

Average monthly nominal accrued wages for the Republic of Uzbekistan

For January-March 2018 (preliminary data)



Wage. The analysis of wages by types of economic activity for January-March 2018 showed the following:

- In education in 20 841 institutions 982,5 thousand people work (specific weight in the total number of workers in the republic is 38,6 %), the wage fund accrued to these workers was 3627,1 billion soums (specific weight in the salary fund in the republic - 30,6 %). In the sphere of education, the average monthly nominal accrued wages totaled 1230,6 thousand soums and increased compared to the same period in 2017, by 14,8 %;

- In industry, in 631 enterprises there are 454,6 thousand people (specific weight in the total number of workers in the republic is 17,8 %), the wage fund amounted to 3157,9 billion soums (the share in the wage fund in the republic - 26,7 %). In the sphere of industry, the average monthly nominal accrued wages totaled 2315,7 thousand soums and increased by 27,5 % as compared to the same period in 2017;

- In healthcare and social services, 425,3 thousand people work in 1441 institutions (the share in the total number of workers in the country is 16,7 %), the wage fund amounted to 1311,3 billion soums (specific weight in the wage fund in the republic - 11,1 %). In the field of health and the provision of social services, the average monthly nominal gross salary was 1027.8 thousand soums and increased by 14,3 % as compared to the same period in 2017;

- In the sphere of transportation and storage, 113,6 thousand people work in 204 organizations (the share in the total number of workers in the country is 4,5 %), the wage fund amounted to 716,0 billion soums (the share in the wage fund in the republic - 6,0 %). In the sphere of transportation and storage, the average monthly nominal accrued wages totaled 2011,9 thousand soums and increased compared to with the same period of 2017 by 21,1 %;

- In the sphere of finances and insurance activity in 143 institutions, 67,7 thousand people work (the share in the total number of workers in the republic is 2,7 %), the wage fund amounted to 563,2 billion soums (the share in the wage fund in the republic - 4,8 %). In the sphere of finance and insurance, the average monthly nominal gross salary was 2774,8 thousand soums and increased compared with the same period in 2017 by 28,6 %..

In general, for all types of economic activities in January-March 2018, the average monthly nominal salary in the Republic of Uzbekistan was **1548,3 thousand soums** (including allowances to wages, remuneration, incentive payments, compensation payments and payment for time worked out, as well as income tax, social insurance contributions and trade union funds withheld from individuals), and increased by 20,1 % compared to the same period in 2017.

For January-March 2018 compared to with the same period in 2017, the largest increase in the nominal accrued wages by type of economic activity was observed in information and communication - 28,9 %, financial and insurance activity - 28,6 %, industry - 27,5 %, construction - 24,8 %.

In January-March 2018, in the structure of economic activities in the republic, the average monthly nominal accrued wages in financial and insurance activity exceeded by 79,2 % the average republican level, in the sphere of information and communications - by 75,9 %, in industry - by 49,6 %, in transportation and storage - by 35,8 %, and below the average national level in the sphere of health and social services - by 33,6 %, services for accommodation and meals - by 25,8 %, education - by 20,5 %.



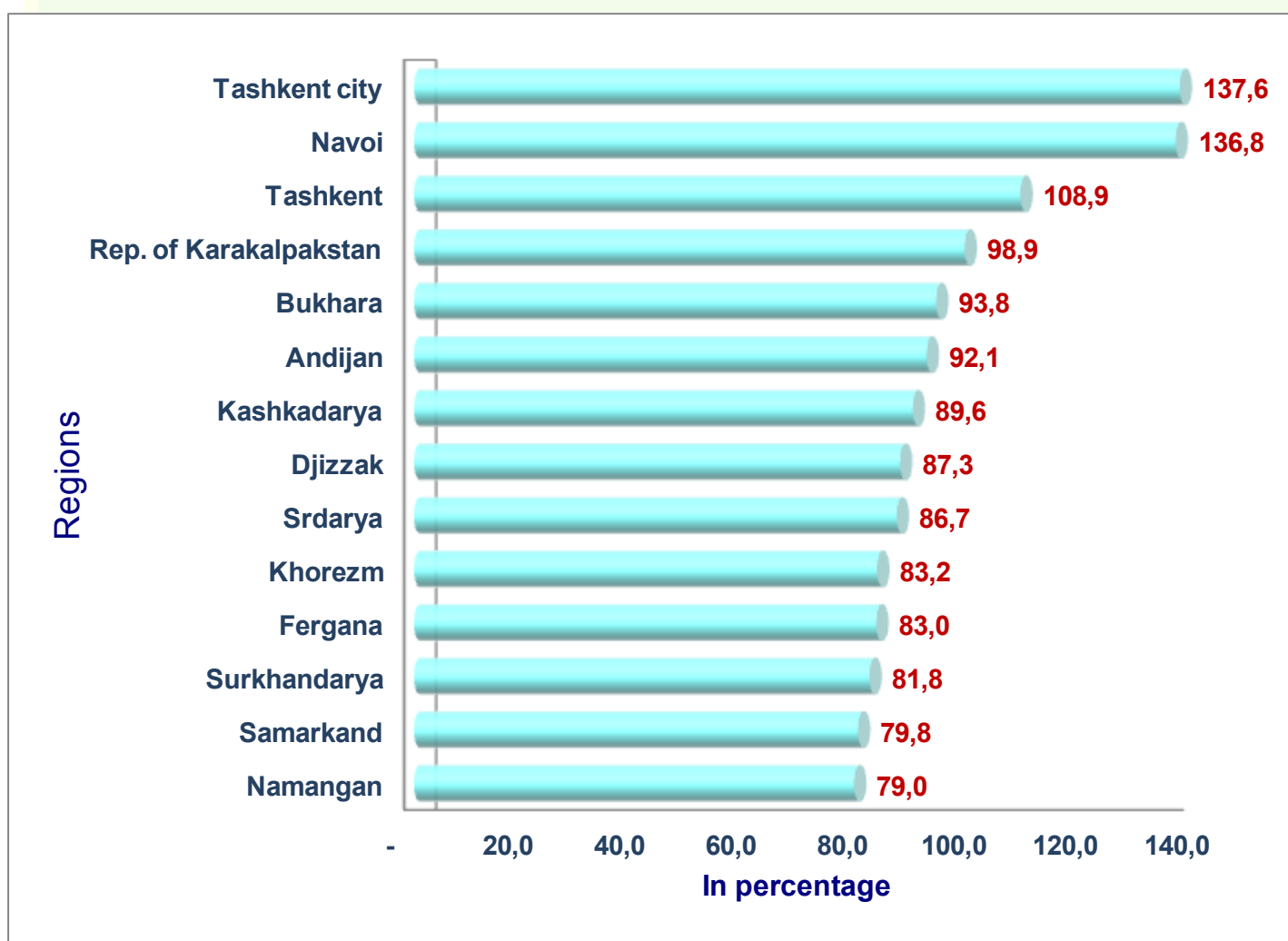
The amount and growth rate of the average monthly nominal accrued wages (for January-March 2018, without agriculture and small business, thousand soums)



If we consider the average monthly nominal wage in the context of the regions, the highest level is observed in Tashkent - 2129,9 thousand UZS (137,6 % of the average republican indicator), in Navoi region - 2118,8 thousand UZS (136,8 %) and in the Tashkent region - 1686,7 thousand soums (108,9 %), and the lowest - in the Namangan region - 1223,9 thousand soums (79,0 %), the Samarkand region 1 234,8 thousand soums (79,8 %).

For reference: According to the Labor Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the monthly salary of an employee who has fulfilled the labor standards and labor obligations fully defined for this period can not be less than the amount established by the legislation for the first category of the Unified wage tariff scale (in January-March 2018, it was 426,5 thousand soums).
