - 104.4 % (5.0 %), services - 106.1 % (25.2 %). In industry, there was a decrease in volumes, which amounted to 97.8 % compared to the previous year (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP - 8.9 %). The volume of GRP per capita amounted to 8830.3 thousand soums and grew by 0.7 %.

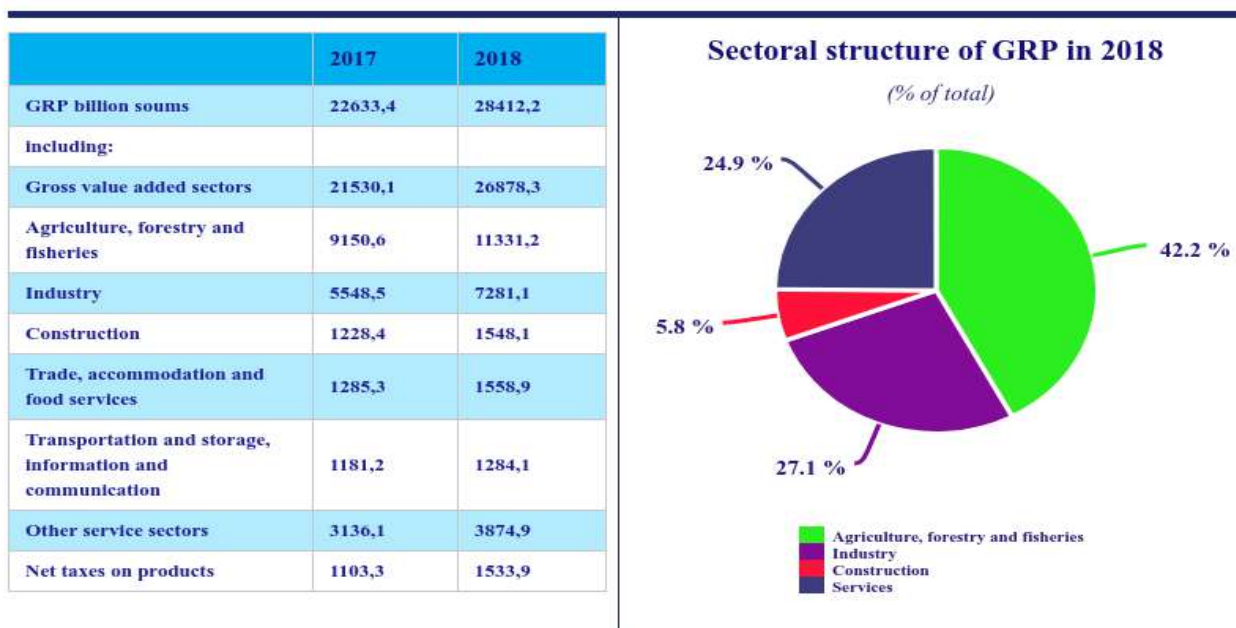


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

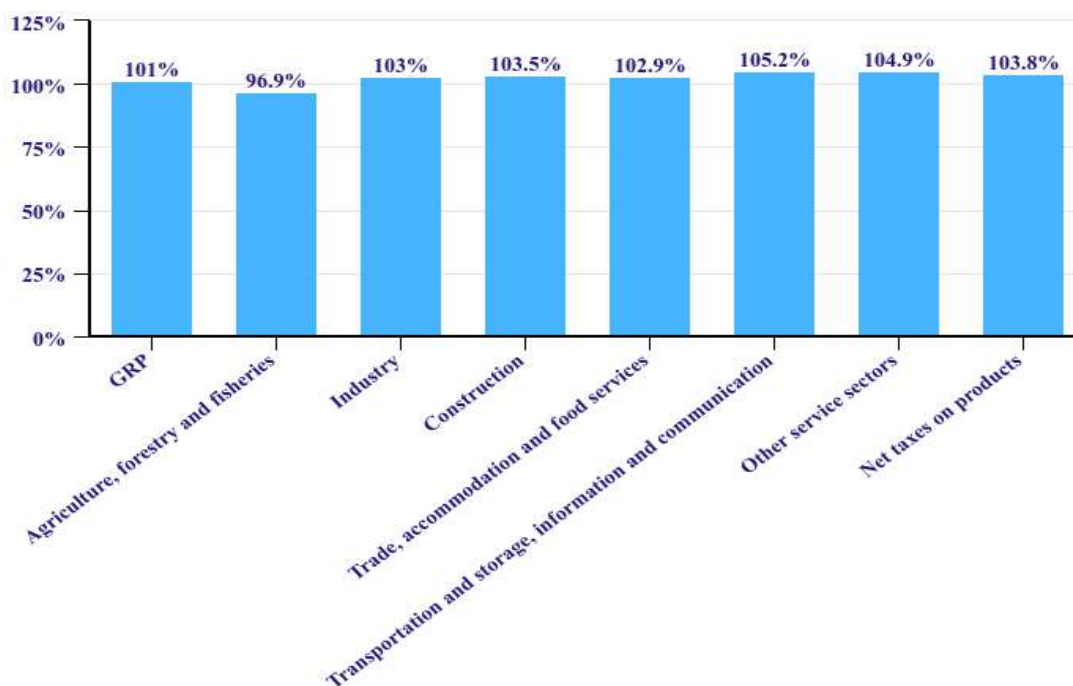


GRP of **Kashkadarya region** increased by 1.0 % and amounted to 28412.2 billion soums. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the main sectors of the regional economy: in industry - 103.0 % (share in the structure of GRP - 27.1 %), construction - 103.5 % (5.8%), services - 104.5 % (24.9 %). In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, a decrease was noted, which amounted to 96.9 % compared to the previous year (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 42.2 %). GRP per capita decreased by 1.0 % and amounted to 8932.1 thousand soums.

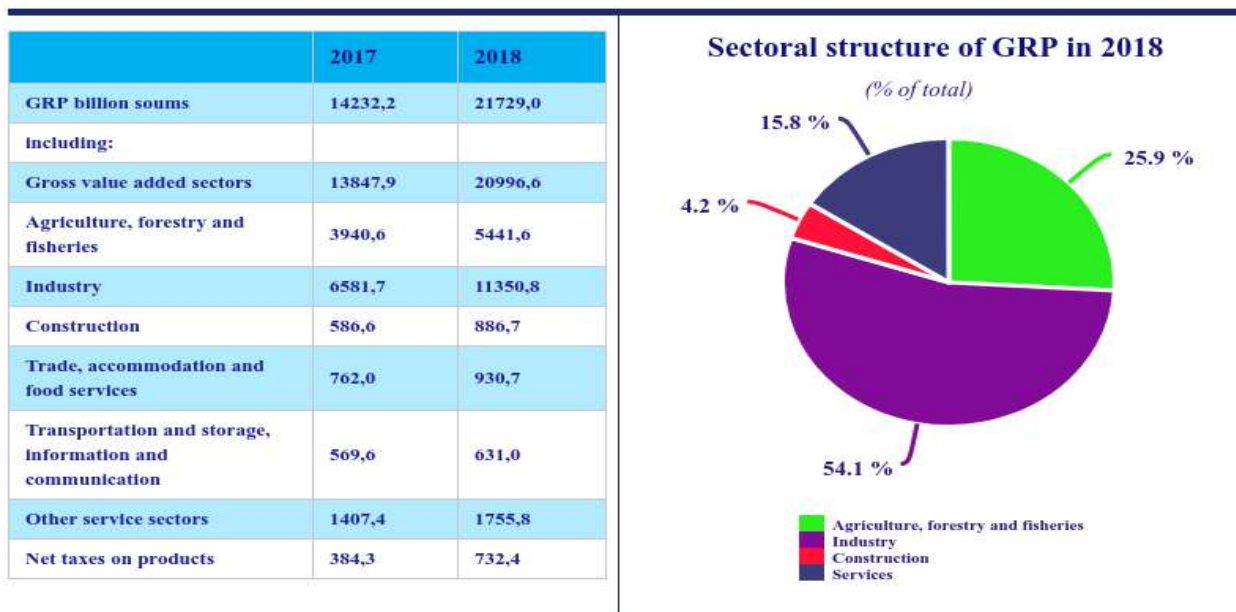


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

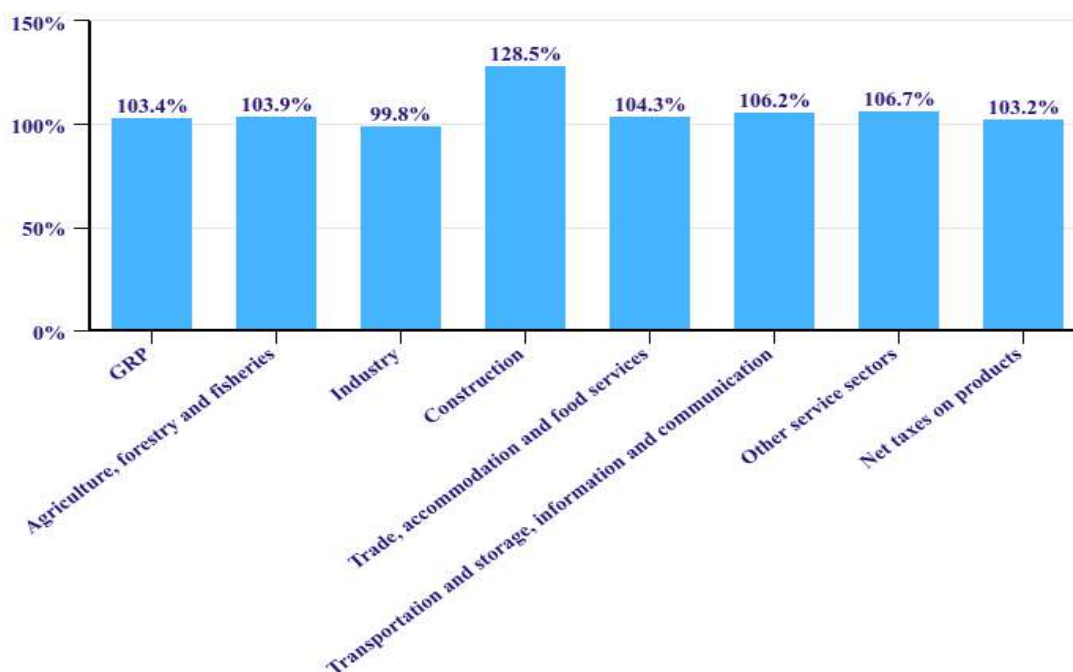


In **Navoi region**, the GRP increased by 3.4 % and reached 21729.0 billion soums. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the main sectors of the regional economy. In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, growth rates amounted to 103.9 % (the share in the structure of the GRP is 25.9 %), construction - 128.5 % (4.2 %), services - 105.9 % (15.8 %). In industry, there was a decrease in volume, which amounted to 99.8 % of the previous year (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 54.1 %). GRP per capita increased by 1.7 % and amounted to 22489.1 thousand soums.

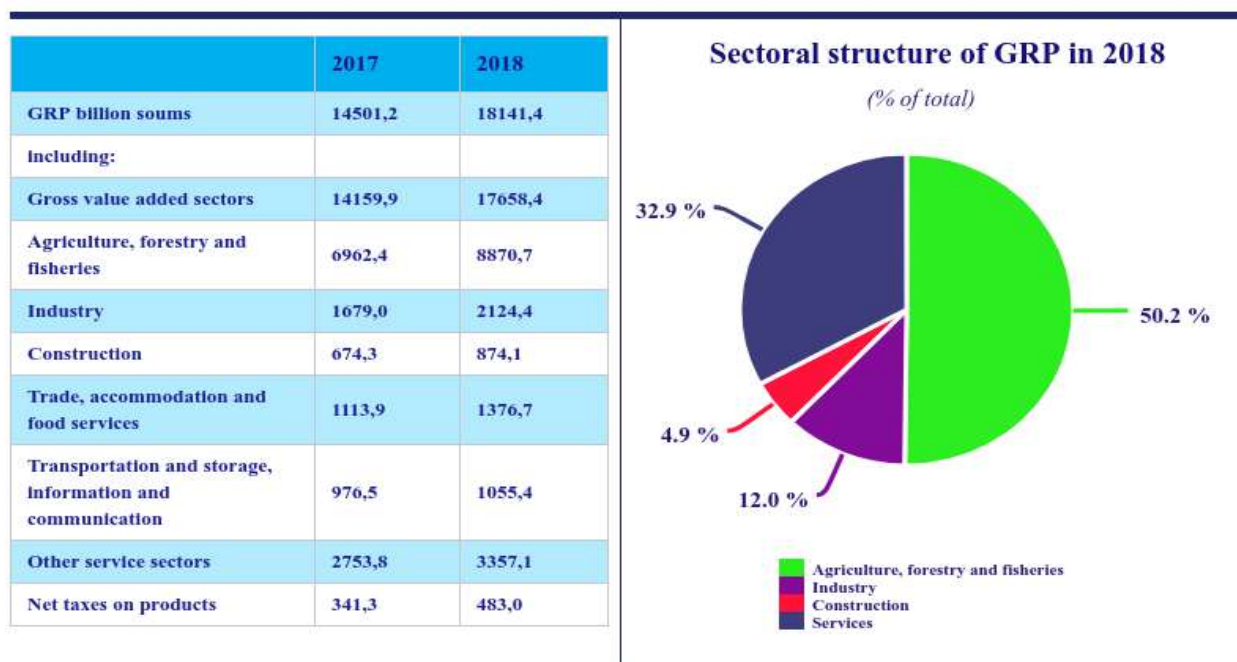


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

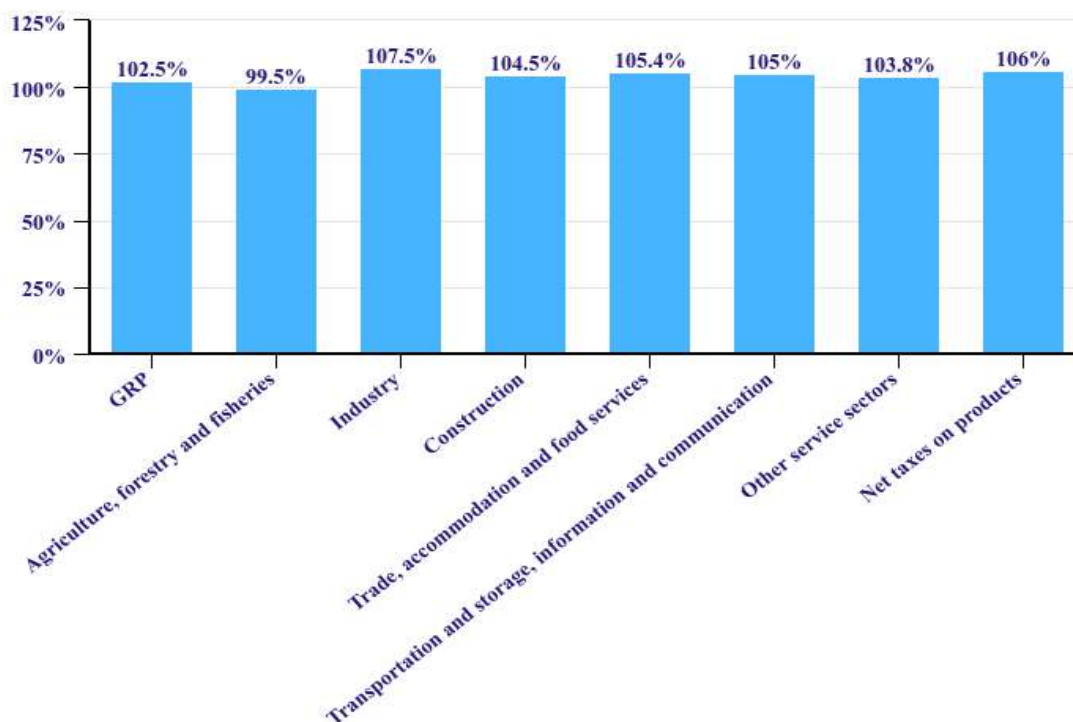


The GRP of **Namangan region** amounted to 18141.4 billion soums, which is 2.5 % higher than the data of the previous year. The growth rates of the GRP are due to positive growth rates in industry - 107.5 % (the share in the GRP structure is 12.0 %), construction - 104.5 % (4.9 %) and the service sector - 104.4 % (32.9 %). In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, a decrease was noted, which amounted to 99.5 % compared to the previous year (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 50.2 %). GRP per capita increased by 0.6 % and amounted to 6654.7 thousand soums.

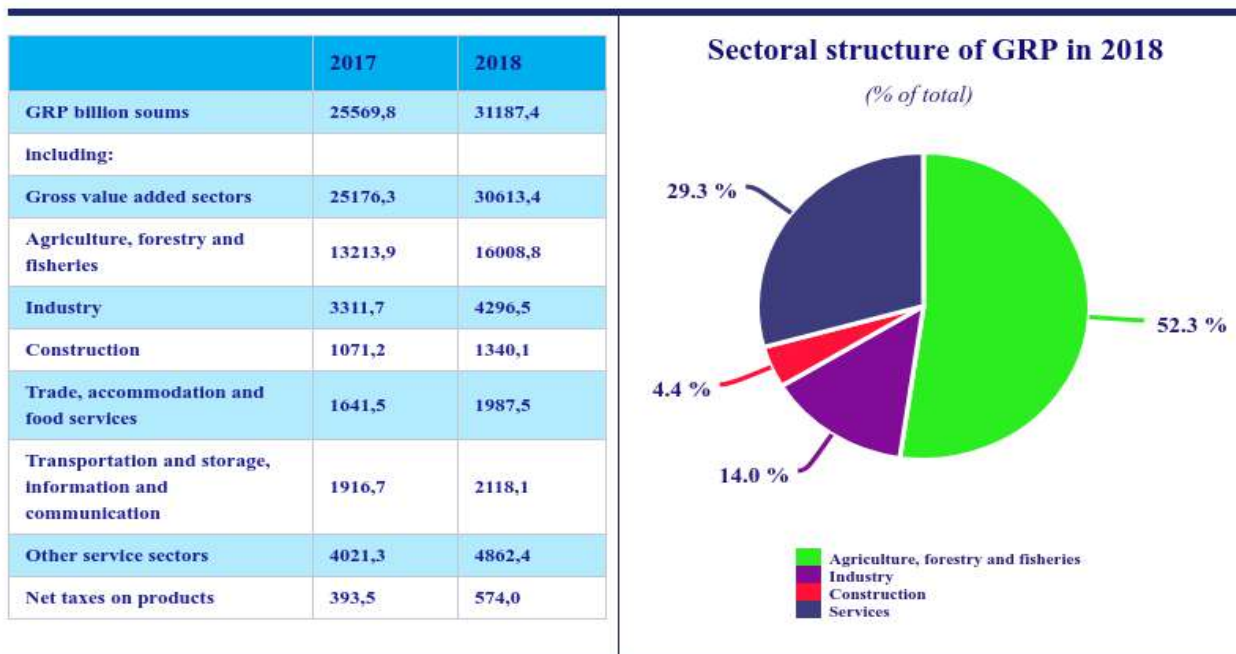


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

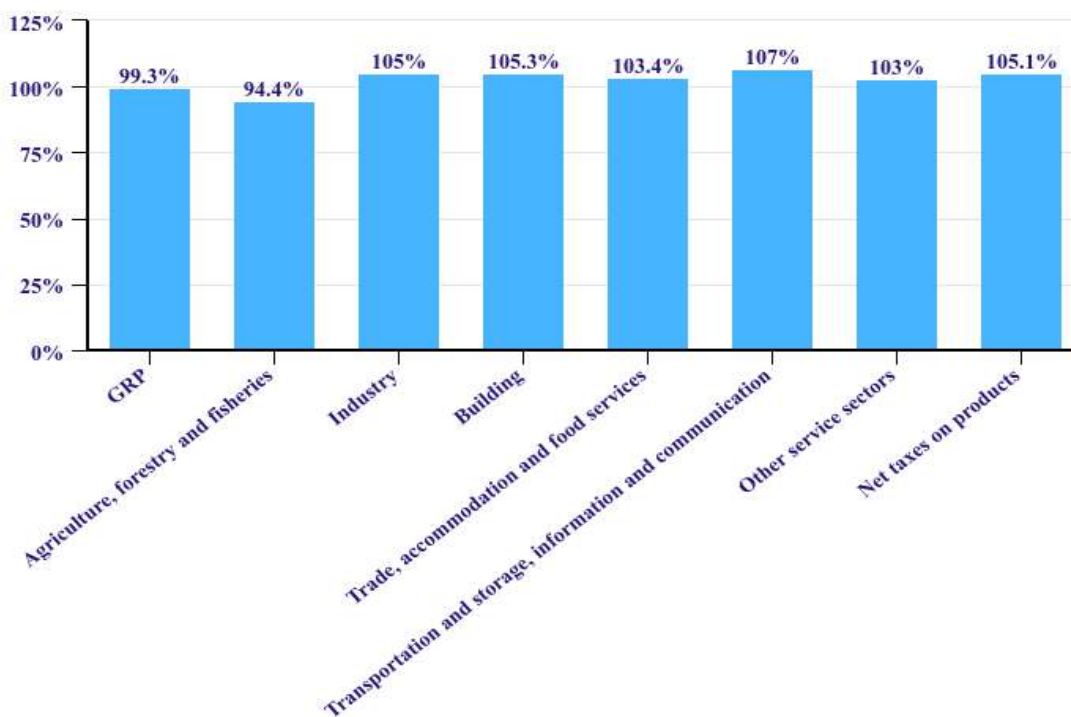


The GRP of the **Samarkand region** amounted to 31187.4 billion soums and decreased by 0.7 %. In this region, positive growth rates were recorded in industry - 105.0 % (share in the GRP structure - 14.0 %), construction - 105.3% (4.4 %), services - 104.1 % (29.3 %). In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, a decrease was recorded, which amounted to 94.4 % by 2017 (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 52.3 %). GRP per capita decreased by 2.7 % and amounted to 8295.8 thousand soums.

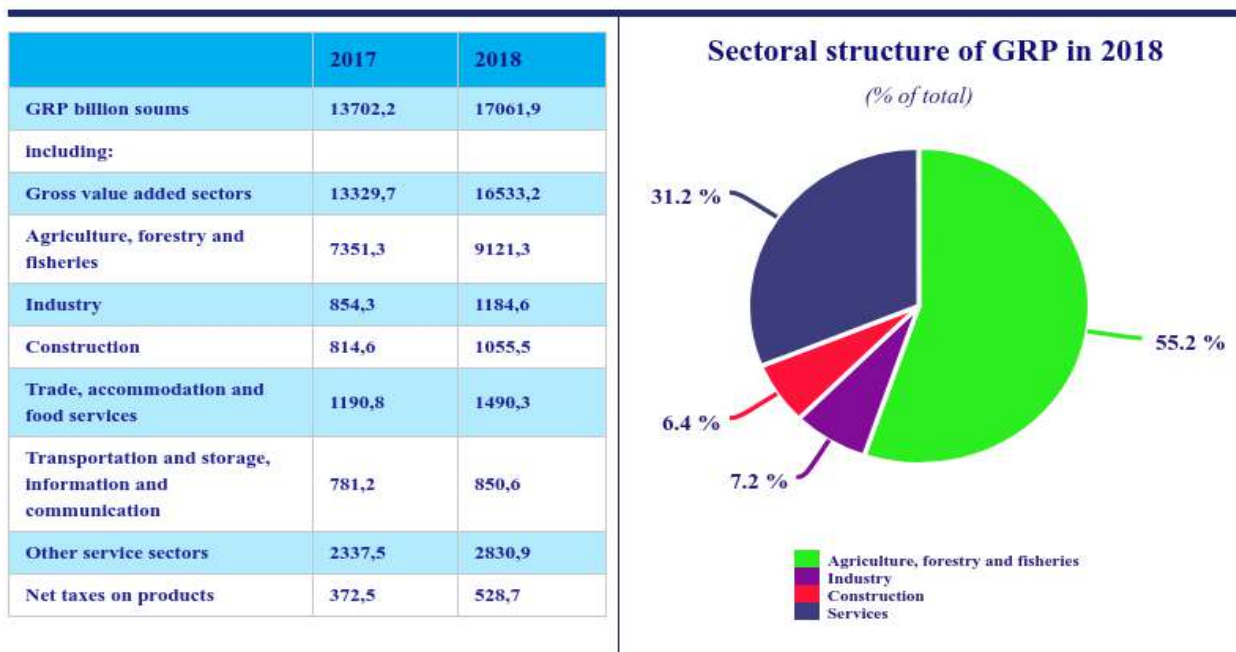


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

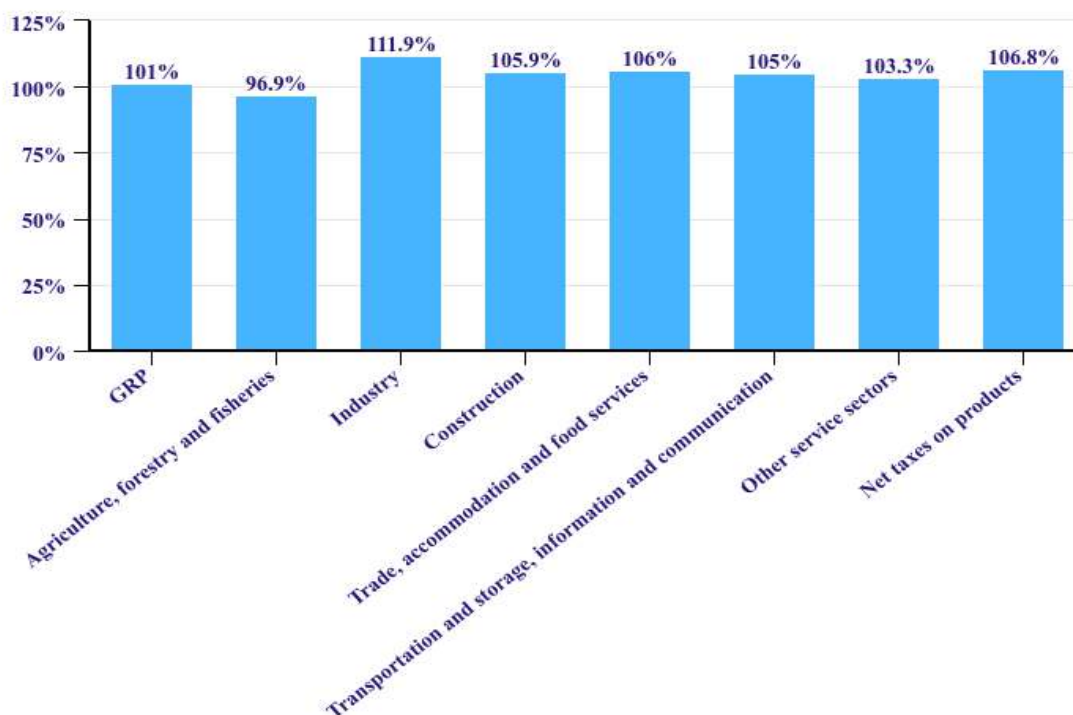


In the **Surkhandarya region**, the GRP grew by 1.0 % and amounted to 17061.9 billion soums. The growth factors in the GRP were industrial growth rates - 111.9 % (7.2 %), construction - 105.9 % (6.4 %), the service sector - 104.3 % (31.2 %). In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, there was a decrease in volume, which amounted to 96.9 % by 2017 (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 55.2 %). GRP per capita amounted to 6 712.5 thousand soums and decreased by 1.1 % by 2017.

(in % by 2017)



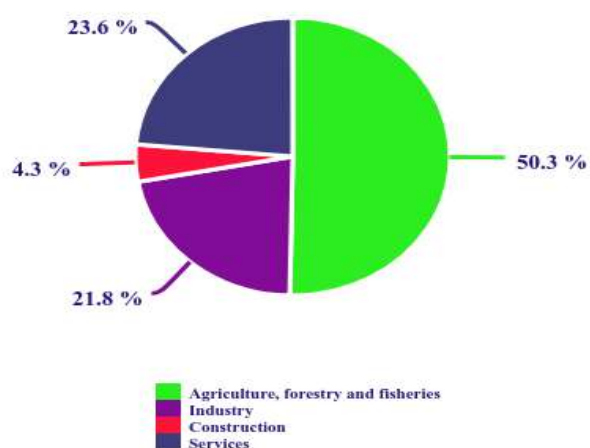
The GRP of the **Syrdarya region** amounted to 8200.5 billion soums with an increase of 2.1 %. In this region, positive growth rates were recorded in the industry - 106.7 % (the share in the GRP structure was 21.8 %), construction - 109.1 % (4.3 %), and the service sector - 104.7 % (23.6 %).

In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, there was a decrease in volume, which amounted to 97.9 % by 2017 (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 50.3 %). The volume of GRP per capita was 9966.6 thousand soums and grew by 0.4 %.

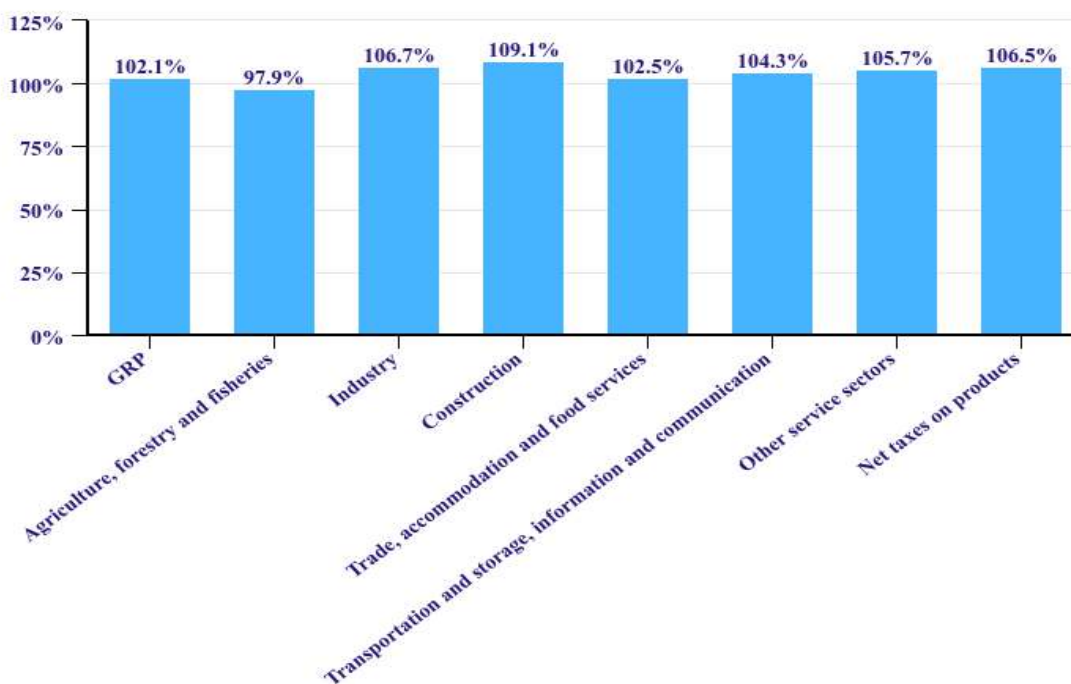
Sectoral structure of GRP in 2018

(% of total)

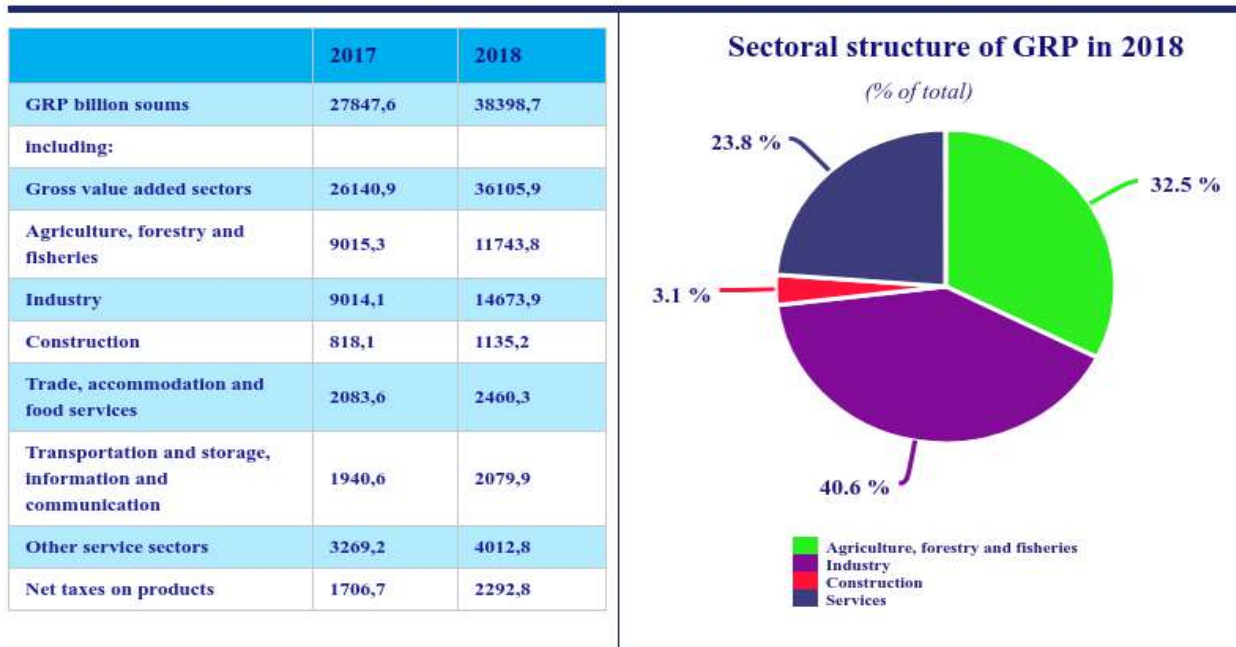


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

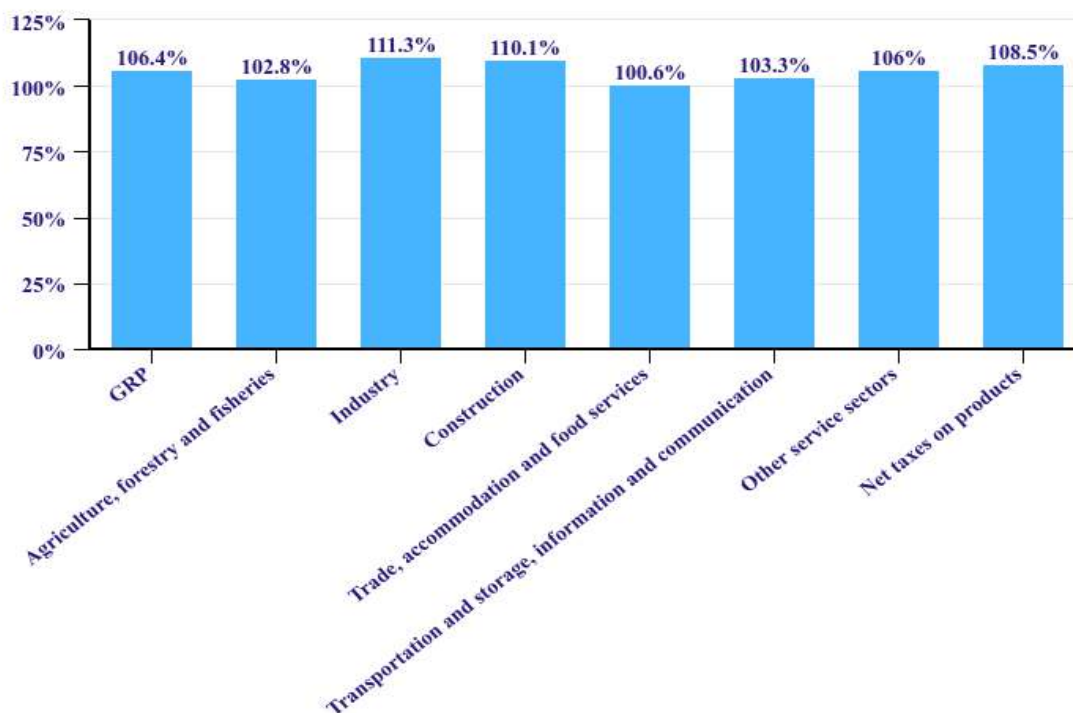


In the **Tashkent region**, the GRP amounted to 38398.7 billion soums and grew by 6.4 %. The growth of GRP is due to positive growth rates in the sectors of the regional economy: in agriculture, forestry and fisheries - 102.8 % (share in the structure of GRP - 32.5 %), industry - 111.3 % (40.6 %), construction - 110.1 % (3.1 %), services - 103.7 % (23.8 %). GRP per capita increased by 5.1 % and amounted to 13333.4 thousand soums.

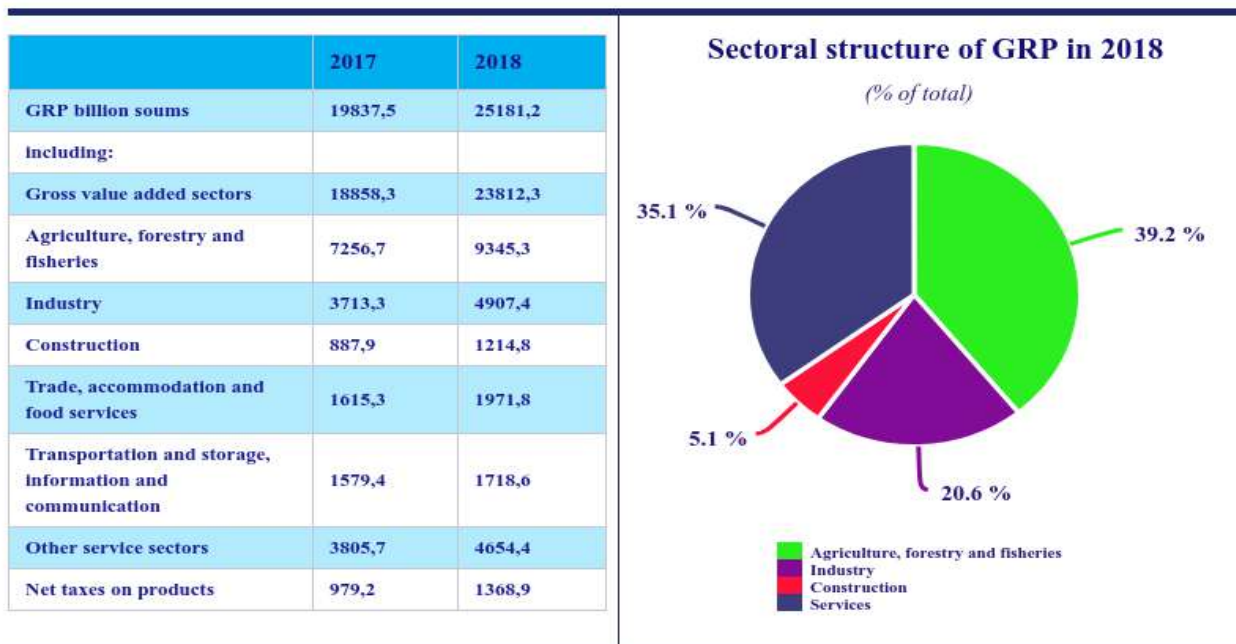


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

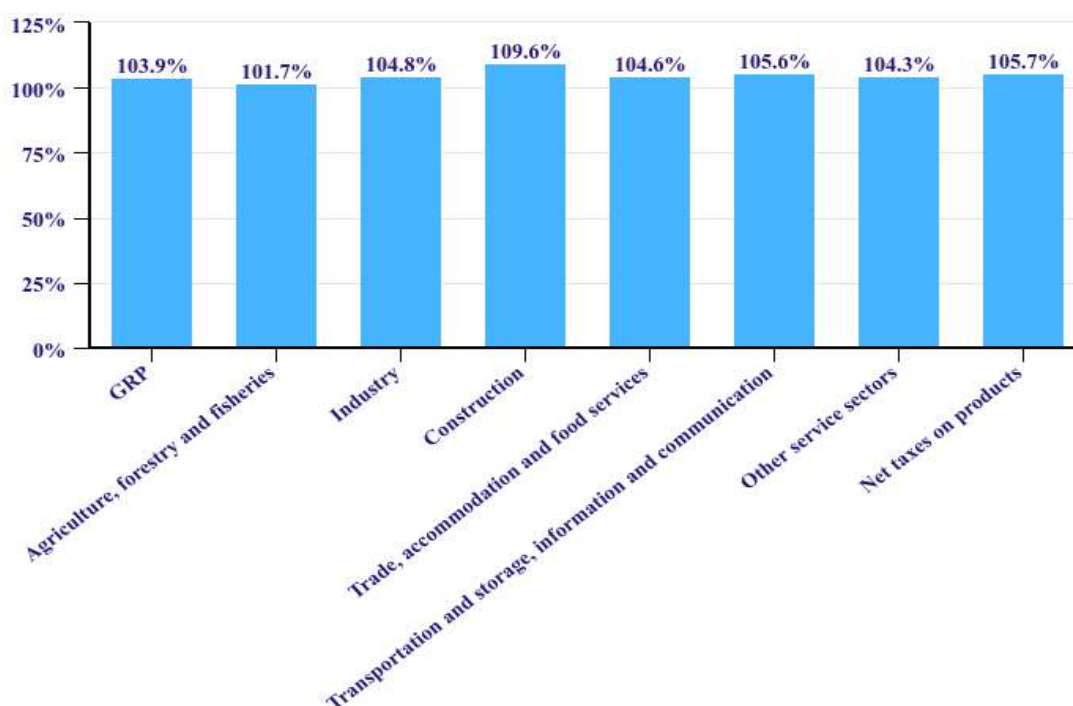


GRP of the **Fergana region** grew by 3.9 % and amounted to 25181.2 billion soums. The growth rate of the GRP is due to the positive growth rates of the regional industries. In agriculture, forestry and fisheries, growth rates amounted to 101.7 % (the share in the structure of GRP - 39.2 %), industry - 104.8 % (20.6 %), construction - 109.6 % (5.1%), the service sector - 104.7 % (35.1 %). GRP per capita amounted to 6895.7 thousand soums and grew by 2.2 %.

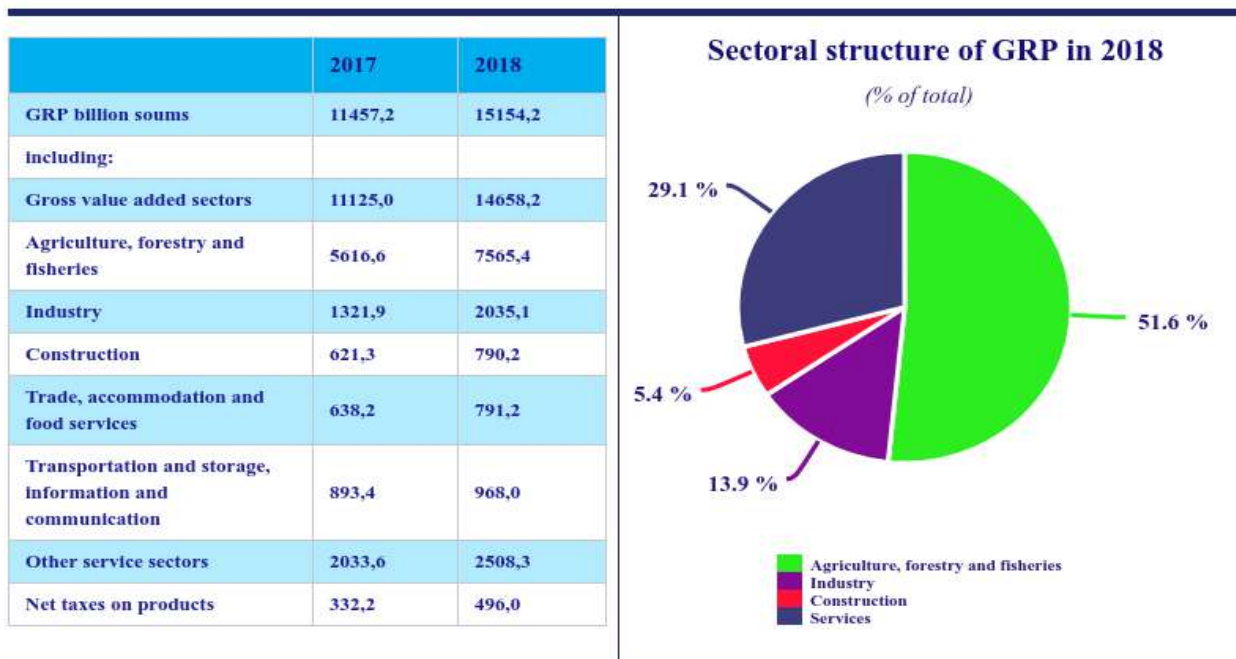


GRP growth rate in 2018

(in % by 2017)

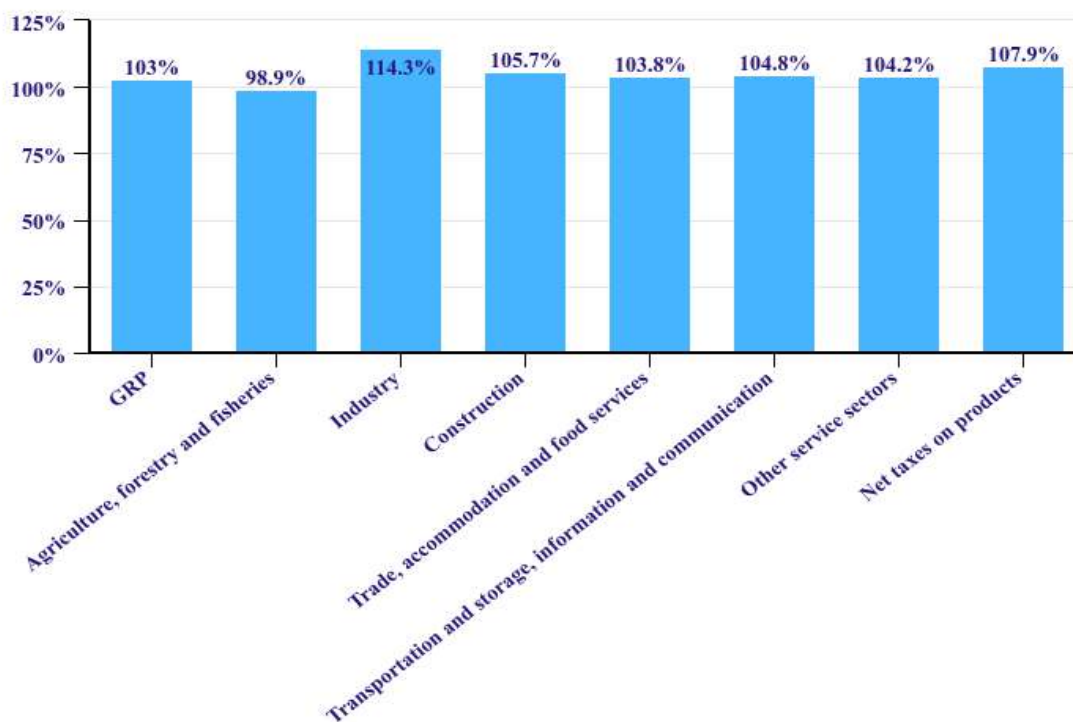


In the **Khorezm region**, the GRP volume amounted to 15154.2 billion soums and grew by 3.0 % compared to the previous year. The growth of GRP is due to the growth rate in industry - 114.3 % (13.9 %), construction - 105.7 % (5.4 %), services - 104.3 % (29.1 %). In the industry of agriculture, forestry and fisheries, there was a decrease in volume, which amounted to 98.9 % by 2017 (the share of this industry in the structure of GRP is 51.6 %). GRP per capita increased by 1.3 % and amounted to 8325.6 thousand soums.

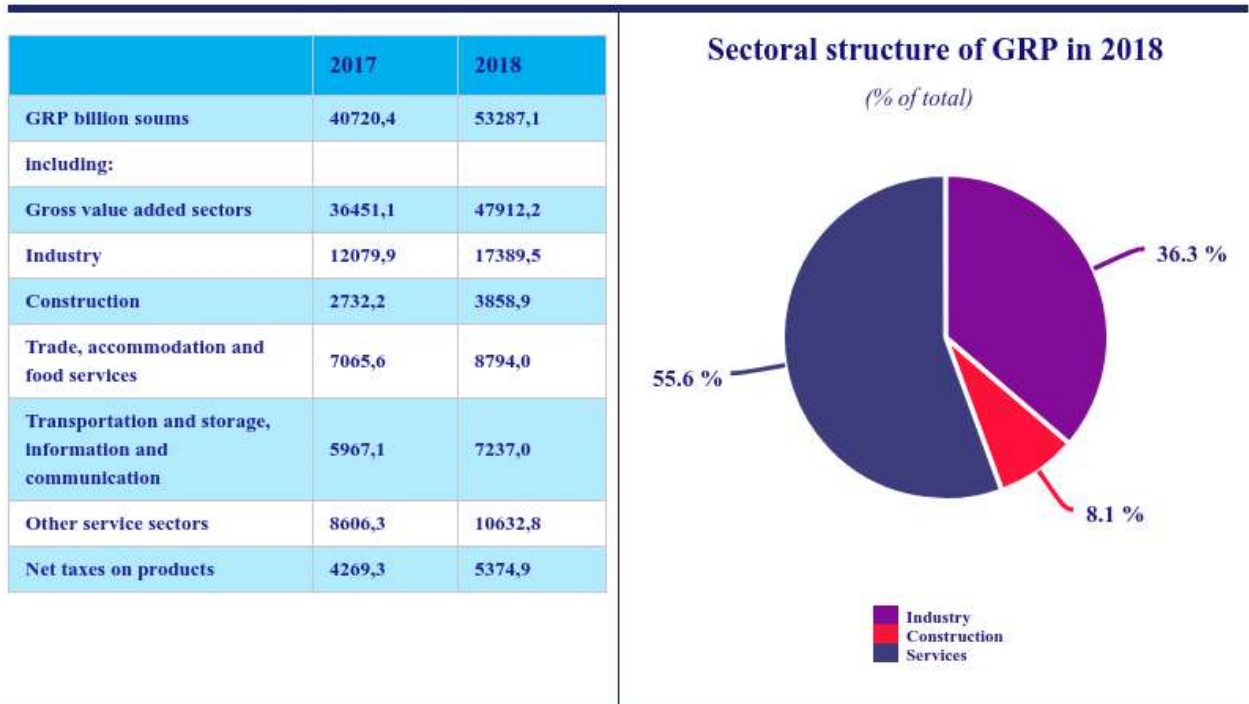


GRP growth rate in 2018

The GRP of **Tashkent city** amounted to 53 287.1 billion soums, which is 8.1 % higher than the 2017 data. The main growth factors for GRP were positive growth rates in such industries - 106.2 % (share in the GRP structure - 36.3 %), construction - 110.6 % (8.1 %), services - 108.8 % (55.6 %). GRP per capita increased by 6.2 % and amounted to 21419.4 thousand soums.
